On Saturday, 11/14/2015, at approximately 0252 hours, I (Ofc. J. HAMMERS) was flagged down by the Ricks Complex security staff about an unknown problem at 208 Duval Street (Dirty Harrys).

Upon arrival, I initiated my BWC. I observed several members from the Ricks security staff detaining an individual later identified as JAMES MAYES (Florida Drivers License). I identified myself as an officer with the Key West Police Department. I took control of MAYES's right arm and along with the assistance from the Ricks security staff, helped MAYES's to his feet. A security staff member told me MAYES poked one of the security staff members in the eye.

I began escorting MAYES out of the complex. On the way out, MAYES said he had a "cramp" in his leg. I told MAYES he had to remove himself from the property. MAYES began to increasingly emphasize that he could not walk. In a controlled manner, I grabbed MAYES's right arm and attempted to help him walk off the property. MAYES had no problem standing on his own accord. In a controlled manner, I attempted to escort MAYES off the property using the "hammer lock" position. While attempting to position MAYES's arm behind his back, he dropped to the ground. I did not employ any take down maneuvers to have caused MAYES to end up on the ground. I allowed MAYES to remain sitting on the ground until another officer arrived. While waiting for backup, it was later discovered that my BWC battery had died. Ofc. C. RHINHART arrived on scene moments later. Ofc. C. RHINHART and I assisted MAYES back to his feet. Ofc. C. RHINHART's BWC captured the rest of the incident. MAYES continued to complain of injury to his leg. MAYES was grabbing the area near his hamstring. MAYES was again able to stand on his own accord. Ofc. C. RHINHART and I repeatedly attempted to escort MAYES off the property. MAYES became agitated, tensed his muscles, and pulled them towards his chest. MAYES was pulling his arms away from my control. I regained control of MAYES's arm in a controlled manner. Again, MAYES dropped to the ground without being forced to do so. MAYES began saying that I injured his leg. I requested KWFD to meet at our location in reference to MAYES's injuries. Ofc. C. RHINHART and I were able to get MAYES to his feet, and walk him off the property. At one point MAYES did not rely on my support to walk himself off the property.

Ofc. C. RHINHART and I relocated MAYES to the corner of Charles Street and Duval Street, and sat him on the curb. I initiated my in-car Coban system. MAYES began increasingly complaining of injury to his leg. MAYES repeatedly claimed KWPD caused injury to his leg. I requested Sgt. P. RODRIGUEZ to meet at my location to document the allegation that the injury was caused by KWPD. KWFD arrived on scene. MAYES was largely uncooperative with KWPD and KWFD. MAYES grew increasingly agitated and hostile towards the members of KWFD. Sgt. P. RODRIGUEZ later arrived on scene.

I met with the Ricks security staff member, MARK LAVER. LAVER said MAYES was causing a disturbance inside Dirty Harrys. LAVER said he was attempting to resolve the issue. LAVER said MAYES became hostile and aggressive. LAVER said MAYES put his hands on his chest several times. LAVER said he warned MAYES not to touch him. LAVER said MAYES grabbed his upper chest. LAVER said he attempted to restrain MAYES to have him escorted off the property. LAVER said during the struggle, one of MAYES's fingers jabbed into his eye. LAVER said additional staff members arrived, and assisted with detaining MAYES until KWPD arrived. LAVER refused medical treatment. I observed redness to both of LAVER's eyes. LAVER initially refused to pursue charges against MAYES for battery. A short time later, LAVER said he changed his mind and wanted to pursue charges.

While conducting my investigation, a subject whom identified himself as MAYES's friend, repeatedly drew my attention. The unidentified male, said he captured the Ricks security staff verbally assaulting MAYES and attacking him. I asked the unidentified male to show me the cell phone video. The unidentified male refused to show me the cell phone video. The unidentified male refused to provide me with his information, therefore, refused to cooperate as a witness to the incident.

I spoke to CHRISTOPHER DWIGHT (Witness). DWIGHT said MAYES was involved in an altercation with customers. DWIGHT said the bouncer, LAVER, intervened. DWIGHT said the situation calmed down but then MAYES became violent. DWIGHT said MAYES initiated the physical altercation. DWIGHT provided me with a written statement. I submitted DWIGHT's statement into the KWPD Records section.

I spoke to RICHARD CEARFOSS (Witness). CEARFOSS said MAYES had an altercation with a customer. CEARFOSS said LAVER addressed the altercation and separated the parties. CEARFOSS said he said MAYES attack LAVER. CEARFOSS provided me with a written statement. I submitted CEARFOSS's statement into the KWPD Records section.

Ricks security staff showed me video footage of the incident from the Ricks security cameras. I observed the following on the video footage:

MAYES and LAVER engaged in conversation. MAYES became visibly aggressive and struck LAVER in his chest with both of his hands. LAVER attempted to detain MAYES.

