	<p>On 1/18/2016, at approximately 1637 hours, Ofc Standerwick and I (Ofc Betz) were on bike patrol near the intersection of Southard and Emma, when I observed a black Toyota Camry, bearing California tag 7FTL689, driving towards us in a reckless manner.</p> <p>The Toyota, which was traveling east, from the Outer Mole area, passed three vehicles, within the intersection of Southard and Noah Lane, at a high rate of speed. The intersection is governed by a three way stop sign, which was violated by the Toyota driver. The vehicle raced towards us, as we</p>

gave loud verbal commands and hand gestures to pull over. The driver, later identified as Paul Galvan, by his California license, complied.

I dismounted my bike and approached the vehicle. As I approached the vehicle, I told Galvan I needed to have his license and registration. Before I could explain why I had stopped him, Galvan opened his driver's door and began to exit the vehicle. As Galvan exited, his two small white dogs, which were seated on his lap, unsecured, ran into the roadway. I ordered Galvan several times to have a seat in his car. Galvan did not comply with my order. I reached out and placed my right hand on Galvan's left shoulder and again ordered him to the car. While dealing with Galvan, a woman walked up to our location and advised Galvan had just "ran over (her) husband's foot". I told Galvan again I needed his license and registration. Galvan began to walk away from me towards the rear of the car. I asked Galvan, "Where are you going?" Galvan continued to walk away from me. I grabbed Galvan by the arm and attempted to detain him. Galvan pulled away from me, at which point I tried to reposition him at the rear of the vehicle, facing away from me, in order to place him into handcuffs.

Ofc Standerwick came to my aid and attempted to help me in detaining Galvan. I told Galvan to "turn around", but Galvan began to scream and refused to comply. Ofc Standerwick and I ordered Galvan to "Stop resisting" several times, but he continued to try to pull away, actively resisting our efforts. We turned Galvan around and leaned him against his vehicle. We attempted to pull Galvan's hands behind his back in order to place him into handcuffs. Galvan continued to pull away in an effort to defeat our attempts at placing him in custody. Through out the encounter, Ofc Standerwick and I gave numerous commands for Galvan not to resist us.

Due to Galvan's resistance, Ofc Standerwick conveyed to me his desire to move Galvan to the ground, so we might have more control of him and place him into custody without injury. We directed Galvan to the ground in a controlled manner. Galvan, who was still screaming " Oh God!" repeatedly, was now facing us. Galvan then began to passively resist us as he extended his legs and arms outward in an effort to keep us from turning him over into a handcuffed position. Ofc Standerwick and I were eventually able to get Galvan turned over onto his stomach and his hands placed into my handcuffs.

We asked Galvan's passenger if Galvan normally acted like this or if he was under the influence. His passenger informed us that he was "just playing" and later described him as a "drama queen".

Sgt Williamson arrived on scene. Sgt Williamson requested paramedics respond to check on Galvan, due to his irrational behavior. Ofc Stockton and Ofc Vazquez of the KWPD Traffic Unit arrived to assist with the crash investigation (16-400096). Ofc Stockton spoke with the victim of the crash and took his statement.

Ofc Standerwick advised me his Coban body camera was broken during the struggle with Galvan, but was still recording.

I spoke with Paramedics and with Sgt Williamson and he decided we should transport Galvan to LKMC for evaluation, as a precautionary measure, in case Galvan ingested any large amounts of narcotics prior to the stop. I road with KWFD and we transported Galvan to LKMC for medical clearance.

Ofc Standerwick met me at the hospital, once Galvan was cleared, and we transported him to MCDL for processing.

	<p>The incident was recorded on my body camera, as well as that of Ofc Standerwick's.</p> <p>Since Galvan did resist my efforts to lawfully detain him, by pulling away from me and Ofc Standerwick, Galvan was in violation of FSS 843.02, resisting without violence.</p> <p>Since Galvan did injure another motorist and flee the scene of the crash, which involved non-serious injury to the motorist, Galvan was in violation of FSS 316.027(2)(a).</p> <p>Since Galvan did travel at a high rate of speed, while passing cars, through an intersection governed by a three way stop sign, with disregard for the stop sign, in an area which is high in pedestrian and bicycle traffic at the time of the incident, Galvan was in violation of FSS 316.192(1)(a), reckless driving.</p>

