On September 15, 2014 at approximately 1948 hours, I Sgt. B. Lariz responded to the 3000 block of Riviera Drive in reference to an arrestee, Patrick Sheeren being TASED. Upon arrival I met with Officers A. Rodriguez. Officer C. Richardson was with Sheeren who was sitting on the ground being treated by Care Ambulance. Once he was treated Ofc. Richardson put Sheeren in the rear of Ofc. Rodriguez's patrol car. Shortly after I partially opened the rear patrol door and talked to Sheeren. I asked Sheeren if he was injured and he said no. I asked Sheeren what happen. Sheeren was not able to describe the incident. I asked Sheeren where he lived and he was not able to answer the question. Sheeren started putting his right foot out of the patrol car. I told Sheeren to put his foot back inside, I shut the door and did not talk to him anymore. While I was talking to Sheeren I noticed he had slurred speech, blood shot eyes and there was a strong odor of alcohol emanating from his breath. This conversation was recorded on Ofc. Rodriguez's Coban, in car video system.

Ofc. Richardson said while investigating the incident Sheeren attempted to leave the scene. Sheeren told Ofc. Richardson that he was leaving and started to walk away. Ofc. Richardson told him to stop and put his hands in front of Sheeren. Sheeren pushed Ofc. Richardson's hands away. Sheeren then pushed away from him, so Ofc. Richardson conducted a leg sweep take down. Once on the ground Sheeren was grabbing and pushing at Ofc. Richardson trying to break free and grabbed Ofc. Richardson around his torso. Ofc. Rodriguez advised he was going to use his TASER. Ofc. Rodriguez deployed his TASER and the probes struck Sheeren's left middle and lower back. Ofc. Richardson was then able to handcuff Sheeren.

I met with the two witnesses, Cory Heydon and Carrie Mann separately. Heydon and Mann's statements were consistent with each other. They said that the officers showed restraint and felt they could have used more force. Heydon said Sheeren pushed Officer Richardson and the force used by the officers was "Perfectly warranted." Mann said the officers were "Polite" and "Cordial." They both wrote sworn statements, which were sent to the KWPD Records Section to be filed with the report.

Due to Sheeren resisting arrest, I did not remove him from the car to take photos. I advised Ofc. Rodriguez to take photos of Sheeren once they were at the jail, which he did. Later I placed those photos, photos of Ofc. Richardson's injuries, which I took and the TASER video all on one disc. I provided Ofc. Rodriguez with the disc and he placed it in the KWPD Property Section as evidence.

Although Sheeren told me he was not injured he had several minor abrasions on the top of his right hand, on the right side of his forehead, above his left eye, right elbow and left elbow.

Officer Richardson sustained an abrasion on his left elbow and it was slightly swollen. He did not require medical treatment. I completed a notice of injury report.

Ofc. Rodriguez arrested Sheeren and charged him with D.U. I. and resisting arrest without violence.

On September 20, 2014 at approximately 2214 hours I, Sgt. B. Lariz responded to 423 Simonton St. per Officer Malsheimer's request. Upon arrival I met with Officers Fraga and Malsheimer. They explained to me that they woke up a subject, Kiah Colbert who was sleeping on the porch of a closed business, Duck and Dolphin Antiques, 601 Fleming St. During this conversation Colbert was in the ambulance, on scene being treated and I did not make contact with him. Shortly after Colbert was transported to the Lower Keyes Medical Center by Care Ambulance to have a laceration on his chin treated and Ofc. Malsheimer followed them.

After waking Colbert up from sleeping on the porch of a closed business and blocking the entrance/exit, Colbert resisted/obstructed the officers. Colbert refused to identify himself. When the officers tried to handcuff Colbert he tensed and pulled away from them. Ofc. Malsheimer applied pressure to Colbert's right wrist to gain compliance but was only able to get the handcuffs on Colbert's right wrist. They then pushed Colbert against the window of a business and were able to handcuff him even though he was still pulling away from them. After Colbert was handcuffed Ofc. Malsheimer was holding onto his right arm when he intentionally stood straight up and leaned forward with his body weight. Colbert is 6'02" tall and weighs 210 pounds. Due to Colbert's weight, Ofc. Malsheimer was not able to prevent him from falling. When Colbert landed he sustained a laceration on his chin.

I then responded to the Lower Keys Medical Center where I met with Ofc. Malsheimer and Colbert. As I walked into the emergency room I could hear Colbert yelling at the medical staff to leave him alone, refusing to get stiches and demanding for the handcuffs to be removed. Due to Colbert's belligerent behavior Ofc. Malsheimer and I entered the room. Colbert continued to say he would not allow them to put stiches on the laceration but he would allow them to apply a bandage, which they did. I tried to talk to Colbert about the incident but he would just curse and not answer the questions. Colbert repeatedly called us Faggots, Duche Bags and requested his attorney. Colbert kept trying to get up, so Ofc. Malsheimer and I had to hold him on the bed by holding his shoulders. While talking to

Colbert I noticed an odor of alcohol on his breath, slurred speech and he had bloodshot eyes. I told Colbert numerous times what his charge was but he would still repeatedly ask what his charge was. I asked Colbert if he had been drinking and he said that he had two beers. I assisted Ofc. Malsheimer with walking Colbert to Ofc. Malsheimer's patrol car without incident. Ofc. Malsheimer then transported Colbert to the Monroe County Detention center. Due to Colbert's aggressive behavior I did not attempt to photograph him on scene. I had Ofc. Malsheimer take photos of Colbert once he was at the Monroe County Detention Center.

I was not able to locate any independent witnesses.

There was a surveillance camera at 423 Simonton St., Bike Fit Key West, which was pointing in the area where the arrest was made. I returned to 423 Simonton St. and left my business card with my work and cellular number. I left a note on the card with the case #, date and time of incident requesting they call in reference to obtaining the video if possible.
