

An application was received for the removal **of (1) Gumbo Limbo tree**. A site inspection was done on December 18, 2014 and documented the following:

Tree Species: Gumbo Limbo (Bursera simaruba)













Diameter: 22" Location: 70%

Species: 100% (on protected tree list)

Condition: 60% (fair)

Total Average Value = 76%

Value x Diameter = 16.7 replacement caliper inches

NOTES: This property just received a landscape plan for redevelopment of the property. This gumbo limbo was included in the plan to be preserved. A recent bug inspection by Keys Pest Control indicated that a gumbo limbo tree and a Royal Poinciana tree were found to be infested with Subterranean termites. The Royal Poinciana tree received approval for removal as per the approved landscape plan so a permit was issued for its removal (T14-7203). Additional information was requested from Keys Pest Control regarding the termites in the gumbo limbo.

UPDATE - March 26, 2015: Keys Pest Control submitted a letter and a map showing the referenced gumbo limbo tree as being infested with termites. No photos of termite infestation were submitted. A re-inspection of the tree did not show any obvious signs of termites.







Bark appears to be solid and healthy. No obvious holes in bark or decay areas.

Scott and John:

In November I received an application to remove and heavy maintenance some trees at Marty's Place—Bertha/Venetia/Dennis Streets. At the time I had questions and sent an e-mail to both Sandra and John regarding the application and the location of the trees. On December 10, 2014, I received a call from Sandra Downs (Tarzan Tree Care) that the two trees requesting removal had been flagged. Today I went and looked at the trees.

A request is being made to remove the Royal Poinciana tree next to 1519 Bertha St (tree #2 on attached map). This tree has already been to the Tree Commission and has received authorization to be removed (see attached copy of landscape plan letter). I can issue a permit to remove that tree fairly quickly.

A request is also being made to remove a Gumbo Limbo tree currently located in front of 1517 and 1519 Bertha St along the walkway. As part of the Final Landscape plan authorized in October 2014 by the Tree Commission, this tree was to remain. Therefore, if a request is now being made to remove this tree, an application must be processed in front of the Tree Commission. The next meeting is January 13, 2015. I have the application you submitted to remove 2 gumbo limbo trees at the Marty's Place complex and to heavy maintenance trim the Royal Poinciana tree. I need additional information before I can process the application.

- 1. Please flag the trees that are to be removed. I can not tell from the application where the trees are located. As you may know, I have mapped all of the vegetation on the entire property for the Development Plan and Landscape Plan that was recently processed for the property. I need to verify whether these trees are on the plan to be removed or whether they were to remain.
- 2. The application states removal of 2 gumbo limbos and heavy maintenance trim 1 Royal Poinciana but the letter from Keys Pest Control states that 1 gumbo and 1 Royal Poinciana had termites. Please correct and clarify. Also, I need additional information regarding the termite infestation—photos of the trees with the termite issue. I looked at the Royal Poinciana and did not see any evidence of termites like I do in other trees around town.

Once I receive the additional information, I will inspect and determine the proper way to process the permit application.
