A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, DIRECTING THE CITY MANAGER TO PRESENT A PLAN FOR THE DEVELOPMENT OF AFFORDABLE AND WORKFORCE HOUSING AT THE CITY OWNED PROPERTIES ON NORTH STOCK ISLAND PREVIOUSLY UTILIZED BY EASTER SEALS AND OCCUPIED BY THE MOSQUITO CONTROL DISTRICT; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the City Commission recognizes the continued need for affordable and workforce housing in the City of Key West; and

WHEREAS, with appropriate zoning modifications, design and planning, City owned land on North Stock Island may provide available space for the development of affordable and workforce housing.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the City Manager is hereby directed to develop a plan and timeline for the development of workforce and affordable housing on the City owned properties on North Stock Island previously utilized by Easter Seals and occupied by the Mosquito Control District.

Section 2: That City Manager and City Attorney are
directed to bring forth any necessary legislation to facilitate
infill affordable and workforce housing at this location.
Section 3: That this Resolution shall go into effect
immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the
signature of the Presiding Officer and the Clerk of the Commission.
