On 05/09/2014, at approximately 1800 hours, I (Det. M. Siracuse) along with Det. S. Warmington, were working an off duty detail for the Key West Housing Authority. Det. Warmington and I were in plain clothes, with our guns and badges exposed at our waistbands.

Det. Warmington and I were on foot walking through the Ft. Village apartment complex. We walked to the 1100 block of Emma Street where we met with several subjects drinking alcohol in the street. I gave those subjects warnings for open containers and they complied.

Det. Warmington and I continued walking northbound on Emma Street, approaching the intersection of Truman Avenue and Emma Street. As we reached that intersection, we observed a black male, personally known to both of us as Ricky Normen Cartwright, riding a bicycle. Both Det. Warmington and I have both had previous law enforcement interaction with Cartwright and he has been trespassed from Housing Authority property.

Cartwright was riding a yellow bicycle inbound on Truman Avenue on the left side of the road. When I first observed Cartwright, he was text messaging on his phone with his right hand and holding a cup of what appeared to be beer in his right, with no hands on the handlebars. Cartwright continued through the stop sign at Truman Avenue and Emma Street without stopping. Det. Warmington and I both told Cartwright to stop the bike, however he continued, riding around in a circle as if he were deciding whether to stop or not. I pulled my Taser and told Cartwright I was going to tase him if he didn't stop the bike. Cartwright came back to us and I told him to get off of the bicycle and sit on the curb. Cartwright got off of the bicycle and began pacing, asking why we were stopping him. Cartwright momentarily sat on the curb, stood back up, pulled up his shorts, and began running westbound on Truman Avenue, towards Ft. Village Apartments.

I pulled my Taser and deployed the probes, both making contact with Cartwright's back. Cartwright

became immobilized and fell to the ground. I held Cartwright down while Det. Warmington handcuffed him. Cartwright began yelling as loud as he could, and almost immediately a large crowd began forming around us. Amidst the crowd was another black male, also personally known to us from prior law enforcement interaction as Johnny Taylor. Taylor resides in Ft. Village Apartments, unit 1C. Taylor began loudly yelling at us, egging on the crowd and drawing closer and closer. Det. Warmington and I gave several loud clear verbal commands to stay back, however Taylor continued coming closer and

verbally threatening us making statements such as, "I dare you to Tase me, I'll smash you."

Within minutes a crowd of at least 50 bystanders surrounded us and Det. Warmington called for additional Officers while I held down Cartwright. Eventually we stood Cartwright up and walked him to the sidewalk on the 200 block of Truman Avenue. Additional units arrived on scene, including mounted patrol. Mounted Officer M. Johnson attempted to clear the streets using the horse, however mainly Taylor refused to get out of the roadway, yelling, "Fuck that horse, blow your fucking whistle, let that horse touch me." Ofc. Hall arrived on scene. Det. Warmington asked Ofc. Hall to try to keep Taylor back because despite numerous commands to stay back, Taylor continued advancing on Ofc. Warmington and I, distracting us from arresting Cartwright.

Ofc. Andruzzi, Det. Warmington, and I, eventually stood Cartwright up and began searching him. Cartwright began yelling as loud as he could and reaching for his pockets. I reached in Cartwright's right pocket and pulled out a large sum of US currency and a green Newport cigarette box that did not contain narcotics. Cartwright reached into his left pocket and pulled out a second Newport cigarette box. Cartwright began pulling us forward and trying to throw the box over a small white picket fence he was leaned against. The fence borders and empty lot on the southeast intersection of Truman and Emma Street. Det. Warmington pulled Cartwright's hand down and got Cartwright to release the cigarette box, which fell to the ground along with additional US currency. Once the box fell to the ground, Cartwright began stepping on it and crushing it with his foot. Det. Warmington pulled his foot to the side and picked up the box, which contained an off white colored substance of suspected crack cocaine. It was clear Cartwright was trying to hide and destroy the cocaine throughout the entire incident. Det. Warmington informed me that although Cartwright had crushed a bit of the cocaine, he had recovered a decent amount. Det. Warmington later field tested (positive) the crack cocaine and weighed the substance (.5 grams). Det Warmington also recovered a small clear plastic bag of FTP marijuana from Cartwright's pocket.

