SECTION 1. That the United States Coast Guard is hereby granted permission to hold the annual Veterans Day Parade from 4:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. on Wednesday, November 11, 2015. The parade will start on Eaton Street, continue down Duval Street, turn North on Truman Avenue, and conclude at the intersection of Truman Avenue and Jose Marti Drive where there will be a celebration of the Vietnam Living Memorial.

SECTION 2. That pursuant to Section 6-26(c), for cause shown upon the record, a special exception to the requirement of payment for required city services set forth in Section 6-26 (a) is hereby granting, waiving all fees for required city services for Veterans Day Parade.

SECTION 3. That this resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signatures of the presiding officers and clerk of the Commission.
