A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, VOIDING REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS (RFP) NO. 04-015: CODE COMPLIANCE SPECIAL MAGISTRATE; DIRECTING AN EVALUATION COMMITTEE BE CONVENED FOR RECOMMENDATIONS TO THE CITY COMMISSION; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the City issued a request for Proposals for a Code Compliance Special Magistrate, capable of providing services set forth in RFP No. 04-015; and

WHEREAS, on March 3, 2015, and March 17, 2015 the City Commission considered awarding the RFP; and

WHEREAS, on March 17, 2015, a City Commission member disclosed a violation of the "Cone of Silence" prohibiting oral communications between members of the Commission and those seeking the award of an RFP, such as the one at issue; and

WHEREAS, the City Attorney's office received a complaint concerning the violation and found an violation to have occurred; and

WHEREAS, during the City Attorney's report at the April 7, 2015 City Commission meeting, the Commission agreed the process should start again and RFP 04-015 be invalidated.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That RFP 04-015 is void in accordance with City of Key West Code of Ordinances section 2-773(e) and 2-834.

Section 2: That City staff shall convene an evaluation committee for the purpose of making recommendations concerning the award of a newly issued RFP for special magistrate services to the City Commission.

Section 3: That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signature of the Presiding Officer and the Clerk of the Commission.
