A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, APPROVING FY 2014-15 BUDGET AMENDMENTS FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF THE NEW CITY HALL AT GLYNN ARCHER SCHOOL (PROJECT GN1302) IN AN AMOUNT TOTALLING \$1,638,660.00; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the City Commission finds that construction of City
Hall at Glynn Archer will serve a public purpose and directly
benefit the residents of the City of Key West; and

WHEREAS, in Resolution No. 14-348, the City Commission accepted the proposal and authorized a contract for the construction of City Hall by Burke Construction Group, Inc., at a cost in excess of the funds budgeted; and

WHEREAS, budget amendments are necessary in order to complete the project; and

WHEREAS, on April 15, 2015, the Key West Bight Management District Board recommended approval of a transfer of \$1,300,000.00 from Bight Reserve funds to construction of the new City Hall;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That budget transfers are approved to fund the construction of the new City Hall at Glynn Archer School (Project GN1302), in a total of \$1,638,660.00 as follows: from Fort Street

Parking Lot Construction 101-4303-543-6300/TR1201 in the amount of \$53,187.00, from Key West Bight operating reserves 405-7501-575-9803 in the amount of \$1,300,000.00, and from the Police Station Roof Replacement Project 101-2101-521-6200/PD1409 in the amount of \$285,473.00. Section 2: That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signature of the Presiding Officer and the Clerk of the Commission.
