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Topic SUPPLEMENTAL

On 09/19/2015, I (Officer T. Calvert) responded to a call about a car that was involved in an earlier hit and run crash was being followed outbound on Flagler Avenue.

Officers J. Stockton, M. Pettie had the vehicle pulled over on the 3600 block of Flagler avenue. I arrived moments later. Officer Stockton advised that the driver was experiencing a heart attack and requested rescue. I went to the passenger side of the car and saw the driver sitting in the car motionless but breathing. I unbuckled the driver from the passenger side of the car then went around and put the driver in a bent wrist position to check for responsiveness. The driver responded and pulled away from me. Moments later the driver laid motionless again. We then attempted to began positioning the driver to remove him from the drivers seat. The driver became agitated and resisted Officers Pettie and Rodriguez. The driver was given a TASER drive stun by Officer Pettie and eventually a full TASER deployment during his resistance from Officer Rodriguez. I then saw the driver exit the drivers seat and lay on the ground. An officer ordered the driver to put his hands behind his back, he did, I placed handcuffs on the driver.

Rescue had arrived and began tending to the driver. I went to the passenger side of the car where I had smelled the odor of marijuana when unbuckling the driver. I saw a small brown paper bag which contained a baggie of a green leafy substance and a small piece of wax paper which contained an amber paste like substance on it. There was also two packs of RAW rolling papers in the bag. I collected these items as evidence and secured them in my car.

I completed a tow slip (15-300567) for the drivers car which had front end damage and drivers side rear quarter panel damage consistent with the earlier crash. I field tested the leafy marijuana and the THC (marijuana) paste for THC. Both field tests were positive. The leafy marijuana weighed 4.7 grams, the paste THC weighed 1.8 grams. I submitted the marijuana, THC paste and rolling paper into KWPD Property as evidence. I photographed these items and the field test results. These photos were uploaded into the DPM system.

My COBAN in car recording system and BWC were activated during this encounter and tagged with the crash report number, 0115401489.

	<p>On Saturday 19-September-2015 at around 2315 hours, I (Officer M. Pettee) was on a traffic stop in the 2700 Block of Flagler Ave, when Key West Dispatch advised a suspect from a Hit and Run crash from earlier in the night was outbound on Flagler Ave. The victims of the Hit and Run were behind the suspect, following him outbound on Flagler Ave.</p>	
	<p>Officer J. Stockton stopped the vehicle at the intersection of Flagler Ave and 18th Street. I arrived shortly after and approached the vehicle, which was occupied by a single white male driver, later identified as Michael Feldman. Feldman was sitting in the drivers seat with his head leaned back against the head restraint. Feldman stated he was having heart issues and requested rescue.</p>	
	<p>While waiting for rescue continued attempts to speak to Feldman were met with minor movements and sounds, all while not responding. Feldman was breathing fine and in no apparent distress, other than his verbal statements. Officer Calvert attempted to get a response from Feldman and was met with resistance, however Feldman awoke and became verbally and physically combative. Officer A. Rodriguez and I began giving Feldman verbal commands to get out of the vehicle, to which he refused. I removed my TASER from its holster and turned it on, giving Feldman more commands to exit the vehicle. Feldman still refused. In an attempt to get Feldman to voluntarily comply I asked Feldman if he wanted to be TASED. Feldman responded by telling me to "do it bitch".</p>	
	<p>I removed my TASER Cartridge and drive stunned Feldmans leg after his consistent refusal to comply. The drive stun had no affect, as Feldman pulled back his leg and swept across his lap tell me to "get that shit out of here."</p>	
	<p>Officer A. Rodriguez then deployed his TASER, striking Feldman with the probes. Feldman then complied and exited the vehicle, placing his hands behind his back as directed. Key West Rescue responded to ensure Feldman was uninjured.</p>	
<p>Feldman was arrested by Officer A. Rodriguez.</p>		
<p>I had no further involvement in this case.</p>

