AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, ADOPTING AN AD VALOREM TAX GENERAL MUNICIPAL MILLAGE RATE FOR FY 2015-2016; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR REPEAL OF INCONSISTENT PROVISIONS; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA:

Section 1*: That the final adopted ad valorem tax general municipal millage rate for FY 2015-2016 is hereby set at 2.6843 mills (\$2.6843 per thousand dollars of assessed property value). The 2015-2016 final adopted millage rate is 3.61 percent more than the 2015-2016 rolled back rate of 2.5908 mills (\$2.5908 per thousand dollars of assessed property value).

Section 2: That this Ordinance is adopted in accordance with Chapter 200.065, Florida Statutes.

Section 3: If any section, provision, clause, phrase, or application of this Ordinance is held invalid or unconstitutional for any reason by any court of competent jurisdiction, the remaining provisions of this Ordinance shall be deemed severable therefrom and shall be construed as reasonable and necessary to achieve the lawful purposes of this Ordinance.
