	<p>On Friday, 12/11/15, at approximately 2106 hours, I (Ofc. I. Kasyanenko), was dispatched to 527 Duval St. (Walgreens), in reference to a white male waving a "big knife". KWPD dispatch said, the caller stated, the suspect was chasing him with a knife, the caller also said the blade was approximately four inches in length. When the call came on the radio, I was in my patrol vehicle located near the corner of Southard St. and Duval St. on Southard St. side. An unknown male on a bicycle approached my vehicle and said there was a male with a knife, running around, across the street from Walgreens on Duval St. I initiated my emergency vehicle lights and made a right on Duval St. As I pulled up to Walgreens, I saw a white male (Suspect) running towards Apprlerouth Ln. and another white male pointing towards the suspect while running after him. I followed after him in my police car. I observed him jumping over the concrete fence, into a parking lot on Apprlerouth Ln. I then observed the suspect making a throwing motion. I was not able to see what the male was throwing. The suspect then jumped back over the fence, at this point I had my duty weapon out, pointing it towards the suspect. I gave the suspect loud verbal commands to get on the ground, the suspect was not listening to my commands and kept walking towards me with his hands up. I reholstered my handgun and took the suspect down with a leg sweep while controlling him to the ground. I handcuffed him (double locked). He was not injured and he did not complain of being injured.</p> <p>I was then approached by a male who was chasing the suspect, later identified as Nathan T Neely III (Victim). Neely said that he was the one who called the police and he also observed the suspect, later identified as Carroll B Jourdan (Suspect), throwing the knife somewhere in the parking lot, as he was running away from me. Neely said Jourdan was making a disturbance, while buying cigarettes at Walgreens and was being disrespectful to the cashier. Neely said Jourdan threw change and yelled profanities towards the cashier. Neely said his friend Lauryn B Barnett (Witness), told Jourdan to stop being rude and disrespectful towards the cashier. Neely said Jourdan started yelling profanities at</p>

Barnett, Neely said he then stood up for his friend and told Jourdan to stop. Neely said he got into a verbal argument with Jourdan and that's when Jourdan began to verbally threaten him. Neely said Jourdan then walked back and forth from Walgreens to Appplerouth Lane. Jourdan at some point retrieved a black knife, with approximately a four inch black blade. Neely said he observed Jourdan throwing the knife into the parking lot, prior jumping the fence.

Neely completed a sworn witness statement, I placed his statement into KWPd Records Division. Ofc. A. Rodriguez, Ofc. C. Rhinhart, Det. Siracuse, Det. M. Diaz and Ofc. C. Williams all arrived on scene.

Ofc. C. Williams, Ofc. Rhinhart and both detectives went to search the parking lot on the North side of Appplerouth Lane for the knife that Jourdan threw.

I met with Lauryn B Barnett (Witness), Barnett stated the following:

Jourdan was confrontational with Barnett inside and outside of Walgreens, because she told Jourdan he was being disrespectful towards the employees. Barnett said Jourdan went in and out of Walgreens on numerous occasions and "verbally assaulted" her. Barnett said Neely then told Jourdan to leave her alone. Barnett said she observed the confrontation as it escalated and Jourdan threatening Neely with a knife.

Barnett wrote a sworn witness statement, I placed her statement into KWPd Records Division. I attempted to talk with Jourdan, as I read Jourdan the Miranda Warning, he kept saying he could not understand me. Jourdan said my accent was too thick and he couldn't understand what I was saying. Det. Diaz then read him the Miranda Warning so Jourdan could understand it better. Jourdan said he still did not understand his rights. Jourdan said he was mentally retarded with an IQ of 8 and dyslexic. Jourdan did spontaneously utter that Neely was way bigger than him and he would have used the knife if he had it.

As I was talking to Jourdan, Ofc. Rhinhart was able to locate the knife that fit the description of the witnesses accounts. I took pictures of the knife and where it was located. I uploaded the photos into KWPd COBAN SYSTEM. I placed the knife into KWPd property/evidence section.

While running Jourdan on KWPd communication channel 2 for warrants. KWPd dispatch advised me that Jourdan has a warrant for unlawful disposal of trash.

I informed Jourdan that he was under arrest for aggravated assault with a deadly weapon and for the outstanding warrant.

I then transported Jourdan to MCDC without further incident.

This incident was recorded on my BWC.

Jourdan was confrontational with Barnett inside and outside of Walgreens, because she told Jourdan he was being disrespectful towards the employees. Barnett said Jourdan went in and out of Walgreens on numerous occasions and "verbally assaulted" her. Barnett said Neely then told Jourdan to leave her alone. Barnett said she observed the confrontation as it escalated and Jourdan threatening Neely with a knife.

Barnett wrote a sworn witness statement, I placed her statement into KWPD Records Division.

I attempted to talk with Jourdan, as I read Jourdan the Miranda Warning, he kept saying he could not understand me. Jourdan said my accent was too thick and he couldn't understand what I was saying. Det. Diaz then read him the Miranda Warning so Jourdan could understand it better. Jourdan said he still did not understand his rights. Jourdan said he was mentally retarded with an IQ of 8 and dyslexic. Jourdan did spontaneously utter that Neely was way bigger than him and he would have used the knife if he had it.

As I was talking to Jourdan, Ofc. Rhinhart was able to locate the knife that fit the description of the witnesses accounts. I took pictures of the knife and where it was located. I uploaded the photos into KWPD COBAN SYSTEM. I placed the knife into KWPD property/evidence section.

While running Jourdan on KWPD communication channel 2 for warrants. KWPD dispatch advised me that Jourdan has a warrant for unlawful disposal of trash.

I informed Jourdan that he was under arrest for aggravated assault with a deadly weapon and for the outstanding warrant.

I then transported Jourdan to MCDC without further incident.

This incident was recorded on my BWC.