	<p>1</p> <p>On 1/8/16 at approximately 1637 hours Ofc. Betz and I (Ofc. Standerwick) were on KWPD bike patrol approaching Emma and Southard Street. When we crossed into Southard Street I heard a roar of an engine which caused me to look in the direction of the noise. It was then that I observed a black Toyota Camry heading East from the outer mole passing multiple cars on Southard Street. I saw the Vehicle run a stop sign as it headed in our direction at a high rate of speed on Emma Street. Ofc. Betz shouted at the car to stop which it did on Southard Street. Ofc. Betz approached the Driver while I was positioned in the rear of the vehicle. I attempted to call out a traffic stop however I was unable to get on the air due to radio congestion at that time. While I was attempting to get on the radio I saw, and heard Ofc. Betz instructing the driver (Defendant) of the vehicle to get back in the car multiple times. At this time the Defendant had exited the vehicle and was standing in front of Ofc. Betz I managed to call out our traffic stop and while doing so the wife of the Victim, who was run over by the Defendant, informed me of the Defendant's actions with his car. I informed Ofc. Betz of the Defendant's actions and at this point the Defendant began to walk away from Ofc. Betz toward the rear of his car. I could hear Ofc. Betz ask the Defendant where he was going and he started to follow the Defendant. The Defendant got to the rear of his passenger side of the car. At this point Ofc. Betz attempted to detain the Defendant and he began to actively resist him by pulling away. I assisted Ofc. Betz in attempting to handcuff the Defendant however he kept resisting us by pulling away from us and he refused to follow our lawful commands. The Defendant also began to scream and yell, "Oh God!.. Oh God!" during the encounter. The entire time we were dealing with the Defendant you could hear Ofc. Betz and I yell "Stop resisting, stop resisting!" in an attempt to get the Defendant to come to his senses. At this point I instructed Ofc. Betz that we should take the Defendant to the ground to better control the Defendant. The Defendant was directed to the ground. The Defendant was on his back and Ofc. Betz and I attempted to secure the Defendant. Due to the Defendant's actions my BWC clip which held my camera broke off and my camera fell to the ground. Ofc. Betz and I continued to tell the Defendant to stop resisting, but he was non responsive to our commands. We attempted to roll the Defendant on his back however he kept resisting our attempts. While on the ground with the Defendant I saw my BWC nearby and picked it up. I handed it to a witness nearby, and informed him to direct it at Ofc. Betz and I. The witness who I handed my BWC camera to informed me he knew the Defendant and that he was just "Playing". While on the ground with the Defendant I attempted to check for responsiveness on the Defendant's face but he was still non-responsive. Ofc. Betz got one handcuff on his left wrist and we were able to get the Defendant to a seated position and brought his other arm to his rear and secured the Defendant. Sgt. Williamson arrived and assisted us in bringing the Defendant to his feet. The Defendant was leaned against the rear of his car, and he began to complain about his left wrist. The Defendant's wrist was checked and he was taken to Key West rescue by Ofc. Betz, Ofc. Beeman and I</p>

as we gave loud verbal commands and hand gestures to pull over. The driver, later identified as Paul Galvan, by his California license, complied.

I dismounted my bike and approached the vehicle. As I approached the vehicle, I told Galvan I needed to have his license and registration. Before I could explain why I had stopped him, Galvan opened his driver's door and began to exit the vehicle. As Galvan exited, his two small white dogs, which were seated on his lap, unsecured, ran into the roadway. I ordered Galvan several times to have a seat in his car. Galvan did not comply with my order. I reached out and placed my right hand on Galvan's left shoulder and again ordered him to the car. While dealing with Galvan, a woman walked up to our location and advised Galvan had just "ran over (her) husband's foot". I told Galvan again I needed his license and registration. Galvan began to walk away from me towards the rear of the car. I asked Galvan, "Where are you going?" Galvan continued to walk away from me. I grabbed Galvan by the arm and attempted to detain him. Galvan pulled away from me, at which point I tried to reposition him at the rear of the vehicle, facing away from me, in order to place him into handcuffs.

Ofc Standerwick came to my aid and attempted to help me in detaining Galvan. I told Galvan to "turn around", but Galvan began to scream and refused to comply. Ofc Standerwick and I ordered Galvan to "Stop resisting" several times, but he continued to try to pull away, actively resisting our efforts. We turned Galvan around and leaned him against his vehicle. We attempted to pull Galvan's hands behind his back in order to place him into handcuffs. Galvan continued to pull away in an effort to defeat our attempts at placing him in custody. Through out the encounter, Ofc Standerwick and I gave numerous commands for Galvan not to resist us.

Due to Galvan's resistance, Ofc Standerwick conveyed to me his desire to move Galvan to the ground, so we might have more control of him and place him into custody without injury. We directed Galvan to the ground in a controlled manner. Galvan, who was still screaming "Oh God!" repeatedly, was now facing us. Galvan then began to passively resist us as he extended his legs and arms outward in an effort to keep us from turning him over into a handcuffed position. Ofc Standerwick and I were eventually able to get Galvan turned over onto his stomach and his hands placed into my handcuffs.

We asked Galvan's passenger if Galvan normally acted like this or if he was under the influence. His passenger informed us that he was "just playing" and later described him as a "drama queen".

Sgt Williamson arrived on scene. Sgt Williamson requested paramedics respond to check on Galvan, due to his irrational behavior. Ofc Stockton and Ofc Vazquez of the KWPD Traffic Unit arrived to assist with the crash investigation (16-400096). Ofc Stockton spoke with the victim of the crash and took his statement.

Ofc Standerwick advised me his Coban body camera was broken during the struggle with Galvan, but was still recording.

I spoke with Paramedics and with Sgt Williamson and he decided we should transport Galvan to LKMC for evaluation, as a precautionary measure, in case Galvan ingested any large amounts of narcotics prior to the stop. I road with KWFD and we transported Galvan to LKMC for medical clearance.

Ofc Standerwick met me at the hospital, once Galvan was cleared, and we transported him to MCDC for processing.

The incident was recorded on my body camera, as well as that of Ofc Standerwick's.

Since Galvan did resist my efforts to lawfully detain him, by pulling away from me and Ofc Standerwick, Galvan was in violation of FSS 843.02, resisting without violence.

Since Galvan did injure another motorist and flee the scene of the crash, which involved non-serious injury to the motorist, Galvan was in violation of FSS 316.027(2)(a).

Since Galvan did travel at a high rate of speed, while passing cars, through an intersection governed by a three way stop sign, with disregard for
