On Sunday, November 1, 2015 at approximately 0059 hours Ofc. Kasyanenko, Ofc. Rhinhart and I (Ofc. Stutz) responded to the area of Southard St. and Simonton St. for a report of a physical disturbance. Key West Police Dispatch advised the caller, later identified as witness Kyle Hogue, reported the sounds of a fight coming from an apartment and a person screaming "Help me!"

Ofc. Kasyanenko arrived on scene first and was directed by Hogue to 602 Southard St apartment 1. I arrived shortly after and observed Ofc. Kasyanenko trying to calm an agitated male subject, later identified as Richard Cormack. I observed Cormack was screaming at another male, later identified as Darryl Cichon. I approached Cichon and observed the left side of his face was heavily bruised and swollen. I observed Cichon had a small laceration of his left eye and complained of pain in his back. I asked Cichon what happened. Cichon stated he was in his home, resting on the couch. Cichon stated he got up do some dishes and an unknown male entered his home and began beating him. Cichon motioned toward Cormack and identified him as the suspect. I asked Cichon if he knew Cormack. Cichon stated he had never met Cormack. As Cichon tried to speak to me, Cormack began screaming at Cichon and threatened to beat him again.

I then approached Cormack and asked him if he knew Cichon. Cormack told me it was none of my business and to go "Fuck myself". I asked Cormack for his identification. Cormack began screaming his name and tensing his fists. I advised Ofc. Kasyanenko that Cormack was in violation of multiple statutes and needed to be detained. I advised Cormack to place his hands behind his back. Cormack did not comply. I unholstered and pointed my TASER at Cormack. I again told Cormack to place his hands behind his back. Ofc. Kasyanenko told Cormack to comply or he would be TASERED. Cormack placed his hands behind his back. Ofc. Rhinhart and Ofc. Kasyanenko began to place Cormack into handcuffs. I observed Cormack begin to tense and pull his arms away from Ofc. Kasyanenko and Ofc. Rhinhart. I observed Cormack pull one of his arms free and began charging

towards me. I ordered Cormack to stop and deployed my TASER. One probe struck Cormack in the center of his chest. The other probe did not connect and Cormack continued to charge forward. Ofc. Kasyanenko deployed his TASER from behind Cormack. I observed Neuromuscular Incapacitation (NMI) was achieved and Cormack fell to the ground. After the TASER cycle completed, I gave Cormack loud verbal commands to place his hands behind his back. Cormack complied and was handcuffed by Ofc. Rhinhart. Cormack continued to be non-compliant and began spitting at officers on scene. Cormack was placed into a spit hood by Ofc. Rhinhart.

Key West Fire Rescue was already on scene treating Cichon for his injuries when Cormack was taken into custody. Sgt. D. Barrios responded to the scene in reference to the response to resistance report. Cormack refused medical treatment on scene. Ofc. Rhinhart and Ofc. Kasyanenko removed the probes from Cormack's chest and back. Photographs were taken of Cormack's injuries. Ofc. D. Fraga responded to the scene and transported Cormack to the processing area located at 510 Greene St.

I again spoke to Cichon about the incident. Cichon again stated he was in his kitchen when Cormack entered the residence. I asked Cichon if the doors were closed or locked. Cichon stated the doors and screen were open. Cichon stated Cormack entered the residence, screamed at him, then grabbed him. Cichon stated Cormack picked him up and slammed him onto the floor. Cichon stated Cormack began hitting him and throwing him around the living area. Cichon stated he was repeatedly picked up and "slammed" onto the floor. I asked Cormack to show me his residence. I observed the front door and screen to the residence were open. I observed the interior screen to the apartment was torn. I observed the door led directly to the kitchen. I observed directly to the left of the entry door was another doorway leading to the living area. I observed on the floor of the living area was a pool of fresh blood. I observed the couch in the living area had multiple fresh blood stains across the cushions.

Ofc. Kasyanenko photographed the scene and Cichon's injuries and later entered them into Key West Police Department COBAN system.