Ofc. Andruzzi placed Cartwright in the back seat of his patrol vehicle and left the area. Det. Warmington photographed Cartwright's bicycle and the cup of beer he had in his possession. Due to the large crowd that was increasing in hostility, All Officers moved one block north, to the intersection of Olivia Street and Emma Street.

Moments later, Officer D. Hall approached Taylor after I had asked Ofc. Hall to take Taylor into custody for resisting an officer without violence. Ofc. Hall asked Taylor to put his hands behind his back and when Ofc. Hall went to handcuff him, Taylor began pulling away. Ofc. Hall eventually handcuffed Taylor and asked him to get into the back of his patrol car. Taylor layed on the ground and refused to stand up. Ofc. Hall and Officer Gaufillet stood Taylor up and attempted to place him in the back seat of Ofc. Hall's patrol vehicle. Taylor began yelling as loud as he could, screaming he was in pain, and braced himself in the door frame of the vehicle. Officer Hall began calling for a supervisor and additional units. Det. Warmington and I got in our unmarked police vehicle and returned to that location.

Det. Warmington, Ofc. Hall, Ofc. Gaufillet and I, after struggling with Taylor for several minutes, got him to lay across the back seat of the patrol vehicle. Taylor appeared to be faking an injury, and his actions were not consistent with the injuries. Taylor began kicking and extending his legs so that Officer Hall could not close the back door. I reached in and tried to pull Taylor further into the vehicle, however Taylor was yelling and began trying to bite my arm. I felt Taylor's teeth clench on my forearm and quickly pulled my arm away from his mouth. Taylor had bit my hand area and grazed my forearm with his teeth. Det. Warmington and Ofc. Hall got Taylor restrained in the vehicle and Officer Hall left the area.

Taylor did not break the skin on my arm or hand, however noticeable red teeth marks were visible and photographed. Both Taylor and Cartwright were transported to the Lower Keys Medical Center where they were medically cleared and subsequently transported to the Monroe County Detention Center for processing. All evidence was placed in the KWPD Property Section by Det. S. Warmington. A total of \$922.00 in US currency was removed from Cartwright's possession and seized under the FL contraband act. The denominations and manner in which the money was contained was consistent with street level narcotics sales. I will be seeking a search warrant for Cartwright's phone to further support evidence of narcotics sales. The incident took place at the intersection of Emma Street and Truman Avenue, which is well within 1000 feet of Ft. Village Apartments, a Key West Housing Authority property.

Cartwright's Charges:

- 1. Possession of cocaine with intent to sell, within 1000 feet of public housing, in violation of F.S.S. 893.13(1)(e)(1)
- 2. Possession of marijuana with intent to sell, within 1000 feet of public housing, in violation of F.S.S. 893.13(1)(f)(2)
- 3. Tamper with or Fabricate evidence Cartwright attempted to throw the crack cocaine over a fence and later crush it under his foot, with the intention of concealing and destroying the evidence, in violation of F.S.S. 918.13
- 4. Resisting without violence, Cartwright refused to stop his bicycle when ordered by two law enforcement Officers. Cartwright then proceeded to run from detectives, in an attempt to escape custody, in violation of F.S.S. 843.02

Taylor's Charges:

- 1. Battery on a law enforcement officer. Taylor, while being arrested for resisting an officer without violence, layed across the back of the patrol vehicle and would not allow officers to close the door. While pulling Taylor from under his arms, Taylor bit a detective on the hand and forearm. Taylor did so intentionally, with the intent of causing bodily harm to the law enforcement officer. Taylor did so in violation of F.S.S. 784.04(2)(b)
- 2. Resisting an officer without violence, Taylor, despite numerous clear loud verbal commands to stay back from the scene of an existing arrest, continued to draw closer and verbally threaten the officers already engaged in effecting a lawful arrest. Taylor ignored officer's commands and presented an

SUPPLEMENTAL Topic

On 05/09/2014 at approx. 1820 hrs. I was assigned by dispatch narcotic detectives needed additional units at Truman Ave. and Emma st.