RICK's security staff provided Ofc. C. RHINHART with a copy of the video footage. Ofc. C. RHINHART submitted the video into the KWPD property section as evidence.

MAYES was extremely uncooperative with the members of the KWFD. MAYES physically refused to cooperate with KWFD and sprawled his body in the street. MAYES demanded to be transported to the hospital. KWFD members requested that I ride with them to Lower Keys Medical Center. KWFD transported MAYES to LKMC without incident.

MAYES was subsequently medically cleared by LKMC staff. Ofc. C. WILLIAMS remained with MAYES while I was transported to my patrol vehicle by Sgt. P. RODRIGUEZ. Ofc. C. WILLIAMS said MAYES attempted to leave LKMC. Ofc. C. WILLIAMS said MAYES physically resisted her control (without violence) when she attempted to place him into handcuffs. See Ofc. C. I took a photo of MAYES and uploaded it onto the KWPD Coban server. I will follow up with LAVER at a later date to photograph his injures.

Ofc. C. WILLIAMS and I, along with LKMC security staff, placed MAYES into my patrol vehicle. While placing MAYES into my vehicle, he would not support himself, and relied on the LKMC security staff and myself to keep from falling to the ground. MAYES physically and verbally refused to cooperate. MAYES physically refused to sit up while in the patrol vehicle. I was unable to secure MAYES using the seat belt. Sgt. P. RODRIGUEZ gave me permission to transport MAYES to MCDC without securing him with the seat belt. I transported MAYES to MCDC. My transport of MAYES was recorded on my in-car Coban system.

Based on the facts and evidence, I believe probable cause exists that on 11/14/2015, JAMES MAYES did knowingly and intentionally strike MARK LAVER and resist a lawful order without violence, in contrary to F.S.S. 784.03 (1)(a)(1) and F.S.S. 843.02.

SUPPLEMENTAL

On November 14th, 2015 at approximately 0424 hours, I met with Ofc. Hammers at the ER. Officer Hammers shared the following information: His arrestee (James) was transported to the ER per James request due to a complaint of injury. He needed me to supervise James while Sgt. P. Rodriguez assisted him in picking up his patrol vehicle which he left at the initial scene. He cautioned me that James may throw himself on the ground and claim injury by cop because that's what James did earlier at the initial scene.

Due to being inside a medical facility in close proximity to patients, I did not initiate Body Cam during the initial contact. While supervising James, James was verbally abusive, using profane and insulting language against the hospital staff and me. James verbal aggressiveness gave me pre-indicators that James was susceptible to becoming combative. I noticed James was not handcuffed therefore. I re-confirmed with Ofc. Hammers that James was under arrest. Officer Hammers re-confirmed that James was under arrest. Officer Hammers added that James was not handcuffed so that medical personnel could evaluate him more easily. James said he was going to leave. I told James that he could not leave because he was detained per the investigating officer, Ofc. Hammers. James asked me why he was being arrested. I advised James that the investigating officer (Ofc. Hammers) would arrive within a few minutes to answer his questions. James said that he could leave if he wanted to because he was not handcuffed. I notified James that he was not free to leave therefore, he could not leave. James demanded to be handcuffed. Due to his un-ordinary demand and having no backup officer assistance with me, I did not handcuff James. James continued to demand I handcuff him. It was only after James scooted to the edge of the hospital bed as if he was going to stand up and leave. did I proceed to handcuff James.

After I placed one handcuff on, James refused to place his other hand behind his back to be completely handcuffed. After repeated verbal commands to place his un-handcuffed hand behind his back, James did so, but grabbed on to his other wrist in a manner that prevented me from placing the second handcuff on. Again, I gave James multiple verbal commands to let go of his wrist. I notified James that he was resisting arrest and was going to be charged with doing so. James then released the grip on his wrist so that I could place the second handcuff on. Throughout the process of attempting to handcuff James, he continuously shouted remarks suggesting police brutality.

After James was handcuffed, James flopped himself on the floor as the on-duty security officer and I

were attempting to keep him from scooting all the way off the bed. We tried holding his body upright, but James presented dead weight and would not attempt to stand or support any of his body weight. We laid James on the floor. I flipped the switch to initiate Body Cam. I tried talking James into complying and allowing me to assist him in getting off the floor and being seated into a wheel chair. James kept shouting remarks suggesting police brutality and said he couldn't. James defeated my efforts in assisting him off the floor by straightening his legs and torso. The on-duty security guard and the on-duty head nurse attempted to assist me in properly lifting James, but James continued to resist and defeat our efforts by forcefully tensing his body. We managed to lift James into the wheel chair,

I looked down at my Body Cam and noticed it was in the off position (I must have not flipped the switch hard enough to initiate). I initiated Body Cam and confirmed it on the on position. James finally sat in the wheel chair, all the while talking about his plans to sue the City, the police department, the hospital staff, and I. James made threats to batter the security guard. James said he sued a Tampa Police agency and won through settlement and said he would do the same with the Key West Police. He added that he wasn't going to settle for any amount, and he would fight for all the money and he will personally sue officers personally for money and assets. While James' mind was distracted making threats, I noticed James bending and moving both of his legs without displayed pain or restraint.

but again, James resisted by straighten and tensing his body so that he would slide off the chair.

