**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF
KEY WEST, FLORIDA, SPONSORING A MARTIN LUTHER KING
MARCH CELEBRATION ON MONDAY, JANARY 18, 2016 FROM
4:00 P.M. TO 6:00 P.M; AUTHORIZING THE CLOSURE OF CERTAIN
STREETS FOR THE MARCH; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE
DATE**

WHEREAS, the City Commission desires to provide a Martin Luther King March on the date and time herein described.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Commission of the City of Key West Florida;

SECTION 1. That the City of Key West hereby sponsors a Martin Luther King march on Monday, January 18, 2016 between the hours of 4:00 p.m. and 6:00 p.m.

SECTION 2. That all provisions of the Code of Ordinances with respect to a march on the City right-of-way shall be observed.

SECTION 3. That the march will start at the Nelson English Park (King Community Center) on Catherine and Thomas Street, turn right at Amelia Street, head north to Duval Street, turn left on Duval Street and travel down Duval Street turning left on Front Street (west), turning left on Whitehead Street (east), traveling down Whitehead until Catherine Street, turn right ending at Nelson English Park.

SECTION 4. That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signatures of the presiding officer and the Clerk of the Commission.