I responded to their location I observed Det. Siracuse and Det. Warmington on the corner struggling with their arrestee who I now know as Ricky Cartwright. Cartwright was handcuffed and in a seated position and I observed a large crowd gathering around the detectives.

I exited my patrol vehicle and assisted bringing Cartwright to his feet. Cartwright continued to refuse the verbal directions of the detectives. As I held the arm of Cartwright I discovered that he had been tased before my arrival. I also observed him holding and eventually dropping objects from his left hand. Cartwright then attempted to step on an object on the ground several times.

EMS unit was on scene but because the crowd forming on the street continued to grow Cartwright was placed directly into my patrol vehicle. For the safety of all officers on scene I transported Cartwright to the Key West Police Department.

I was met at the Police Station by EMS. I removed a taser probe from the middle of Cartwright's back and he was then attended to by medics. Photographs of Cartwright and of the probe in Cartwright's back were taken before removal.

He was cleared by EMS and I transported Cartwright to the Lower Keys Medical Center. The emergency room staff treated a small puncture hole to Cartwright's back from the taser probe. The medical staff cleared Cartwright and he was then transported to the Monroe County Jail for processing,

On May 9, 2014 at approximately 1847hrs, I (Ofc. A. Gaufillet) responded to Truman Ave. and Emma St. to assist officers.

When I arrived on scene Ofc. D. Hall and I were advised that there was another subject (Johnny Taylor), that had not previously been detained because of safety reasons. Ofc. Hall located the Taylor and I assisted in his detention. Once handcuffed we attempted to bring him back towards Ofc. Hall's car. At this point Taylor told us that his neck and back were hurting him and he was suddenly unable to walk. We continued to escort him back to the patrol car all the while he was screaming that we were hurting him. When we arrived at the patrol car Taylor head butted the patrol vehicle's left rear passenger door and left rear quarter panel. Ofc. Hall then opened the rear door in an attempt to put him in the car. Taylor sat on the rear seat but would not fully get into the vehicle. He wrapped his right foot under the door and hooked his left foot on the door jam. I pushed his right foot off of the door and Ofc. Hall put his other foot into the vehicle. At this point other officers arrived on scene and I maintained security as the crowds were becoming very hostile towards us. Once inside the vehicle Taylor was removed from the scene. No further information at this time.

On Friday, May 9, 2014, at approximately 1822 hours, I (Ofc Hall) responded to the intersection of Truman Ave and Emma Street as back up to detectives on scene. I arrived and observed a large crowd surrounding the detectives that had a subject in handcuffs.

I parked my patrol car and quickly got between the detectives and the crowd, making the crowd give the detectives room.

I then observed Johnny Taylor Jr in the front of the crowd yelling and screaming at the detectives. It appeared that Taylor was outraged at the detectives. He kept yelling at the detectives and the other officers on scene.

Taylor was specifically yelling at the horse and the mounted officer. Taylor kept yelling, "Man, That fucking horse comes near me again, I'm going to fucking punch it!"

I got in between the horse and Taylor and told him to calm down.

Taylor backed up slightly and still kept yelling.

I could see that Taylor was the main person getting the crowd agitated.

I again tried to get Taylor to calm down but was unable to gain compliance.

Once the detectives removed the other subject from the scene, we left and I met the two in front of Douglas Gym.

Detective Siracuse told me that he was going to arrest Taylor for resisting without violence for taking their attention away from their arrest. I could see Taylor still at the intersection.

I pulled my patrol car up to Taylor and got out. I approached Taylor and told him to place his hands behind his back, that he was under arrest. Taylor laced his hands behind his back and I started to put him in handcuffs. I was able to get his right wrist in a handcuff before Taylor stated to try and pull away from me. I gained control of Taylor and was able to get his left wrist int handcuffs.

Taylor was yelling and saying, "My back, my neck, I have a broke neck."

I walked Taylor to the rear of my patrol car. Once I opened my rear door, Taylor started screaming again. Taylor was yelling, "My back, I was hit by a car man, my back!"

Taylor then dropped to his knees, then tried to lay down while Ofc Gaufillet and I still had a hold of him. We pulled him up and tried to get him into the rear of my patrol car.

Taylor then braced himself in the door jam keeping us from putting him inside the rear. Taylor was bracing his head and shoulder against the top and bracing his legs and feet under the rear door. The entire time. Taylor was screaming and yelling.

