A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE EXPENDITURE OF \$5,000.00 IN SUPPORT OF THE KEYS TO BE THE CHANGE PROGRAM IN SUPPORT OF YOUTH LEADERSHIP, EDUCATION AND ACTIVITY PROGRAMS; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the City Commission desires to support and encourage the success of KTBTC with City funds.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1</u>: That Keys to be the Change is hereby awarded the sum of five thousand dollars (\$5,000.00) in support of youth leadership, education and activity programs.

<u>Section 2</u>: That funding for this organization shall be provided from the City Manager's discretionary budget.

<u>Section 3</u>: That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signature of the Presiding Officer and the Clerk of the Commission.
