

On August 14, 2014 at approximately 0100 hours Officer Fraga requested that I, Sgt. B. Lariz respond to the 500 block of Rose Lane in reference to a response to resistance report. Upon arrival Officer Fraga briefed me about the incident. I met with the suspect, Nikko Finnegan. Finnegan had slow slurred speech, bloodshot eyes and a strong odor of alcohol emanating from his breath. Finnegan said he was allowed into Fat Tuesday Bar even though he is only 20 years old. Finnegan said he was physically pushed out of the bar by bouncers. Finnegan kept asking for us to just let him go. I saw that Finnegan had abrasions on his face, arms and hands. I asked Finnegan if he was injured and he complained of an injury above his left eye, which was a small abrasion and said his neck hurt. Finnegan said he injured his neck in a car accident a few weeks ago. Officer Fraga requested Care ambulance to respond. Fraga later told me that Finnegan refused treatment. I asked Finnegan how much he had to drink and he said a lot. I asked Finnegan how many drinks he had and what type. Finnegan said he had about 10 drinks, some being beer and some vodka.

I met with a group of subjects, two females and two males who appeared to know or be with Finnegan. I asked the group if they witnessed the incident and they all said no. I told the officers on scene to get the subjects contact information. Officers Fraga and Morris later told me the subjects were not cooperative and only two of them provided partial information.

I went inside Fat Tuesday Bar and the surrounding area to locate any other witnesses but the bar was closed and empty. The only witnesses I talked to were the two bouncers that were involved, Brian Rose and Michael Wukotich. Both of their verbal statements to me were consistent with each other. They were not sure how Finnegan got inside the bar but think he may have snuck in. Rose said he did make Finnegan leave earlier in the evening when he tried to get in but said he must have returned later. See witness statements and my Coban in car recording for further details. Wukotich said he recorded the incident involving Rose, Finnegan and himself on his cellular phone. Wukotich provided Officer

Fraga with the video, which Officer Fraga placed in property as evidence. The Fat Tuesday Staff was provided the case number and will call in when they are able to place the Fat Tuesday surveillance video onto a disc.

Officer Fraga said while he was dealing with Finnegan he was uncooperative. Finnegan kept asking Officers Fraga and Cutie for his driver's license back and then started approaching Officer Cutie and slapping his hands together in front of Officer Cutie's face. Due to Finnegan's actions Officer Cutie told him to place his hands behind his back and attempted to handcuff him. Finnegan began to flee and Officer Cutie grabbed him by the arm. Finnegan pulled his arm away from Officer Cutie with such force that he pulled Officer Cutie with him. Officer Fraga then grabbed Finnegan from behind, under his right arm and put his left arm over Finnegan's left shoulder directing Finnegan to the ground in a controlled manner to gain control of him. Finnegan continued pulling away and pulling his hands under his body. Officer Kasyanenko arrived on scene. Officer Fraga disengaged because his gun belt came unclipped. Officer Cutie turned on his TASER and placed it on Finnegan's back advising him to cooperate or he would be TASED. Finnegan then complied and Officer Kasyanenko handcuffed him.

It is unknown which injuries Finnegan sustained from being taken to the ground by Rose and Wukotich or Officers Fraga and Cutie. I photographed Officer Fraga's abrasion that he sustained on his left elbow, Rose's abrasions on his hands and Finnegan's injuries. While trying to take profile photos of Finnegan's face he was not cooperative. Finnegan kept turning his face behind him instead of to the side. I gave him multiple chances and instructions to only turn sideways and look at the officer next to him, but he would intentionally turn his head behind him so I could not get a good photograph. I placed all of the photos that I took, Officer Cutie's TASER video and TASER log; which I downloaded onto a disc. I gave the disc to Officer Fraga and he placed it into the property section as evidence. I also completed a Notice of Injury report for Officer Fraga.
