The second thing is this is really your chance to accurately describe what happened without feeling like someone is your enemy or out to get you because the Citizen Review Board is looking at this not taking any sides. We're not trying to protect anyone. We're not trying to go after anyone. We're just trying to get whatever factual information that we can get to make sure that the board, the Citizen Review Board, has all the facts when they ultimately review this situation independent of the police department and independent of State Attorney's Office.</p> <p>So you should feel comfortable to be forthright in answering any questions I have because the more information that we have, the better it is for the Citizen Review Board to make a decision that's based on all of the information. Okay?</p> <p><b>A</b> Yes.</p> <p><b>Q</b> And you understand you're under oath?</p> <p><b>A</b> Yes.</p> <p><b>Q</b> Which means that you have to tell the truth.</p>



<p>5</p> <p>1 A Yes.</p> <p>2 Q Please don't guess. You know, if I ask you a</p> <p>3 question and you don't know the answer, just say, "I</p> <p>4 don't know." Don't try to make up an answer because</p> <p>5 that's always dangerous. And I realize this happened a</p> <p>6 few years ago and things may not be as clear in your</p> <p>7 mind today as they may have been then. So don't guess</p> <p>8 at what you think it was if you don't know.</p> <p>9 A Yes.</p> <p>10 Q Now let's get a little bit of background. Why</p> <p>11 don't you tell me a little bit about yourself; where you</p> <p>12 grew up; how long you have lived in Key West; how old</p> <p>13 you are. Just give me a little bit of background.</p> <p>14 A Well, I'm from Haiti. I came to the U.S. when</p> <p>15 I was, I believe, 11. I've been in Key West, Florida,</p> <p>16 since I was 11, and I'm 26 now.</p> <p>17 Q Do you have -- did you complete school in</p> <p>18 Haiti?</p> <p>19 A No. I did middle school and high school here.</p> <p>20 Q So you completed high school here in Key West?</p> <p>21 A Yes.</p> <p>22 Q Did you graduate from Key West High School?</p> <p>23 A No, I did not. I got a GED.</p> <p>24 Q Do you have family here?</p> <p>25 A I have, yeah, my mom, my brothers and my</p>	<p>7</p> <p>1 A 320 Angela Street, Apartment 5-A.</p> <p>2 Q I want to go back to the day that this taser</p> <p>3 event occurred in April of 2011.</p> <p>4 A Yes.</p> <p>5 Q And I want to kind of find out what the</p> <p>6 situation was then. Okay. Mr. Murphy, on that day how</p> <p>7 long had you known that gentlemen?</p> <p>8 A I knew him since 2008.</p> <p>9 Q And how did you meet him?</p> <p>10 A He was living in Key West for a little bit and</p> <p>11 then I think he had lost his job and then he moved back</p> <p>12 to West Virginia. I met him in Key West. He was living</p> <p>13 here.