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Topic SUPPLEMENTAL

On 07/05/2015 at 1932 hours I, (Ofc. J. Tellier) and Ofc. R. Currul were dispatched to 5200 W. College Rd. (Bayshore Manor) in reference to a mentally unstable man on the property. Caller stated that there was a man wearing a green shirt, sitting at a picnic table screaming and hitting himself.

Upon our arrival, I was flagged down by a man in a black SUV. He was pointing to the rear of the property. I parked my patrol car and walked up to the man. He was wearing a blue hat, green t-shirt, blue jeans, blue shoes, and mirrored sunglasses. He was also wearing a medical band on his right wrist from Lower Keys Medical Center. As soon as he saw me he looked away towards the bushes, pretending we weren't there.

I said hello to the man, but he still stared at the bushes. I told the man why we were there and I also told him that we were not going away. I was trying to build a rapport with the man, so Ofc. Currul was staying off to the side as backup. The man looked at me and then smiled. He began performing, what I can only interpret as sign language. He was pointing at me, then the bushes, then the sky. I asked him if he was hearing impaired, could read lips, and was even able to speak but his only response to me was giving me hand gestures. While he was sitting he was rolling his shoulders and stretching his neck (posturing).

I saw the medical band, so I asked him if I could read his name since he didn't want to speak. I approached slowly and he flinched. The name on the band was [redacted] I addressed him as [redacted], still no words only hand gestures.

[redacted] nally spoke saying, "Check your watch, what time is it". I asked him why he was on the property, no answer. I asked him if he wanted to go to the hospital, no answer. Then he started quoting a 1990s rap song to me, "Stop! collaborate and listen".

At this point Ofc. Currul was putting on his rubber gloves. I began to put mine on and [redacted] said, "Make sure those last all day while you're jerkin off!"

I walked up [redacted] attempting to get his date of birth from the medical bracelet so I could run his information on Comm 2. I reached for the bracelet and he flinched. I reached in again, and he bowed his chest and put his arm back in a fighting stance. He was sitting down. At this point we knew we were dealing with a mentally unstable person, who had the possibility of being violent. I signaled to Ofc. Currul it was time to take [redacted] into custody. I grabbed [redacted] left arm and Ofc. Currul grabbed the right. As soon as we touched [redacted] he tensed up his arms, stood up and tried to walk away from us. I tried to get his arm behind his back, but he kept pulling away. I tried to perform a straight arm take down, but Ofc. Currul was still holding on.

At that point I realized that this situation was becoming more violent and we had to gain control of [redacted] I disengaged letting go [redacted] and drew my taser from the holster. Ofc. Currul was still holding onto [redacted] who was trying to run away backwards, pushing at Ofc. Currul.

I deployed my taser with the two probes hitting [redacted] on the upper left thigh and near the knee cap. He immediately stiffened and fell backwards while Ofc. Currul guided him to the ground. As soon as [redacted] was on the ground he grabbed the probe on his upper thigh and yanked on it. I ordered him to stay

down, and Ofc. Currul ordered him to roll over on his stomach. still had his body tensed resisting Ofc. Currul's efforts to roll him over. I got down on one knee and tried to help push onto his belly, but he was using his right arm to brace himself was told that if he didn't roll over and put his hands behind his back, he would be tased again. I tased him a second time while pushing him onto his belly. Once he was on his belly I turned off my taser, holstered it, and got his right arm in a shoulder lock to control him while Ofc. Currul handcuffed him. was still screaming but not trying to stand up. Once he stopped screaming we rolled him onto his side. At that point I turned on my Coban mic even though my patrol car was pointed in the opposite direction.

Ofc. Currul notified dispatch that we needed an ambulance and a supervisor reference to a response to resistance (taser usage). Ofc. M. Hansell arrived on scene to assist. He was helping Ofc. Currul with who was still screaming for his mother.

I gave dispatch the subjects name and date of birth, but they got no return. Later on dispatch informed me the man's name was

was still laying on his side screaming when Rescue arrived on scene. I took pictures of upper body and the taser probe areas. I uploaded the photos to the Coban system. Ofc. M. Hansell pulled out the probes. The probes, the cartridge, the wire, and the Affidts were all placed in a paper bag as evidence and later turned into the property section by me.

Sgt. F. Blasberg arrived on scene so I briefed him as to what happened. was still screaming so the paramedic administered a shot of Haladol to calm him down. was placed on a stretcher and transported to the Emergency Room at Lower Keys Medical Center as a Baker Act.

There were no video cameras in the rear of the property, but there was a woman watching from inside the building. Her name is Mariya Boardman and she is an employee of Bayshore Manor. She told me she was frightened by the man saying, "he looked so strong while he was fighting with you two officer, I can only imagine if he would've come in here and it's just me by myself".

