	<p>1 On Tuesday, December 1, 2015, at approximately 1609 hours, I (Ofc Hall) responded to DePoo Hospital, in reference to an armed barricaded person. I met with the nurses on duty at the double doors to the secured area. Several nurses advised me that the subject was in the bathroom of his room, and had the metal handicap rail from the shower.</p>	
	<p>I asked where he had gotten the rail. They advised me that he ripped it from the wall. The nurses described the metal railing as a pipe, approximately 3 inches in diameter and approximately 3 feet long.</p>	
	<p>I could see several employees at the end of the hallway standing in a doorway. The nurses pointed me to the doorway. I walked into the room where 2 security guards were holding the door closed. The quickly told me that the subject was inside, and pointed to the closed door. The also told me that the subject did not speak any English.</p>	
	<p>I moved to the door and put my left foot against it, keeping it shut. I had the security guards leave, to keep them safe and out of harm's way. Ofc Keohane arrived to the room about the same time.</p>	
	<p>Ofc Keohane took position in the room with her TASER out. After some discussion, I decided to crack open the door and try and make contact with the subject. I cracked the door slightly, just enough to see partially inside the room. I could see the subject holding the metal pipe. The subject kept hitting the door with the pipe in an attempt to hit me.</p>	
	<p>I attempted to let the subject know that we were the Key West Police Department. I even opened the door several times allowing the subject to see my badge and uniform. I told him over and over that I was Police (Policia). The subject kept saying, "No, No, No Policia." The subject kept hitting the door and wall with the pipe. I closed the door and put my foot against it again.</p>	
<p>Once Ofc Blasberg arrived and then Sgt Woods, I made the decision to try and take the subject into custody.</p>		
<p>I then started slowly opening the door while trying to cover the room with my TASER. The more I opened the door, the more the subject would get closer to the wall 90 degrees to my right not allowing me to see him. He kept hitting the wall and open doorway with the pipe in an attempt to hit me.</p>

After several wall strikes by the subject with the pipe, I waited until he hit the wall and started to draw the pipe back. Once he started to draw the pipe back, I stepped into the bathroom and deployed my TASER. One probe went into the subject causing him to jump against the back wall, while the second probe fell to the ground as if it hadn't deployed all the way.

Once the subject saw that he was not shot or hurt, He drew the pipe back up and swung it at my head. I quickly dropped my TASER, blocked the pipe with my left forearm, and closed the gap between the subject and me. I then grasped the subject's neck and head with both hands and forearms. I then felt as if I was being TASERED. I then dropped my body weight to the left and rotated in the same direction. I was able to throw the subject to my left using my body weight as he struggled to hit me and get away from me. The subject and I ended up on the floor in the doorway. I again felt as if I was being TASERED.

Once on the ground, I grabbed the subject's left arm. Ofc Blasberg took the subject's arm from me in an attempt to handcuff him.

The subject would not bring his right arm out from under him. I grabbed the subject's left leg and pulled up on it, rotating it to the left in an attempt to help free the arm. Other officers were able to get his right arm out from under him and place him into handcuffs.

Once the subject was handcuffed, I looked down and saw that my left arm was bleeding where the subject hit it with the metal pipe. My arm started hurting and I was no longer able to move my fingers.

Rescue arrived on scene and transported the subject to the Emergency Room. Another Rescue team arrived on scene. They cleaned and bandaged my arm. I then drove myself to the Emergency Room.

	<p>On Tuesday, 01DEC2015, approximately 4:07pm (1607) COMM 1 aired a call regarding an EDP (emotionally disturbed person) housed at DePoo hospital, acting highly aggressive towards staff. Further, the patient had barricaded himself in the bathroom and had armed himself with a shower curtain rod (this rod was pulled from its anchors, was solid metal and was over an inch in diameter). I responded to the call and arrived a short time later (Officers Hall and Keohane had arrived previous) with Sgt. Wood. We entered the hospital and went to the second floor via the elevator.</p> <p>Exiting the elevator, we removed our eyeglasses and knocked to gain access to the ward. We then were directed to the back. At this time I activated my body camera and donned protective kevlar gloves. As we came towards the back of the ward, I could hear Officer Hall yelling, "Key West police. Come out!" It should be known all the officers present were in their class B uniforms and were easily recognizable as police officers. Officer Hall said this at least two (2) or more times as we approached. Once inside the room the bathroom was in the far end, off the corner of the room. Officer Hall was by the bathroom door and Officer Keohane was directly to his right. As I entered with Sgt. Wood there was a bed between me and Officer Hall.</p> <p>Officer Hall attempted to open the bathroom door when the person inside swung something at the door. Although I only got a glimpse, when the object which was swung connected with the door, I could hear that it was very substantial by the impact it made (as opposed to a metallic "ting" this made a "thunk" upon impact). Officer Hall quickly shut the door. Again verbal commands were given (police, put down the weapon, etc.) by both Officer Hall, myself and a doctor who spoke Spanish). Officer Hall attempted to open the door again and as he did, had his TASER activated. As he pushed the door further open, he deployed his TASER. As he did, the person swung the rod again (deadly force) striking Officer Hall. I had positioned myself standing on the bed and activated my TASER when Officer Hall deployed his. Office Hall then entered into the bathroom.</p> <p>Apparently, Officer Hall's TASER did not achieve NMI (neuro muscular incapacitation) when he deployed it since the person swung the shower rod again, striking Officer Hall (deadly force). Officer Hall grabbed a hold of the person and as they began to struggle, I had a clear shot at the person which I took. I deployed my TASER which due to the struggle only connected with one probe on him (left arm) while the other probe connected with Officer Hall (right shoulder and lodged into his body armor). As they struggled, the wires to the TASER became entangled.</p> <p>Since the person was still actively fighting (aggravated/aggressive) and NMI had not been achieved, I went into the bathroom, going "hands-on" with the person. I was able to pull the person from Officer Hall as I went to the ground/floor. Officer Hall freed himself and was partially on top of the person who at this point was on the ground/floor partially on his stomach. He was still resisting and I then unholstered my TASER (I had placed it back in the holster prior to going "hands-on") and placed it on the</p>

