ARTICLE XIII. - COSMETICS

Sec. 18-701. - Definitions.

The following words, terms and phrases, when used in this article, shall have the meanings ascribed to them in this section, except where the context clearly indicates a different meaning:

*(Coding: Added language is underlined; deleted language is struck through.)

Cosmetic retailer means any business, <u>person or firm</u> that offers for sale cosmetic products in an amount over \$75.00 U.S. Dollars, or who offers cosmetic product samples wherein said samples are applied on customers in any form, with or without an associated fee. <u>The cosmetic retailer and his, her or its employees and agents also constitute the "permit holder" hereunder.</u>

Customer means any person entering upon the business premises of or engaging in discussion with a cosmetic retailer for the purpose of inquiring about cosmetics offered for sale, sampling, or negotiating a purchase, or actual purchasing cosmetics held for sale by a cosmetics retailer.

Historic district shall mean all property located within the following zoning districts of Key West: HRO, HRCC-1, HRCC-2, HRCC-3, HRCC-4, HMDR, HHDR, HNC-1, HNC-2, HNC-3, HCT, HCL, HPS, HPS-1 and HPRD.

Permit holder means cosmetics retailer.
