A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE KEY WEST, FLORIDA, SUPPORTING OF FLORIDA SENATE BILL 156 AND SUPPORTING FLORIDA HOUSE BILL 33, CREATING THE "FLORIDA COMPETITIVE WORKFORCE ACT," TO SECURE FOR ALL INDIVIDUALS IN THE STATE FREEDOM FROM DISCRIMINATION BECAUSE OF OR BASED ON THE PERCEPTION OF RACE, COLOR, RELIGION, SEX, NATIONAL ORIGIN, AGE, SEXUAL ORIENTATION, GENDER IDENTITY OR EXPRESSION, HANDICAP, OR MARITAL STATUS; AUTHORIZING THE CITY CLERK TRANSMIT CERTIFIED COPIES OF RESOLUTION; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the Florida Senate is considering Senate Bill 156, and the Florida House is considering House Bill 33, which, if passed, would expand civil rights protections to prohibit discrimination because of or based on the perception of sexual orientation, gender identity or expression; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the Key West City Commission supports SB 156, and HB 33 and urges its legislators to support such measures.

Section 2: That the City Clerk is hereby authorized to
transmit a certified copy of this Resolution to Representative
Raschein, Senator Bullard, Governor Rick Scott and members of
the House and Senate leadership.
Section 3: That this Resolution shall go into effect
immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by
the signature of the Presiding Officer and the Clerk of the
Commission.
