A RESOLUTION OF THE CAROLINE STREET CORRIDOR AND BAHAMA VILLAGE COMMUNITY REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY (CRA) AWARDING THE BID OF BAZON-COX & ASSOCIATES, INC. FOR THE KEY WEST HISTORIC SEAPORT CCTV SURVEILLANCE SYSTEM (RFP 05-15), IN A TOTAL AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$153,637.97; AUTHORIZING CONTINGENCY Α 10% ALLOWANCE; AUTHORIZING NECESSARY BUDGET TRANSFERS; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT IN CONFORMANCE WITH BID DOCUMENTS; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, on April 8, 2015 two bids were opened in response to RFP #05-015, for Key West Historic Seaport CCTV Surveillance System, and the bid of Bazon-Cox & Associates, Inc. was the sole bid determined to be responsive; and

WHEREAS, the Key West Bight Management District Board approved the bid at its meeting of May 13, 2015; and

WHEREAS, City/CRA staff recommends award of the bid to Bazon-Cox & Associates, Inc..

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CAROLINE STREET CORRIDOR

AND BAHAMA VILLAGE COMMUNITY REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the bid of Bazon-Cox & Associates, Inc. for the Key West Historic Seaport CCTV Surveillance System Project, in a total amount not to exceed \$153,637.97 is hereby awarded in accordance with the terms and conditions contained in the Request for Proposals #05-015 and response thereto.

Section 2: That a contingency allowance of 10% is hereby approved.

Section 3: That necessary budget transfers, including \$30,000.00 from account 405-7504-575-6400 (KB1304 - Lighting), \$9,207.72 from account 405-7505-575-6400 (KB1304 - Lighting) to account 405-7504-575-6400 (KB 1403), for a total amount of \$117,692.72 for the Key West Historic Seaport area; and \$7,245.25 from account 405-7506-575-3400 (Landscaping Services) to account 405-7506-575-6400 for a total amount of \$35,945.25 for the Ferry Terminal portion of the project.

Section 4: That the City Manager, upon consent of the City Attorney, is authorized to execute a contract in substantial conformance with the bid documents on behalf of the CRA/City of Key West:

Section 5: That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signature of the presiding officer and the Clerk of the Agency.