persons neck, activated it and yelled, "stop resisting." This did not work since the wires which had become entangled, shocked Officer Hall as well as the person. I then re holstered it and was able to get the persons arm/wrist in a wrist/arm bar and began to apply pressure. I yelled, "stop resisting. give me your other hand," but because of his position (he was almost totally lying on it) he was unable to do so. Officer Hall then repositioned himself and by doing so, the persons other hand became loose enough to obtain and he was finally subdued and handcuffed. A W/F staff member then came over with a syringe and injected the person which I later found out to be a sedative to calm him down.

The combative person, the W/H/M, was stood up and checked for injuries (other than two probes and some minor scrapes he was not injured). Officer Hall said he thought his arm may have been broken, so Officer Keohane and I held onto the W/H/M. KWFD ambulances were summoned to the scene (one for the W/H/M and one for Officer Hall. Once one of the ambulances arrived, the W/H/M was placed onto the stretcher (still handcuffed) and was transported to the ER. Since he was so combative, I rode in the ambulance with him as a safety precaution for the firefighters/paramedics. During the ride out to the ER, the W/H/M was sedate, probably due to the injection he received at DePoo, and did not make any statements. Once at the ER, I shut my body camera off and escorted the firefighters/paramedics into the ER.

At the ER, the W/H/M was checked and his injuries treated. My right knee, apparently during the scuffle, began to hurt (my adrenaline was wearing off) and I advised Lt. Ream who had just arrived. Lt. Ream then took a picture of my knees (comparison) and advised me to get my knee checked while at the ER (I did and was later admitted)

Due to my injury and being admitted to the hospital (treated and later released), I gave Sgt. Wood my TASER and my body camera to be downloaded for evidence.

Sgt. Wood and Ofc. F. Blasberg arrived on scene to assist. Sgt Wood again attempted to speak to Dominguez, who again swung the pole in our direction.

Ofc. D. Hall, Ofc. F. Blasberg and I drew our tasers and attempted to talk Dominguez out of the bathroom, with translation provided by Dr. Hernandez. Dominguez again began swinging the pole. Ofc. Hall attempted to taze Dominguez, but only one probe penetrated Dominguez skin. As Ofc. Hall entered the bathroom to grab Dominguez, he quickly brought the pole up and attempted to strike Ofc. Hall in the head. Ofc. Hall brought his left arm up to shield his head and was struck by the pole. Ofc. Blasberg at that time, attempted to taze Dominguez, but the probes did not place at their intended target. Ofc. Hall was able to get Dominguez to the ground, where he continued to resist our efforts to handcuff him. Ofc. Blasberg grabbed Dominguez's right arm and attempted to put it behind his back, but Dominguez continued to fight. I delivered a drive stun to the back of Dominguez's right upper arm, giving him loud verbal commands to put his arms behind his back. Dominguez complied and was then handcuffed. He was then given an injection of a sedative by the nurse on scene.

Dominguez was transported to Lower Keys Medical Center ER by EMS with Ofc. Blasberg accompanying the ambulance. Ofc. Hall, was checked by EMS for the strike he recieved from the pole. Hall, was checked by EMS for the strike he recieved from the pole. He had pain and swelling to the site where he was hit. Ofc. Hall drove himself to the Emergency Room for further evaluation. It was discovered that Ofc. Blasberg suffered a possible knee injury and I suffered a right arm and shoulder injury while taking Dominguez into custody. Dominguez was later transported to the Monroe County Detention Center after being medically cleared at the ER. I stayed on scene to collect the taser cartridges and AFIDs. I also took photos of the bathroom wall, the damage to the wall and the shower bar used by Dominguez. The shower bar, which weight approximately 10 to 15 pounds, was taken from the scene and put into evidence. I also obtained photos of Ofc. Hall's left arm. The photos were put on a disk and put into evidence. Two probes were recovered on scene. One was taken from the suspects lower chest area and the other was found on the bathroom floor. The third was found caught in the shoulder part of Ofc. Hall's vest. The fourth probe was unaccounted for. I spoke with employees and also two members of the corporate office. I explained to them that I could not locate a fourth probe and that it may have fallen down the drain located in the center of the floor of the bathroom. All parties verbalized their understanding. It was noted that I did not have my body camera on my person, as I had taken it off before the call to download it.

