SECTION 1. That the City of Key West hereby sponsors a Martin Luther King march on Monday, January 19, 2015, between 4:00 p.m. and 5:00 p.m.

SECTION 2. That all provisions of the Code of Ordinances with respect to a march on the City right-of-way shall be observed.

SECTION 3. That the march will start at the Nelson English Park (King Community Center) on Catherine and Thomas Street, turn right at Amelia Street, head north to Duval Street, turn left on Duval Street and travel down Duval Street turning left on Front Street (west), turning left on Whitehead Street (east), traveling down Whitehead until Catherine Street, turn right, ending at Nelson English Park.

SECTION 4. That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signature of the presiding officer and the Clerk of the Commission.
