A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING KEY WEST CULTURAL PRESERVATION SOCIETY, INC. TO CONDUCT A FIVE-DAY MARITIME HISTORY-THEMED FESTIVAL FEATURING TWO CLASS A HISTORIC SAILING TALL SHIPS AT MALLORY SQUARE DOCK & PLAZA ON MAY 28 THROUGH JUNE 1, 2015, FROM 10:00 A.M. TO 10:00 P.M., AND THE USE OF THE EAST QUAY WALL FOR DOCKAGE SPACE FOR THE HISTORIC SHIPS; PURSUANT TO TERMS AND CONDITIONS SET FORTH BY THE CITY MANAGER; AUTHORIZING THE SALE AND CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES WITHIN AN ENCLOSED AREA; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECITVE DATE

WHEREAS, Key West Cultural Preservation Society, Inc. wishes to conduct an event at Mallory Square Dock & Plaza & the East Quay Wall between the hours of 10:00 a.m. and 10:00 p.m. on May 28 through June 1, 2015; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Commission of the City of Key West, Florida;

SECTION 1. That the Key West Cultural Preservation Society, Inc. is hereby granted permission to conduct a Five Day Maritime History-themed Festival on the date and during the hours stated above; PROVIDED all trash is adequately collected and contained; guarantee indemnifying the City is executed; and provided the organizations meet the terms and conditions set forth by the City Manager.

SECTION 2. That pursuant to City of Key West Code of Ordinances, Section 18-86, the consumption of alcoholic beverages is permitted within the barricaded areas of the event.

**SECTION 3.** Use of the City owned East Quay is subject to the Navy granting access across the restricted Truman Annex Harbor.

SECTION 4. That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its