</p> <p>14 Q You met him sometime in 2008, you believe?</p> <p>15 A Yeah.</p> <p>16 Q And then he lost his job and went to West</p> <p>17 Virginia?</p> <p>18 A Yeah. Couple, maybe couple of months later,</p> <p>19 maybe five or six months after we met, you know, he lost</p> <p>20 his job. One of his friends that he was living with</p> <p>21 died. So the place that he was living with got</p> <p>22 foreclosed and he moved back home.</p> <p>23 Q Now did he come back to Key West?</p> <p>24 A Well, he was coming back and forth to see me.</p> <p>25 And then 2009 he asked me to move to West Virginia with</p>
<p>6</p> <p>1 sister.</p> <p>2 Q What is your mother's name?</p> <p>3 A Her name is Marie Larmecie Ysme.</p> <p>4 Q How do you spell that, please?</p> <p>5 A The middle name?</p> <p>6 Q All of it.</p> <p>7 A Well, it's L-a-r-m-e-c-i-e, like Larmecie. And</p> <p>8 Ysme is Y-s-m-e.</p> <p>9 Q And that's your mom's name?</p> <p>10 A That's my mom's name.</p> <p>11 Q And what's your brothers' names?</p> <p>12 A My brothers' names -- I have three brothers.</p> <p>13 Q Do they all three live in Key West?</p> <p>14 A No. Only one of them is living in Key West.</p> <p>15 Q And what is his name?</p> <p>16 A Kin, K-i-n.</p> <p>17 Q K-i-n, and what's his last name?</p> <p>18 A Annulyse.</p> <p>19 Q Okay. Do you have currently any employment?</p> <p>20 A Yes, I do.</p> <p>21 Q And where do you work?</p> <p>22 A I work at the Lighthouse Court Hotel.</p> <p>23 Q About how long have you worked there?</p> <p>24 A About three years.</p> <p>25 Q And what is your current address?</p>	<p>8</p> <p>1 him and I did that and then, you know, he proposed and</p> <p>2 everything, asked my mom for me and everything like</p> <p>3 that.</p> <p>4 Q Where in West Virginia?</p> <p>5 A Huntington. Huntington, West Virginia, but his</p> <p>6 family lives in Barboursville.</p> <p>7 Q In where?</p> <p>8 A Barboursville.</p> <p>9 Q Barboursville, West Virginia?</p> <p>10 A Yes.</p> <p>11 Q When you went up there, did you begin living</p> <p>12 with him?</p> <p>13 A Yeah, we were living together.</p> <p>14 Q Were you living in a house or an apartment that</p> <p>15 he had?</p> <p>16 A It was a house that we were leasing.</p> <p>17 Q And about how long did you live up in West</p> <p>18 Virginia with Mr. Murphy?</p> <p>19 A Well, got pregnant with my son, Kaeden, and he</p> <p>20 was working a lot. Like he would go to work all week</p> <p>21 and then come on the weekends and stuff. So I would say</p> <p>22 it was about like four months after I went back home.</p> <p>23 Q Why did you move back home?</p> <p>24 A Just missing Key West. I was missing home,</p> <p>25 missing my family, and he was always away at work.</p>

