A RESOLUTION OF THE CAROLINE STREET CORRIDOR AND BAHAMA VILLAGE COMMUNITY REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY (CRA) APPROVING THE ATTACHED FIRST AMENDMENT TO LEASE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CRA AND FURY MANAGEMENT, INC. FOR THE BOOTH LOCATED AT THE CORNER OF ELIZABETH STREET AND GREENE STREET IN THE HISTORIC SEAPORT; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE
