

An application was received for the removal of (3) Mahogany trees, (1) Green Buttonwood tree, and (1) Gumbo Limbo tree. A site inspection was done on February 11, 2015 and documented the following:

1. Tree Species: Mahogany (Swietenia mahagoni)







Explanation of request for tree removal

We had Cynthia from Cynthia's Blue Palms come to treat a tree for termites. She discovered problems with many more trees and recommended removal. I then had Nick from A Caring Tree Service Company come for an estimate, and he agreed with Cynthia.

I would like to go tree by tree. Please see sketch for reference.

Tree 1) Gumbo Limbo in the front yard next to my driveway. This tree was cut by Keys Energy approx. 1 year ago due to encroachment into power lines. They chopped it so low it had no leaves after cutting. Cynthia recommended removal because 1) the cutting by Keys Energy is now going to require major maintenance to maintain the integrity of the tree. 2) the root system is buckling up the sidewalk, as well as, my driveway.

Tree 2) Buttonwood in the front comer of front yard. This tree is literally within a foot of the sewer line coming from my house, to the road. It's only a matter of time before the roots grow through the sewer line. It's also buckling up the sidewalk, as well as, my neighbors driveway.

Tree 3) Mahogany in the front yard. This tree is full of wood borers. It's also growing at an angle and competing for sun with my neighbors poinciana. The integrity of this tree is compromised.

Tree 4) Mahogany in the back corner of my yard. This tree also has wood borers and is directly on the property line. Was poorly cut and is unhealthy and compromised.

Tree 5) Large mahogany in my back yard. Again, wood borers and possible termites. I'm very scared that this tree will come down on my home. Our bedrooms are in the back and I'm worried about harm to my family when it comes down.

We would very much like to start over in the back yard especially.