What was his job?</p> <p>2 A He was working with the union, like -- I'm not</p> <p>3 real sure.</p> <p>4 Q Was it construction-type work?</p> <p>5 A Yeah. Not construction but like -- what do</p> <p>6 they call it? Not in mines, not the mines, but like he</p> <p>7 would go work -- I can't remember, but he would leave</p> <p>8 for all week. Maybe his dad, his dad know because his</p> <p>9 dad got him that job.</p> <p>10 Q Now do you know what year it was that you moved</p> <p>11 back to Key West from West Virginia?</p> <p>12 A It was about say 2010.</p> <p>13 Q And he stayed up there? He, Mr. Murphy.</p> <p>14 A Yeah, he stayed up there for a little bit and</p> <p>15 then I came here, had my baby.</p> <p>16 Q When was your child born?</p> <p>17 A He was born November 11th -- November 14, 2010.</p> <p>18 Q When you came back, he did not come back with</p> <p>19 you at that time?</p> <p>20 A No.</p> <p>21 Q Where were you living then?</p> <p>22 A I was living with my mom, went back to my mom.</p> <p>23 Q Now once you were back to Key West, did you</p> <p>24 ultimately go to work again or did you just stay home</p> <p>25 with your child?</p>	<p style="text-align: right;">11</p> <p>1 A Yes.</p> <p>2 Q And what was that date?</p> <p>3 A It was going to be like May-ish.</p> <p>4 Q Of what year?</p> <p>5 A 2011.</p> <p>6 Q To your knowledge had he ever been in any</p> <p>7 trouble with the law?</p> <p>8 A Well, from what he told me, I know that he was</p> <p>9 arrested down here for driving without a license or</p> <p>10 something, but not to my knowledge that he was arrested</p> <p>11 or convicted of anything.</p> <p>12 Q And what about you, have you had any run-ins</p> <p>13 with the law?</p> <p>14 A No.</p> <p>15 Q Now I want to go back to the day that this</p> <p>16 happened. This happened early in the morning on the</p> <p>17 11th, correct, or the 10th?</p> <p>18 A April 16th.</p> <p>19 Q April 16th. You're right. I'm sorry. It was</p> <p>20 April 16th?</p> <p>21 A Yeah. Around like 3:40-ish in the morning.</p> <p>22 Q I want to go back, okay, before the incident.</p> <p>23 Tell me what you all had been doing; you all being you</p> <p>24 and your husband, your soon-to-be husband, Mr. Murphy.</p> <p>25 What were you all doing prior to this incident?</p>
<p style="text-align: right;">10</p> <p>1 A I just stayed home because I was really</p> <p>2 pregnant.</p> <p>3 Q Now with respect to Mr. Murphy, while you're</p> <p>4 down here, did he come visit you from time to time when</p> <p>5 you were down here?</p> <p>6 A Yeah. He was working. He was sending me money</p> <p>7 and stuff. So that's why I was able to not work and</p> <p>8 just continue.</p> <p>9 Q Did he come down from time to time to see you?</p> <p>10 A While I was pregnant, no. After I give birth</p> <p>11 he came down.</p> <p>12 Q Now did there come a time when he moved back to</p> <p>13 Key West?</p> <p>14 A Yes.</p> <p>15 Q When was that?</p> <p>16 A I'll say like 2011 he went back, yes.</p> <p>17 Q And did he find employment down here?</p> <p>18 A Yes, he did.</p> <p>19 Q Where was he working?</p> <p>20 A He worked at Daddy Bones for a little bit doing</p> <p>21 delivery. And then he worked at the Sandal Factory for</p> <p>22 a little bit. And then he found line cook at the Salute</p> <p>23 with Richard.</p> <p>24 Q And had the two of you set the date to be</p> <p>25 married?</p>	<p style="text-align: right;">12</p> <p>1 A Well, it was his friend's birthday.</p> <p>2 Q Who is his friend?</p> <p>3 A Some guy that he was working with at Salute.</p> <p>4 Q Do you know his first name, last name, or</p> <p>5 anything?</p> <p>6 A No. All I knew is that he was working in the</p> <p>7 kitchen with him.</p> <p>8 Q At Salute?</p> <p>9 A Salute, yeah.</p> <p>10 Q This gentleman, whose birthday it was, worked</p> <p>11 at Salute?</p> <p>12 A Yes.</p> <p>13 Q If you saw him again would you recognize him?</p> <p>14 A Yes.</p> <p>15 Q So it was his birthday?</p> <p>16 A It was his birthday. So he invited me and Matt</p> <p>17 -- he invited Matt out. He was supposed to go out that</p> <p>18 Saturday. So Matt was like, "You know what?" Because</p> <p>19 he was going on both days. So Matt say, "I feel like</p> <p>20 something is going to happen. Let's just go out today</p> <p>21 and then we're going to stay in Saturday."</p> <p>22 Q This was Friday night?</p> <p>23 A Yes.</p> <p>24 Q What do you think he meant by "I feel like</p> <p>25 something is going to happen"?</p>

