## I. Key West Bight Operations:

- Purchase order issued for window placement in Harborwalk Tenants Showers and Laundry. Contractor ordering windows
- Air conditioning units approved for Harborwalk Tenants Showers and Laundry awaiting installation of windows to complete.
- Sidewalk along Sebago office on Lazy Way installed.
- RFP for property wide CCTV surveillance system received April 8<sup>th</sup>. Ranking committee to rank proposals and submit recommendation to Bight Board.
- Working with Turtle Kraals staff to eliminate standing water at back of building.
- Working on adding additional bicycle parking throughout the seaport.
- Working with Engineering Services Department to prepare an ITB for piling replacement and D-dock repair.
- Preliminary survey received for BO's Fish Wagon.
- Staff placing new stone in planters throughout Seaport property.

## **Key West Bight Marina:**

- March fuel sales at the Ferry Terminal the Yankee Freedom average 646 gallons per day for a profit of \$5,003.00 and the Key West Express average 1,805 gallons per day for a profit of \$13,538.25.
- The Marina is having the second annual Viking Key West Challenge from April 8<sup>th</sup> to the 12<sup>th</sup> at this time we have 9 yachts ranging from 66ft to 82 ft.
- CheckRequ The Marina is having the first Princess yachts Owners Holiday from April 16<sup>th</sup> to the 19<sup>th</sup> the marina has 15 vessels at this time. Requested Transient Dockage For this March were up 6 % percent from last March.
- Transient Dockage for February was up 18% percent from last February.