James requested to speak to a supervisor. I advised Sgt. P. Rodriguez of his request. Sergeant Rodriguez acknowledged and added that he met with him earlier but James didn't want to talk to him. Officer Hammers arrived and discussed the investigation progress with James. Officer Hammers notified James that he was going to be transported to the jail.

James complained that the handcuffs were too tight. James refused to stand or brace his weight on one-leg (since he claimed the other leg was injured) to allow officers to search him and for transport to the jail. Officer Hammers and the on-duty security guard had to lift James off the wheel chair so that I could search James back pockets. I checked the handcuffs and confirmed they were not fastened tight. They had one-finger space allotted. I loosened them even more to where there was two-finger width of space allotted. James continued shouting the handcuffs were too tight. As James was making statements suggesting police brutality, I observed James purposefully grind and push his wrists forcefully against the handcuffs. It appeared that James was attempting to self-inflict handcuff marks on his wrists. I requested Ofc. Hammers re-confirm the handcuffs were loose. Officer Hammers re-confirmed the handcuffs were two-finger width space allotted.

James continued to bear all of his weight on Ofc. Hammers and the security guard. James refused to help or comply. After some time, James stood enough to be seated in the patrol vehicle. James refused to get all the way inside the vehicle claiming the handcuffs were too tight. I had double-locked the handcuffs therefore, they were in the same spacious position as I initially applied them. I could visually see the space in the handcuffs and Ofc. Hammers physically re-checked the handcuffs confirming they had the same space allotted as before. James straightened his body so that he could not be seat-belted.

Once at the jail, James told deputies he would cooperate with them. James stood and bore weight on one leg. I observed James move and bend the "injured" leg but he did not bear weight on it. When the handcuffs were removed, I did not observe any injuries to his wrists nor did he complain of any to the deputies during booking.

On 11/14/2015 at approximately 0252 hours, I Ofc. Rhinhart assisted Ofc. J. Hammers at Rick's Bar/Durty Harry's Bar at 208 Duval St. regarding a trespass and battery incident.

Upon my arrival, I observed (Arrestee) James Mayes holding his left leg and screaming loud. Mayes was very intoxicated and out of control.

The bouncers at Rick's Bar/Durty Harry's Bar stated Mayes battered Rick's Bar employee (Victim) Mark Laver.

After further investigation and reviewed security video, it was determined a battery did occur and Laver stated he will press charges.

Key West Rescue responded to the scene to treat Mayes alleged leg injury. Mayes was transported by Key West Rescue to the Lower Keys Medical Center for treatment.

After the Lower Keys Medical Center treated and released Mayes, Mayes was arrested and transported to the Monroe County detention Center for processing by Ofc. J. Hammers.

I obtained a security video CD on 11/14/2015 at 0500 hours from Rick's Bar/Durty Harry's Bar for evidentiary purposes. I placed the video CD into the Key West Police Department's property/evidence.

This incident was captured on my VIEVU body worn camera and uploaded into the Key West Police Department's COBAN DPM system for recorded documentation.

along with the assistance from the Ricks security staff, helped MAYES's to his feet. A security staff member told me MAYES poked one of the security staff members in the eye.

I began escorting MAYES out of the complex. On the way out, MAYES said he had a "cramp" in his leg. I told MAYES he had to remove himself from the property. MAYES began to increasingly emphasize that he could not walk. In a controlled manner, I grabbed MAYES's right arm and attempted to help him walk off the property. MAYES had no problem standing on his own accord. In a controlled manner, I attempted to escort MAYES off the property using the "hammer lock" position. While attempting to position MAYES's arm behind his back, he dropped to the ground. I did not employ any take down maneuvers to have caused MAYES to end up on the ground. I allowed MAYES to remain sitting on the ground until another officer arrived. While waiting for backup, it was later discovered that my BWC battery had died. Ofc. C. RHINHART arrived on scene moments later. Ofc. C. RHINHART and I assisted MAYES back to his feet. Ofc. C. RHINHART's BWC captured the rest of the incident. MAYES continued to complain of injury to his leg. MAYES was grabbing the area near his hamstring. MAYES was again able to stand on his own accord. Ofc. C. RHINHART and I repeatedly attempted to escort MAYES off the property, MAYES became agitated, tensed his muscles, and pulled them towards his chest. MAYES was pulling his arms away from my control. I regained control of MAYES's arm in a controlled manner. Again, MAYES dropped to the ground without being forced to do so. MAYES began saying that I injured his leg. I requested KWFD to meet at our location in reference to MAYES's injuries. Ofc. C. RHINHART and I were able to get MAYES to his feet, and walk him off the property. At one point MAYES did not rely on my support to walk himself off the property.