I was like, "Okay, we can just stay home</p> <p>3 Saturday."</p> <p>4 Q So Matt decided to do the party on Friday with</p> <p>5 his friend?</p> <p>6 A Yeah.</p> <p>7 Q And you went along?</p> <p>8 A Yeah.</p> <p>9 Q And where was his party?</p> <p>10 A Well, everybody was at Lazy Gecko.</p> <p>11 Q Who is everybody?</p> <p>12 A Him and the co-worker, and then I had some of</p> <p>13 my friends with me that, you know, they drove downtown.</p> <p>14 We walked to Duval Street.</p> <p>15 Q At that time -- I didn't ask you this, but at</p> <p>16 that time were you and Matt living together or were you</p> <p>17 living separate?</p> <p>18 A We were living together.</p> <p>19 Q And was that at the Angela Street address?</p> <p>20 A Yes.</p> <p>21 Q So you and Matt walked to the Lazy Gecko?</p> <p>22 A Yes.</p> <p>23 Q About what time did the party start?</p> <p>24 A Like 12:00-ish.</p> <p>25 Q So it was a late start?</p>	<p>15</p> <p>1 didn't know what he was doing?</p> <p>2 A He always say, "I'm Irish," you know. He</p> <p>3 doesn't -- no, he doesn't drink too much.</p> <p>4 Q How about you, are you okay with handling</p> <p>5 alcohol?</p> <p>6 A Yeah. And, plus, I was breastfeeding. So I</p> <p>7 wasn't drinking too much and stuff.</p> <p>8 Q So you're at the Lazy Gecko. The party starts</p> <p>9 around midnight?</p> <p>10 A Uh-huh.</p> <p>11 Q Right?</p> <p>12 A Yeah.</p> <p>13 Q And then when did the party start ending?</p> <p>14 A Well, everybody started leaving around like</p> <p>15 3:00-ish and we started just walking back home.</p> <p>16 Q When you left the party, tell me who you were</p> <p>17 with and what direction you were heading.</p> <p>18 A Okay. Well, it was just me and Matt walking,</p> <p>19 but then as we were walking we met -- he saw one of his</p> <p>20 friends that he used to work at Daddy Bones with. I</p> <p>21 don't know his name or nothing like that. He's</p> <p>22 Caucasian male. So we started walking.</p> <p>23 As we got right by the little stairway the</p> <p>24 accident happened, this couple --</p> <p>25 Q I want to go back a little. So you and Matt</p>
<p>14</p> <p>1 A Yeah.</p> <p>2 Q What had you been doing before the party</p> <p>3 started, you and/or Matt? What had you been doing?</p> <p>4 Were you downtown --</p> <p>5 A Yeah.</p> <p>6 Q -- doing other things?</p> <p>7 A Yeah, we were just walking around and stuff,</p> <p>8 walking Duval Street like we all do, you know.</p> <p>9 Q When do you think it was approximately that you</p> <p>10 first got to Duval Street that evening?</p> <p>11 A I would say around 11:00-ish.</p> <p>12 Q And did you go straight to the Lazy Gecko or</p> <p>13 did you just walk around or did you go to a night club,</p> <p>14 to a bar?</p> <p>15 A We went walking around and then we went to Lazy</p> <p>16 Gecko.</p> <p>17 Q And do you drink alcohol?</p> <p>18 A Yes.</p> <p>19 Q And what about Matt, did he drink alcohol?</p> <p>20 A Yes.</p> <p>21 Q From your knowledge of Matt, did you have any</p> <p>22 feeling that he had any difficulties dealing with</p> <p>23 alcohol?</p> <p>24 A No.</p> <p>25 Q You never saw him inebriated to the point he</p>	<p>16</p> <p>1 leave the party, just you two?</p> <p>2 A Just us two.</p> <p>3 Q And then you bump into this fellow that used to</p> <p>4 work at Daddy Bones with Matt?</p> <p>5 A Yeah. They were friends.</p> <p>6 Q And is this the same fellow -- no, Salute is</p> <p>7 the other fellow?</p> <p>8 A Yeah. He's a black guy.</p> <p>9 Q The guy at Salute is a black gentleman?</p> <p>10 A Yes.</p> <p>11 Q And then the fellow from Daddy Bones is a white</p> <p>12 gentleman?</p> <p>13 A Yes.</p> <p>14 Q You don't know this person's name either?</p> <p>15 A No.</p> <p>16 Q Do you know anyone who knows him?</p> <p>17 A Well, not that I know of. No.</p> <p>18 Q But you're pretty confident he worked at Daddy</p> <p>19 Bones?</p> <p>20 A Yes. Because after the accident happened, I</p> <p>21 went to Daddy Bones and I spoke with him.</p> <p>22 Q Do you know where he is today?</p> <p>23 A No, I don't.</p> <p>24 Q Daddy Bones is either out of business or on the</p> <p>25 verge?</p>

