**SUBJECT: 1995 Saulsbury Fire Engine Disposal** 

#### **Action statement:**

Approving the disposal of an obsolete 1995 Saulsbury Fire Engine whose original acquisition price exceeded \$20,000; Authorizing the city manager to dispose of this property through a sealed bid of no less than \$2000.

## Strategic Plan/Business Plan:

Key West Fire Department staff is recommending a sale as obsolete/unusable.

#### **Background:**

The 1995 Saulsbury Fire Engine has exceeded the useful life as an emergency response vehicle.

The 1995 Saulsbury is in need of repairs that exceed the value of the truck.

## **Purpose and Justification:**

The 1995 Saulsbury Fire Engine is no longer deployed. While attempting annual pump test the fire pump to transmission transfer case driveline failed. The truck no longer operates and requires tow to move. Repairs to Engine 7 to bring it back to the previous status are estimated by Ten-8 Fire Equipment at \$33,950.52.

#### **Options:**

- 1) The City Commission could approve the disposal of the 1995 Saulsbury Fire Engine allowing City staff to proceed with a sale by sealed bids.
- 2) The Commission could decline to approve the disposal of the 1995 Saulsbury Fire Engine.

### Financial Impact:

The sale of the 1995 Saulsbury Fire Engine would have a positive budget impact for the City.

#### Recommendation:

Staff recommends Option #1; approving the disposal of the 1995 Saulsbury Fire Engine