Ofc. C. RHINHART and I relocated MAYES to the corner of Charles Street and Duval Street, and sat him on the curb. I initiated my in-car Coban system. MAYES began increasingly complaining of injury to his leg. MAYES repeatedly claimed KWPD caused injury to his leg. I requested Sqt. P. RODRIGUEZ to meet at my location to document the allegation that the injury was caused by KWPD. KWFD arrived on scene. MAYES was largely uncooperative with KWPD and KWFD. MAYES grew increasingly agitated and hostile towards the members of KWFD. Sqt. P. RODRIGUEZ later arrived on scene.

I met with the Ricks security staff member, MARK LAVER. LAVER said MAYES was causing a disturbance inside Dirty Harrys. LAVER said he was attempting to resolve the issue. LAVER said MAYES became hostile and aggressive. LAVER said MAYES put his hands on his chest several times. LAVER said he warned MAYES not to touch him. LAVER said MAYES grabbed his upper chest. LAVER said he attempted to restrain MAYES to have him escorted off the property. LAVER said during the struggle, one of MAYES's fingers jabbed into his eye. LAVER said additional staff members arrived, and assisted with detaining MAYES until KWPD arrived. LAVER refused medical treatment. I observed redness to both of LAVER's eyes. LAVER initially refused to pursue charges against MAYES for battery. A short time later, LAVER said he changed his mind and wanted to pursue charges.

While conducting my investigation, a subject whom identified himself as MAYES's friend, repeatedly drew my attention. The unidentified male. said he captured the Ricks security staff verbally assaulting MAYES and attacking him. I asked the unidentified male to show me the cell phone video. The unidentified male refused to show me the cell phone video. The unidentified male refused to provide me with his information, therefore, refused to cooperate as a witness to the incident.

I spoke to CHRISTOPHER DWIGHT (Witness). DWIGHT said MAYES was involved in an altercation with customers. DWIGHT said the bouncer, LAVER, intervened, DWIGHT said the situation calmed down but then MAYES became violent. DWIGHT said MAYES initiated the physical altercation.DWIGHT provided me with a written statement. I submitted DWIGHT's statement into the KWPD Records section.

spoke to RICHARD CEARFOSS (Witness). CEARFOSS said MAYES had an altercation with a customer. CEARFOSS said LAVER addressed the altercation and separated the parties. CEARFOSS said he said MAYES attack LAVER. CEARFOSS provided me with a written statement, I submitted CEARFOSS's statement into the KWPD Records section.

RICK's security staff provided Ofc. C. RHINHART with a copy of the video footage. Ofc. C. RHINHART submitted the video into the KWPD property section as evidence.

MAYES was extremely uncooperative with the members of the KWFD. MAYES physically refused to cooperate with KWFD and sprawled his body in the street. MAYES demanded to be transported to the hospital. KWFD members requested that I ride with them to Lower Keys Medical Center. KWFD transported MAYES to LKMC without incident.

MAYES was subsequently medically cleared by LKMC staff. Ofc. C. WILLIAMS remained with MAYES while I was transported to my patrol vehicle by Sgt. P. RODRIGUEZ. Ofc. C. WILLIAMS said MAYES attempted to leave LKMC. Ofc. C. WILLIAMS said MAYES physically resisted her control (without violence) when she attempted to place him into handcuffs. See Ofc. C. WILLIAMS supplemental report for further information.

I took a photo of MAYES and uploaded it onto the KWPD Coban server. I will follow up with LAVER at a later date to photograph his injures.

Ofc. C. WILLIAMS and I, along with LKMC security staff, placed MAYES into my patrol vehicle. While placing MAYES into my vehicle, he would not support himself, and relied on the LKMC security staff and myself to keep from falling to the ground. MAYES physically and verbally refused to cooperate. MAYES physically refused to sit up while in the patrol vehicle. I was unable to secure MAYES using the seat belt. Sgt. P. RODRIGUEZ gave me permission to transport MAYES to MCDC without securing him with the seat belt. I transported MAYES to MCDC. My transport of MAYES was recorded on my in-car Coban system.

Based on the facts and evidence, I believe probable cause exists that on 11/14/2015, JAMES MAYES did knowingly and intentionally strike MARK LAVER and resist a lawful order without violence, in contrary to F.S.S. 784.03 (1)(a)(1) and F.S.S. 843.02.