	<p>On Tuesday, 01DEC2015, approximately 4:07pm (1607) COMM 1 aired a call regarding an EDP (emotionally disturbed person) housed at DePoo hospital, acting highly aggressive towards staff. Further, the patient had barricaded himself in the bathroom and had armed himself with a shower curtain rod (this rod was pulled from its anchors, was solid metal and was over an inch in diameter). I responded to the call and arrived a short time later (Officers Hall and Keohane had arrived previous) with Sgt. Wood. We entered the hospital and went to the second floor via the elevator.</p> <p>Exiting the elevator, we removed our eyeglasses and knocked to gain access to the ward. We then were directed to the back. At this time I activated my body camera and donned protective kevlar gloves. As we came towards the back of the ward, I could hear Officer Hall yelling, "Key West police. Come out!" It should be known all the officers present were in their class B uniforms and were easily recognizable as police officers. Officer Hall said this at least two (2) or more times as we approached. Once inside the room the bathroom was in the far end, off the corner of the room. Officer Hall was by the bathroom door and Officer Keohane was directly to his right. As I entered with Sgt. Wood there was a bed between me and Officer Hall.</p> <p>Officer Hall attempted to open the bathroom door when the person inside swung something at the door. Although I only got a glimpse, when the object which was swung connected with the door, I could hear that it was very substantial by the impact it made (as opposed to a metallic "ting" this made a "thunk" upon impact). Officer Hall quickly shut the door. Again verbal commands were given (police, put down the weapon, etc.) by both Officer Hall, myself and a doctor who spoke Spanish). Officer Hall attempted to open the door again and as he did, had his TASER activated. As he pushed the door further open, he deployed his TASER. As he did, the person swung the rod again (deadly force) striking Officer Hall. I had positioned myself standing on the bed and activated my TASER when Officer Hall deployed his. Officer Hall then entered into the bathroom.</p> <p>Apparently, Officer Hall's TASER did not achieve NMI (neuro muscular incapacitation) when he deployed it since the person swung the shower rod again, striking Officer Hall (deadly force). Officer Hall grabbed a hold of the person and as they began to struggle, I had a clear shot at the person which I took. I deployed my TASER which due to the struggle only connected with one probe on him (left arm) while the other probe connected with Officer Hall (right shoulder and lodged into his body armor). As they struggled, the wires to the TASER became entangled.</p> <p>Since the person was still actively fighting (aggravated/aggressive) and NMI had not been achieved, I went into the bathroom, going "hands-on" with the person. I was able to pull the person from Officer Hall as I went to the ground/floor. Officer Hall freed himself and was partially on top of the person who at this point was on the ground/floor partially on his stomach. He was still resisting and I then unholstered my TASER (I had placed it back in the holster prior to going "hands-on") and placed it on the persons neck, activated it and yelled, "stop resisting." This did not work since the wires which had become entangled, shocked Officer Hall as well as the person. I then re holstered it and was able to get the persons arm/wrist in a wrist/arm bar and began to apply pressure. I yelled, "stop resisting. give me your other hand," but because of his position (he was almost totally lying on it) he was unable to do so.</p>

Officer Hall then repositioned himself and by doing so, the persons other hand became loose enough to obtain and he was finally subdued and handcuffed. A W/F staff member then came over with a syringe and injected the person which I later found out to be a sedative to calm him down.

The combative person, the W/H/M, was stood up and checked for injuries (other than two probes and some minor scrapes he was not injured). Officer Hall said he thought his arm may have been broken, so Officer Keohane and I held onto the W/H/M. KWFD ambulances were summoned to the scene (one for the W/H/M and one for Officer Hall. Once one of the ambulances arrived, the W/H/M was placed onto the stretcher (still handcuffed) and was transported to the ER. Since he was so combative, I rode in the ambulance with him as a safety precaution for the firefighters/paramedics. During the ride out to the ER, the W/H/M was sedate, probably due to the injection he received at DePoo, and did not make any statements. Once at the ER, I shut my body camera off and escorted the firefighters/paramedics into the ER.

At the ER, the W/H/M was checked and his injuries treated. My right knee, apparently during the scuffle, began to hurt (my adrenaline was wearing off) and I advised Lt. Ream who had just arrived. Lt. Ream then took a picture of my knees (comparison) and advised me to get my knee checked while at the ER (I did and was later admitted)

Due to my injury and being admitted to the hospital (treated and later released), I gave Sgt. Wood my TASER and my body camera to be downloaded for evidence.
