A RESOLUTION OF THE CAROLINE STREET CORRIDOR AND BAHAMA VILLAGE COMMUNITY REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY (CRA) APPROVING A TWO-YEAR EXTENSION OF THE CONTRACT BETWEEN THE CITY AND FLOWERS CHEMICAL LABORATORIES FOR WATER AND SOIL TESTING AT THE KEY WEST BIGHT IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$28,033.00 PER YEAR; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, in Resolution No. 12-043 the CRA approved the contract for water testing at the Key West Bight, and in Resolution No. 12-034 the City Commission concurrently approved the contract for water testing at the City Marina at Garrison Bight, with an option for a two-year renewal; and

WHEREAS, City staff has determined that the vendor has rendered services as required, and recommends exercising the renewal option for a period of two years.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CAROLINE STREET CORRIDOR AND BAHAMA VILLAGE COMMUNITY REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the option for a two-year renewal of the water and soil testing contract for the Key West Bight, approved in CRA resolution No. 12-043 and concurrent City Commission Resolution No. 12-034, between the City/CRA and Flowers Chemical

Laboratories, is hereby approved in an amount not to exceed
\$28,033.00 per year. (Water testing at the City Marina at Garrison
Bight shall be included in the signed contract at a cost not to
exceed \$9,692.00 per year, as approved in simultaneous City
Commission Resolution No. 15).
Section 2: That this Resolution shall go into effect
immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by
the signature of the presiding officer and the Clerk of the Agency.