I then spoke to witness, Kyle Hogue, about the incident. Hogue stated he was staying in an adjoining apartment to the victim. Hogue stated he heard screaming coming from Cichon's apartment. Hogue stated he could hear a males voice screaming profanity and what sounded like another male pleading for help. Hogue stated he heard the sounds of someone being slammed on the ground repeatedly and screaming, "Help me!" Hogue stated he opened the door between the two apartments and could see one male, he described as Cormack, begin hitting the other man (Cichon). Hogue stated Cormack struck Cichon until he stopped screaming for help. Hogue stated he immediately called the police and directed Ofc. Kasyanenko when he arrived. Hogue provided a sworn statement for this incident.

I provided Cichon with a case umber for this incident and a Victim's Rights Brochure. Cichon was then transported to the Lower Keys Medical Center for further treatment.

I found probable cause to believe Cormack violated the following Florida State Statutes:

F.S.S 810.02(2)(A): Burglary with Battery on the Occupant:

Cormack did enter the dwelling, 602 Southard St. Apartment 1, with the intent to commit a crime there in, by repeatedly striking Cichon against his will causing injury (Battery).

SUPPLEMENTAL

On Sunday, 11/1/15, at approximately 0059 hrs, I (Ofc. I. Kasyanenko) was dispatched to the corner of Simonton St. and Southard St. in reference to two males fighting inside of the apartment complex. Caller later identified as Kyle Hogue (Witness), by his Florida driver's license, informed dispatch that one of the males was yelling "help me". On arrival, Hogue flagged me down and directed me to 602 Southard St. Apt #1.

While walking to the apartment, I observed a large tall male, approximately 6 foot and 6 inches in height, walking out of the dark yard of the apartment complex. The male was shirtless and sweaty, I recognized the male as Richard Cormack (Suspect) from previous encounters. Right behind Richard came out another male Darryl Cichon (Victim). As soon as Darryl saw me, he pointed at Richard and said that he attacked him in his apartment. I observed Darryl with significant injuries on his face and head area. Darryl's left side of the face was swollen/bruised and he had a laceration on his left eve. I requested Darryl to have a seat. I then requested Richard to have a seat, Richard ignored my request and started to walk in a opposite direction. I followed Richard and asked him to stop again, Richard kept walking away. I had to catch up with Richard and grabbed him by his arm and walked him towards the area with more light. Richard finally complied and sat down. I did not observed any injuries on Richard.

Ofc. Stutz arrived on scene at this time. Ofc. Stutz went over to speak with Darryl about what happened.

Richard started to yell profanities at Darryl and said he will kick his ass. Richard had a slurred speech and blood shot eyes. Richard appeared agitated and very aggressive towards Darryl.

Ofc. Rhinhart arrived on scene at this time.

Ofc. Stutz came over and asked Richard why he was screaming at Darryl and if he knew what he has done. Richard said "Fuck you, you don't know me" to Ofc. Stutz. Richard then started to get aggressive towards Ofc. Stutz. Ofc. Stutz informed Richard he was going to be placed in handcuffs at this time, due to violation of multiple statutes. Myself and Ofc. Rhinhart stood Richard up, to place him in handcuffs. Richard became enraged and started screaming at Ofc. Stutz, telling him he was not scared of him. Ofc. Stutz turned his TASER on, due to Richard being so aggressive towards him and refusing to follow our commands. As I was attempting to place handcuffs on Richard, Richard started to tense up and started to pull away from mine and Ofc. Rhinhart's grip. Richard finally ripped away from our grip and started charging towards Ofc. Stutz. Ofc. Stutz informed Richard that he was going to get TASED prior to him pulling away from us. Ofc. Stutz deployed his TASER as Richard was walking towards him in aggressive manner. Ofc. Stutz's TASER did not get full Neuromuscular Incapacitation (NMI) and Richard was still walking towards Ofc. Stutz with his fist clinched. I then deployed my TASER and hit Richard in his back, my TASER deployment was able to achieve full NMI and Richard fell on the ground. Ofc. Stutz gave loud verbal command to Richard to put his hands behind his back. Richard finally complied, but still said "Fuck you", to Ofc. Stutz.

