A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, APPROVING A WORK ORDER UNDER THE CITY'S ENVIRONMENTAL ENGINEERING SERVICES CONTRACT WITH TETRA TECH, IN A TOTAL AMOUNT NOT TO FOR DESIGN, PERMITTING \$172,327.00 AND CONSTRUCTION DOCUMENT PREPARATION TO SUPPORT ARMORING OF THE REST BEACH PERMANENT NECESSARY BUDGET SHORELINE; AUTHORIZING THE WORK ORDER AND TRANSFERS FOR PERMITTING FEES; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, in Resolution No. 14-354, the City Commission approved a three-year Environmental Engineering Services contract with Tetra Tech, Inc.; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That a work order for Design, Permitting and Construction Document Preparation to support permanent armoring the Rest Beach shoreline, under the City's Environmental Engineering Services Contract with Tetra Tech, Inc. is hereby approved in an amount not to exceed \$172,327.00.

Section 2: This project will be funded from account No. 101-1900-519-4600, Rest Beach Seawall (Project IS19001602), and a budget transfer in the amount of \$122,327.00 from Account No. 101-1900-519-3400 (Project EN1407), Rest Beach Seagrass Mitigation is hereby authorized.

Section 3: The City is additionally authorized to pay the
\$8,600.00 Coastal Construction Line Permit application fee from
Account No. 101-1900-519-3400 (Project EN1407), Rest Beach
Seagrass Mitigation.
Section 4: That this Resolution shall go into effect

the signature of the presiding officer and the Clerk of the
Commission.