Once we were able to get Taylor into the rear of the patrol car, Taylor was extending his legs out the door in an attempt to keep us from closing the doors. Detective Siracuse tried to pull Taylor closer to the other side of the vehicle as Taylor was moving around in an attempt to keep Detective Siracuse from moving him.

Once Taylor was inside the patrol vehicle with the doors closed, I transported him to the police department.

Sqt Biskup tried to talk to Taylor but was unable because Taylor refused to talk and only asked questions. Sqt Biskup then had me transport Taylor to the ER for medical clearance.

Once at the ER, Taylor refused to get out of the patrol car. Nurses and security officers from the ER helped me remove Taylor from the vehicle. The entire time, Taylor screamed and yelled that he was in pain.

Taylor was cleared by the doctor at the ER.

Taylor was then transported to the jail by an ambulance since Taylor refused to walk or get off of the bed.

Once at the Jail, Taylor refused to get off of the stretcher.

Corrections officers and I then removed Taylor from the stretcher and placed him in a chair.

After Taylor was processed. I returned to take pictures of Taylor for the RRI. I was able to take a picture of Taylor's face before Taylor refused anymore pictures and started yelling and cursing at me.

I asked Taylor if he had any other injuries from the Key West Police Department. Taylor said, "No, I'm fine, now get out of my fucking face!"

Sqt Katz was present for the pictures.

Det. Warmington and I continued walking northbound on Emma Street, approaching the intersection of Truman Avenue and Emma Street. As we reached that intersection, we observed a black male, personally known to both of us as Ricky Normen Cartwright, riding a bicycle. Both Det. Warmington and I have both had previous law enforcement interaction with Cartwright and he has been trespassed from Housing Authority property.

Cartwright was riding a yellow bicycle inbound on Truman Avenue on the left side of the road. When I first observed Cartwright, he was text messaging on his phone with his right hand and holding a cup of what appeared to be beer in his right, with no hands on the handlebars. Cartwright continued through the stop sign at Truman Avenue and Emma Street without stopping. Det. Warmington and I both told Cartwright to stop the bike, however he continued, riding around in a circle as if he were deciding whether to stop or not. I pulled my Taser and told Cartwright I was going to tase him if he didn't stop the bike. Cartwright came back to us and I told him to get off of the bicycle and sit on the curb. Cartwright got off of the bicycle and began pacing, asking why we were stopping him. Cartwright momentarily sat on the curb, stood back up, pulled up his shorts, and began running westbound on Truman Avenue, towards Ft. Village Apartments.

I pulled my Taser and deployed the probes, both making contact with Cartwright's back. Cartwright became immobilized and fell to the ground. I held Cartwright down while Det. Warmington handcuffed him. Cartwright began yelling as loud as he could, and almost immediately a large crowd began forming around us. Amidst the crowd was another black male, also personally known to us from prior law enforcement interaction as Johnny Taylor. Taylor resides in Ft. Village Apartments, unit 1C. Taylor began loudly yelling at us, egging on the crowd and drawing closer and closer. Det. Warmington and I gave several loud clear verbal commands to stay back, however Taylor continued coming closer and verbally threatening us making statements such as, "I dare you to Tase me, I'll smash you."

Within minutes a crowd of at least 50 bystanders surrounded us and Det. Warmington called for additional Officers while I held down Cartwright. Eventually we stood Cartwright up and walked him to the sidewalk on the 200 block of Truman Avenue. Additional units arrived on scene, including mounted patrol. Mounted Officer M. Johnson attempted to clear the streets using the horse, however mainly Taylor refused to get out of the roadway, yelling, "Fuck that horse, blow your fucking whistle, let that horse touch me." Ofc. Hall arrived on scene. Det. Warmington asked Ofc. Hall to try to keep Taylor back because despite numerous commands to stay back, Taylor continued advancing on Ofc. Warmington and I, distracting us from arresting Cartwright.

