A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, TERMINATING THE INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT APPROVED IN RESOLUTION 14-018 BETWEEN MONROE COUNTY AND THE CITY OF KEY WEST FOR THE USE OF A PORTION OF A GEOGRAPHIC INFORMATION SYSTEM (GIS); PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, in Resolution 14-048, on March 19, 2014, the City Commission approved an Interlocal Agreement (ILA) with the Monroe County Growth Management Department for a GIS system provided by ESRI, to query, analyze, and map data; and

WHEREAS, City Staff later learned that Monroe County's Enterprise License Agreement (ELA) cannot be utilized by the City of Key West per the agreement Monroe County has with ESRI; and

WHEREAS, in Resolution No. 14-340, on November 18, 2014, the City Commission approved the purchase of an ESRI enterprise software license for the City of Key West on November 18, 2014, to give City staff the capability to direct connect to the ESRI users database without the need to utilize Monroe County computers and servers.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the attached Interlocal Agreement, authorized in Resolution No. 14-048, between Monroe County and The City of Key West for the use of a portion of a Geographic Information System (GIS), is hereby terminated.

Section 2: That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signature of the Presiding Officer and the Clerk of the Commission.