1 **A Yeah. I know that he had went to jail for**  
2 **violation of probation soon after that thing, that**  
3 **incident happened. So if I see his picture I would**  
4 **definitely recognize him because I went and spoke to**  
5 **him.**  
6 **Q** So this fellow -- so now there's three people  
7 walking down Duval Street, you and Matt and this fellow  
8 from Daddy Bones?  
9 **A Yes.**  
10 **Q** And I gather you all are heading south on  
11 Duval?  
12 **A Yes.**

14 Let me make it easy. Was it on the Hard Rock  
15 side or the Grand Cafe side of Duval, or does that make  
16 it difficult for you?  
17 **A Across Wendy's.**  
18 **Q** It was on the Wendy's side?  
19 **A No. The other side.**  
20 **Q** Okay. So you were on the west side of Duval  
21 with Wendy's being on the east side?  
22 **A Yes. If I'm walking down I'm on the left side.**  
23 **Q** And you're heading south?  
24 **A Yes.**  
25 **Q** Did you stop at any bars or anything?

1 **A No, walking home. He was talking to his friend**  
2 **and they were just talking about work.**  
3 **Q** What was Matt -- how would you describe his  
4 level of intoxication, if at all?  
5 **A I mean, you wouldn't think that he was that --**  
6 **he was intoxicated.**  
7 **Q** Did he drink any alcohol at the party?  
8 **A Yes, he did.**  
9 **Q** What was he drinking?  
10 **A I know that he had like a shot of Padron and**  
11 **then like two cocktails because we weren't, we didn't**  
12 **have money like that to spend, so we were watching our**  
13 **budget.**  
14 **Q** Now you're heading down Duval Street with this  
15 Daddy Bones fellow and I gather you get to Caroline  
16 Street, right, which is where Bull & Whistle is?  
17 **A We pass Caroline Street.**  
18 **Q** Now you go past Grand Cafe on the right?  
19 **A Uh-huh.**  
20 **Q** And did something happen about the time that  
21 you got past Grand Cafe on Duval Street?  
22 **A Yeah. The couple that was sitting on the**  
23 **steps, it was right in front of a clothing store, they**  
24 **stopped Matt. Matt, you know --**  
25 **Q** Let me stop you for a second. On that side of

1 Duval you have got the Women's Club, right, that big red  
2 brick building as you are going towards Wendy's. Had  
3 you passed it?  
4 **A Yes, we had passed it.**  
5 **Q** Then there is a cigar store?  
6 **A Across the cigar store.**  
7 **Q** So you were across the street near where the  
8 Southern Cross Hotel is?  
9 **A Yes, a little bit -- like here's Southern Cross**  
10 **and then here's the steps, right there (indicating).**  
11 **Q** There's one of these Duval Street businesses  
12 there that sells bathing suits and stuff?  
13 **A We were past that one. So here's the bathing**  
14 **suit shop, here's Southern Cross entranceway and then**  
15 **here's the steps, right there (indicating).**  
16 **Q** There were some people sitting there?  
17 **A Yes.**  
18 **Q** And I gather at that time in the morning there  
19 weren't a whole lot of people on Duval Street?  
20 **A Yeah, there was people walking home and stuff.**  
21 **It was mostly more people across the street walking.**  
22 **Q** So you all come in contact with these two  
23 people. Tell me what happened. Is it a man and a woman  
24 sitting there?  
25 **A A man and a woman and the lady was holding a**

1 **little dog, a dog. And I wasn't watching. I was**  
2 **just -- we wanted to go home.**  
3 **Q** Did you know those people at all?  
4 **A No.**  
5 **Q** So what happened?  
6 **A The guy stopped Matt and asked Matt for**  
7 **something, because Matt went towards him and, you know,**  
8 **they said something. Like he -- it's 3:00-something in**  
9 **the morning. He stopped him. He was asking him for**  
10 **something. So then when I saw Matt stop, I say, "Come**  
11 **on, Matt. Let's go. Let's go. Like forget about these**  
12 **people. Let's go."**  
13 **As he's walking away, I hear the lady say,**  
14 **"Nigger lover."**  
15 **I'm like -- I'm like, "Is this a prank or**  
16 **something? Like what the hell is going on?"**  
17 **And then we thought like, "You guys are so**  
18 **ignorant."**  
19 **We started arguing like this is ignorant. And**  
20 **there was two black guys that was walking on the street.**  
21 **Like here we are and they were walking on the street**  
22 **(indicating). But they stopped -- when they hear**  
23 **"nigger lover," they stop. They're like, "Whoa,"**  
24 **listening to what's going on, too. Everybody was just**  
25 **arguing, arguing, arguing.**

And then we got him across the  4 street where like -- not Earthbound Trading -- but the  5 store that's next to it, like Chico's or something, got  6 him across the street and then I hear, "That's how you  7 make monkey babies." And then Matt just kind of like --  8 Q Let me see if I understand what you said.