Ofc. Andruzzi, Det. Warmington, and I, eventually stood Cartwright up and began searching him. Cartwright began yelling as loud as he could and reaching for his pockets. I reached in Cartwright's right pocket and pulled out a large sum of US currency and a green Newport cigarette box that did not contain narcotics. Cartwright reached into his left pocket and pulled out a second Newport cigarette box. Cartwright began pulling us forward and trying to throw the box over a small white picket fence he was leaned against. The fence borders and empty lot on the southeast intersection of Truman and Emma Street. Det. Warmington pulled Cartwright's hand down and got Cartwright to release the cigarette box, which fell to the ground along with additional US currency. Once the box fell to the ground, Cartwright began stepping on it and crushing it with his foot. Det. Warmington pulled his foot to the side and picked up the box, which contained an off white colored substance of suspected crack cocaine. It was clear Cartwright was trying to hide and destroy the cocaine throughout the entire incident. Det. Warmington informed me that although Cartwright had crushed a bit of the cocaine, he had recovered a decent amount. Det. Warmington later field tested (positive) the crack cocaine and weighed the substance (.5 grams). Det Warmington also recovered a small clear plastic bag of FTP marijuana from Cartwright's pocket.

Ofc. Andruzzi placed Cartwright in the back seat of his patrol vehicle and left the area. Det. Warmington photographed Cartwright's bicycle and the cup of beer he had in his possession. Due to the large crowd that was increasing in hostility, All Officers moved one block north, to the intersection of Olivia Street and Emma Street.

Moments later, Officer D. Hall approached Taylor after I had asked Ofc. Hall to take Taylor into custody for resisting an officer without violence. Ofc. Hall asked Taylor to put his hands behind his back and when Ofc. Hall went to handcuff him, Taylor began pulling away. Ofc. Hall eventually handcuffed Taylor and asked him to get into the back of his patrol car. Taylor layed on the ground and refused to stand up. Ofc. Hall and Officer Gaufillet stood Taylor up and attempted to place him in the back seat of Ofc. Hall's patrol vehicle. Taylor began yelling as loud as he could,

screaming he was in pain, and braced himself in the door frame of the vehicle. Officer Hall began calling for a supervisor and additional units. Det. Warmington and I got in our unmarked police vehicle and returned to that location.

Det. Warmington, Ofc. Hall, Ofc. Gaufillet and I, after struggling with Taylor for several minutes, got him to lay across the back seat of the patrol vehicle. Taylor appeared to be faking an injury, and his actions were not consistent with the injuries. Taylor began kicking and extending his legs so that Officer Hall could not close the back door. I reached in and tried to pull Taylor further into the vehicle, however Taylor was yelling and began trying to bite my arm. I felt Taylor's teeth clench on my forearm and quickly pulled my arm away from his mouth. Taylor had bit my hand area and grazed my forearm with his teeth. Det. Warmington and Ofc. Hall got Taylor restrained in the vehicle and Officer Hall left the area.

Taylor did not break the skin on my arm or hand, however noticeable red teeth marks were visible and photographed. Both Taylor and Cartwright were transported to the Lower Keys Medical Center where they were medically cleared and subsequently transported to the Monroe County Detention Center for processing. All evidence was placed in the KWPD Property Section by Det. S. Warmington. A total of \$922.00 in US currency was removed from Cartwright's possession and seized under the FL contraband act. The denominations and manner in which the money was contained was consistent with street level narcotics sales. I will be seeking a search warrant for Cartwright's phone to further support evidence of narcotics sales. The incident took place at the intersection of Emma Street and Truman Avenue, which is well within 1000 feet of Ft. Village Apartments, a Key West Housing Authority property.




- 1. Battery on a law enforcement officer. Taylor, while being arrested for resisting an officer without violence, layed across the back of the patrol vehicle and would not allow officers to close the door. While pulling Taylor from under his arms, Taylor bit a detective on the hand and forearm. Taylor did so intentionally, with the intent of causing bodily harm to the law enforcement officer. Taylor did so in violation of F.S.S. 784.04(2)(b)
- Resisting an officer without violence, Taylor, despite numerous clear loud verbal commands to stay back from the scene of an existing arrest, continued to draw closer and verbally threaten the officers already engaged in effecting a lawful arrest. Taylor ignored officer's commands and presented an imminent risk to officer safety. Taylor did so in violation of F.S.S. 843.02