	<p>1 On Saturday, September 19, 2015 at approximately 2312 hours, Key West Dispatch advised the suspect vehicle from a Hit and Run crash from earlier in the night was outbound on Flagler Avenue. Key West Dispatch provided a description of the vehicle and a Florida Tag. The vehicle was described as a Black Hyundai Sedan bearing Florida Tag BHCS56. The victims of the Hit and Run were behind the suspect vehicle and were following him outbound on Flagler Avenue.</p>	
	<p>I, Officer J. Stockton, was in the area of Flagler Avenue and 5th Street. I began to travel Eastbound on Flagler Avenue until, I, located the vehicle. The vehicle Key West Dispatch described was traveling Eastbound and I was following it. As I was behind the vehicle, I could smell rubber burning. The left rear tire was flat and the vehicle had damage along the left side. The vehicle also had front end damage. I conducted a traffic stop on the vehicle on the 3600 block of Flagler Avenue.</p>	
	<p>As I approached the driver's side, the white male driver, who was the only occupant of the vehicle, rolled down the window. The white male driver, was later identified as MICHAEL SHANE FELDMAN, DOB 02/23/1982, by his Florida Driver's License. FELDMAN said he believed he was having a heart attack and asked for rescue.</p>	
	<p>I advised Key West Dispatch to have Key West Fire/Rescue respond to the scene to help FELDMAN. FELDMAN then leaned back in the drivers seat and appeared to fall asleep. I asked FELDMAN for his name and if he had any medical conditions, but he would not respond. FELDMAN appeared to be breathing normal.</p>	
	<p>Officer T. Calvert, Officer M. Pettee, and Officer A. Rodriguez arrived on scene as I was speaking to FELDMAN. Officer T. Calvert opened the passenger door and unbuckled FELDMAN's seatbelt in preparation for Key West Fire/Rescue's arrival. Officer T. Calvert attempted to wake FELDMAN, by using a bent wrist pain compliance. FELDMAN woke up, tensed and pulled away from Officer T. Calvert's hold and began yelling. Officer M. Pettee and Officer A. Rodriguez began giving FELDMAN loud verbal commands to exit the vehicle. FELDMAN refused. Officer M. Pettee attempted to drive stun FELDMAN left leg, but FELDMAN pushed Officer M. Pettee's TASER away and said, "get that shit out of here."</p>

I was simultaneously notified by Key West Dispatch that a hit and run was reported by the same vehicle that I was out with. The vehicle I was with was a silver Honda Accord bearing Florida license plate 505QBX.

I met with the vehicle owner, Shelby Griffith, who told me that her vehicle was struck by a black sedan, possibly a Toyota Corolla, on the rear right side of her vehicle before the vehicle fled the scene, east on N. Roosevelt Blvd. Griffith also told me about another vehicle that was involved in the crash that was parked in the plaza next to McDonald's. Ofc. T. Calvert met with the driver of that vehicle, a silver Hyundai Sonota bearing New Jersey license plate G41EKM. The driver of the Hyundai, Mildred Rose, told me her vehicle was struck as she was traveling east on the 3700 block of N. Roosevelt Blvd. while traveling in the outside lane. Rose stated her vehicle was struck on the rear left side which caused her to spin across three lanes of traffic and ended up facing west.

I provided the vehicle information to Key West Dispatch and officers searched the area, unsuccessfully locating the suspect vehicle.

At approximately 2312 hours, I was informed that the victim vehicle driver had located the suspect vehicle and was following it. I noticed Feldman's arm go back into the vehicle despite Ofc. T. Calvert attempting to remove Feldman from the scene. I heard Ofc. T. Calvert state that Feldman was awake and pulling away from him.

Ofc. M. Pettee and I retrieved our TASERS from our holsters and activated them. I gave Feldman loud verbal commands to exit the vehicle and he refused, and requested to have the TASER used on him. I saw Feldman's arms and body tensing as he spoke and he refused to exit the vehicle. Ofc. M. Pettee removed his cartridge from his TASER and attempted to apply a "drive stun" to Feldman's left upper leg. Feldman then pushed both of his hands and arms out towards the TASER and Ofc. M. Ofc. M. Pettee stayed on scene to wait for Arnold's Towing to remove Feldman's vehicle from the scene.

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I attempted to question Feldman and read him the Miranda Warning and he stated he understood, but refused to speak with me.

I issued Feldman a citation for careless driving for sideswiping two vehicles. I also issued Feldman a criminal citation in reference to leaving the scene of a crash with property damage and explained to him that he must appear before the Honorable Judge Miller on October 5, 2015 at 0830 hours at the Key West Courthouse. Feldman expressed his understanding and signed the citation. I provided Feldman with copies of his citations.

I completed the crash report (15-401489).

My vehicle's COBAN did not record the incident but my BWC did.

Feldman was in possession of marijuana, less than 20 grams (4.7g), which is a violation of FSS 893.13(6)(b).

Feldman was in possession of drug paraphernalia, which is a violation of FSS 893.147(1).

Feldman willfully resisted the commands of several law enforcement officers in their official capacities, without doing harm to their persons, which is a violation of FSS 843.02.

Feldman was operating a motor vehicle, crashed, and willfully left the scene of the crash without fulfilling the requirements of FSS 316.062, which is a violation of FSS 316.061.

Cleared by arrest.