Richard continued being aggressive towards us throughout the investigation. Sgt. D. Barrios arrived on scene and attempted to calm Richard down. Richard did not calm down and got aggressive towards Sgt. Barrios. Richard spit in our direction numerous times. Ofc. Rhinhart placed a spit hood on Richards

On Sunday November 1, 2015 at approximately 0109 hours, I (Sergeant Donny Barrios) was called to the scene at 602 Southard Street, in regards to a tasing.

Upon arrival, I saw a white male, later identified as Richard Cormack, laying face down in the yard next to the building. I saw Officer's Thomas Stutz and Igor Kasyanenko, standing to the side of Cormack and had their TASER'S deployed. Cormack was yelling and his words were mumbled. He said "Don't touch me, Fuck, all you all"!

Officer Kasyanenko briefed me on the incident and said both he and Officer Stutz deployed their TASER'S on Cormack.

I assisted with getting Cormack rolled over to a sitting position. I am very familiar with Cormack from numerous Law Enforcement encounters as well as him growing up in Key West. I identified myself to Cormack and he said "Fuck you Barrios"! I was unable to reason with Cormack, due to him being under the influence or either alcohol and or drugs. Cormack was covered in dirt, from the dirt parking lot.

Cormack began to spit towards Officers and I requested Officer Rhinhart to get a spit hood, and it was placed on Cormacks head. Officer Rhinhart took photographs of the locations of the TASER prongs while I assisted with holding Cormack. Officer Rhinhart and Officer Kasyanenko then removed the TASER prongs. Officer Kasyanenko took possession of both TASER cartridges to be placed into evidence. KWFD was on scene and put bandaids over the prong puncture wounds.

I requested Officer Fraga to respond with the transport van. Cormack continued to kick his legs and tried to pull away from Officers, while we were escorting to the Transport Van. Cormack was then placed into the transport van and taken to Old City for booking.

Once Cormack was placed into the Transport Van, I met with Officer Stutz and Kasyanenko, inside of the apartment. I saw fresh blood on the floor and on the couch, that was a result of Cormack beating Darryl Cichon (Victim). Cichon was treated on scene by KWFD, for injuries sustained from Cormack. Initially Cichon refused to go to the hospital, but then changed his mind and was transported by KWFD to the Lower Keys Medical Center.

I went to Old City Hall to meet with Officer Stutz, who was completing the arrest affidavit for Cormack. Once at Old City Hall, Officer Fraga told me Cormack continued to resist his efforts to walk him from the Transport Van to Old City Hall. Officer Fraga had to pin Cormack up against the passenger side of the Van. Cormack began to hit his head against the side of the van. I was unable to see any dents at that time. When I arrived at the Key West Police Station for briefing, I asked Officer Fraga if there was any damage done to the van. He walked out to the Van, which was parked at the Police Station and noticed 3 small dents, which were consistent with Cormack banging his head. Officer Fraga told me about them and I went out to inspect the van. I saw the dents and took photographs and later placed them into COBAN DPM. I notified Lt. Tripp of the damage that was discovered.

I downloaded Officer Stutz and Officer Kasyanenko's TASER'S and placed the disk's into property.

I completed a Response to Resistance report and forwarded it to Sgt. Randy Smith of Internal Affairs.

My BWC was activated during my time on scene.

Rhinhart) responded to the area of Southard St. and Simonton St. for a report of a physical disturbance. Stutz instructing Cormack to place his hands behind his back. Cormack did not comply. Ofc. Stutz un holstered and pointed his TASER at Cormack. Ofc. Stutz again told Cormack to place his hands behind his back. Ofc. Kasyanenko told Cormack to comply or he would be TASERED. Cormack placed his hands behind his back. Ofc. Kasyanenko and I began to place Cormack into handcuffs. I felt Cormack begin to tense and pull his arms away from Ofc. Kasyanenko and I.