At the time of this report I have no further information on this case. For further information see Ofc. Currul's original report.

	<p>On Sunday 05 July 2015, Ofc J Tellier and I responded to Bay Shore Manor on a report of male subject hitting himself. The male was sitting in the rear of the property wearing jeans and a green shirt.</p> <p>We approached the male and saw a hospital bracelet on his right wrist. We tried to speak to the male, who was ignoring our presence. When he did acknowledge us, he started to first make movements with his hands that resembled some kind of sign language. When he made any sounds, they were moans and growls. We tried to determine if he was hearing or speech impaired. He indicated that he was not by shaking his head "No" when asked about both. He started eventually to speak incomprehensibly and randomly yelled. As we tried to talk to him, Ofc Tellier tried to get close enough to read the bracelet. The male tensed and pulled back while yelling something neither of us could understand.</p> <p>I indicated to Ofc Tellier that I was going to retrieve a pair of gloves. When I returned wearing blue gloves, the male seemed to become frightened. Ofc Tellier put on orange gloves. As Tellier was putting on his gloves, the subject told him to make sure they last all day while he "Jerked off".</p> <p>Ofc Tellier got close enough to examine the bracelet and the subject pulled away and tried to flee from us. We grabbed him and he started to twist around trying to dislodge our grip on his arms. I had his right arm and Ofc Tellier had his left arm. We tried to direct the subject to the ground but were not able</p>

to. He was able to twist away from Tellier but I maintained my grasp on him as he twisted around. He was screaming incomprehensibly still.

I saw Ofc Tellier draw his Taser and moved to keep the subject between me and Ofc Tellier. I did not release my grasp of the subject as Ofc Tellier deployed his Taser. The probes struck the subject on the left thigh and were effective. The subject was able to be directed to the ground. As the cycle ended, the subject located the probes and tried to remove them. Ofc Tellier delivered another cycle from the Taser. We were then able to get the subject to roll onto his chest. I was then able to place handcuffs on him. I called for a supervisor and an ambulance to respond to the scene due to the Taser deployment. We then rolled the subject onto his side.

The subject was still kicking his legs and at this point seemed to be having a psychotic break. I requested an additional officer to respond to help control the male. Ofc M Hansell responded to assist.

Key West Fire arrived and after assessing the male advised that he should be taken to the Emergency before being Baker Acted. They administered calming medication before transporting him to the ER.

Sgt Blasberg arrived shortly before transport.

Ofc Tellier took pictures of the subject and the Taser probes.

I followed the ambulance to the ER. At the ER a Florida ID card was located and the subject was identified as: He was seen by Dr McGrath. Dr McGrath concurred that the subject needed to be Baker Acted. I completed the Baker Act form and stood by while was treated. After he was transferred to Depoo Hospital for Psychiatric Evaluation, I transported him to Depoo.

During transport he was yelling directions to me from the back of the police car. He also seemed to be giving a sermon to someone. He asked his mother for direction and permission to exit the car at Depoo. While walking into Depoo, he recited the credo of The Men In Black while stepping only on white colored tiles.

At initial contact my COBAN was not active due to the microphone being charged. The COBAN shut down at the ER and did not record the entire transport to Depoo. It did record some of the transport after it powered back up.






observed "Frisbee Dave (David Bloom)" yelling at two individuals playing tennis. Bloom was yelling various things, including a rant about the death penalty. Bloom began to advance towards a female tennis player in an aggressive manner. I approached Bloom at this point, and advised him he was under arrest and to put his hands behind his back. Bloom stated, "You are not going to handcuff me". I took ahold of Bloom's left arm and attempted to secure him in handcuffs. Bloom attempted to jerk his arm free and spun around to where he was facing me. I was able to turn Bloom back around and told him, in loud repetitive verbal commands, to stop resisting and place his hands behind his back. Bloom continued to attempt to break free of my grasp and flail his unsecured arm around. I took Bloom to the ground using a straight arm bar take down. Once on the ground Bloom continued to resist my efforts to secure him in handcuffs. Ofc Young assisted me in securing Bloom's right arm. Once secured, Bloom continued to yell random obscenities and gibberish.

I advised Sgt. Wood of the incident and he responded to the scene. I transported Bloom to the MCDC without further incident. Photos were taken of Bloom at the jail.

Bloom did commit a violation of FSS 877.03 Breach of the peace; disorderly conduct by yelling and disturbing the peace and quiet of the patrons of the Bayview Park Tennis Courts.

Bloom did commit a violation of FSS 509.143 resist detention or arrest by refusing to place his hands behind his back when told he was under arrest.
