I told Harvey that Shepard was going to the hospital and he could go somewhere else. The female was trying to reason with Harvey and Shepard, telling them that was their best move. Harvey told the female that he was Lance Harvey and knew everyone that runs Key West. Ofc. Betz and Ofc. Standerwick arrived. I asked Ofc. Betz if he knew Harvey as he knows everyone who runs Key West. Harvey said, "Can you call Danny or Joe Tripp?" Ofc. Betz asked Harvey what he had been arrested for? Harvey said he has not been arrested. Ofc. Betz told him he look familiar and that's why he was asking. Harvey told Ofc. Betz that he looked familiar because he runs Key West. Ofc. Betz asked Shepard for his identification and he reached into his pocket and tried to remove his wallet. Shepard was uncoordinated and was unable to get his wallet all the way out of his pocket. Ofc. Betz removed his wallet from his pocket and removed his identification card. Ofc. Betz asked Shepard where he was from? Harvey said he was from New Hampshire. Ofc. Betz asked Harvey if he could Shepard. Harvey said, "He is fucking drunk. you don't realize that?" Harvey stated that he had the best Lawyers in town so don't mess with him. Harvey then stated that he knows all of our Chiefs and Captains so don't play with him right now.

Ofc. Standerwick asked Harvey for his identification. Harvey then stated that today was his friends 21st birthday and he thinks someone put something in his drink. I told Harvey that we had established those facts and I asked him for his identification. Harvey said that he did not have his id so are we going to arrest him now? Harvey continued to say he knows all of our bosses and that's all we needed to know. I tried to explain to Harvey this was a simple thing, his friend needs help and that was all he needed to say.

Shepard then began yelling that he had been drinking since he was 16 years old and he was not acting the way he was because he was drunk but because he had been drugged. KWFD Rescue 2 arrived to evaluate Shepard. Shepard became agitated. I told Shepard he could go to the hospital with Rescue or he could go to the jail. I told Shepard those were his two choices. Harvey told Shepard that he was going to go home. I told Harvey he was either going to the hospital or the drunk tank. Harvey said I was smiling and called me an ass hole again. Shepard then yelled take me to the drunk tank. He stood up. I instructed Shepard to sit back down three times. Shepard said, "you sit me down." I placed my hand on Shepard's left shoulder and told him to sit back down. Shepard began moving his body and pulling away from me. I took a firm grasp on Shepard's left shoulder and continued to instruct him to sit down. Shepard pushed my hand off of his shoulder then began swinging both of his hands at me. I grabbed onto the back of his head and neck and directed him to the ground. Once on the ground Shepard reached up and grabbed onto my right testicle. I moved my body back away from him to free myself from his grip. Shepard got back up to his feet and I deployed my Taser. Both of the probes struck Shepard in his upper right chest area. Shepard clenched the right side of his chest and fell to the ground. While My Taser was going through its 5 second cycle Harvey charged towards me with his right arm cocked back and his right fist clenched and it appeared that he was going to punch me. ground and complied with our lawful commands. Harvey crouched over and was backing away from us, ignoring our lawful commands to get onto the ground. I shifted my focus to Harvey as he was still actively resisting Ofc. Standerwick and I. Ofc. Standerwick was giving Harvey loud verbal commands to get on the ground and he still refused. I removed my Taser cartridge from my Taser and positioned myself on Harvey's left side. Harvey refused to comply with our lawful commands. I utilized my OC spray to gain control and compliance. My OC spray was effective and Harvey complied with our lawful commands. Ofc. Standerwick ordered Harvey onto the ground and told him to place his hands behind his back. Harvey complied and Ofc. Standerwick handcuffed him. Once handcuffed I stood Harvey up and walked him over to KWFD Rescue 2 for treatment and evaluation. Harvey was complaining that his eyes hurt and he was burning. KWFD Rescue 2 flushed Harvey's face and eyes with saline .

After Harvey had been treated for OC exposure by KWFD Rescue 2 I walked him over to my marked patrol car and instructed him to lean up against the rear fender of my marked patrol car. I checked Harvey for any additional injuries and did not find any. Harvey still had a Taser probe in his chest and one in his arm. Harvey started screaming then twisted his body and pulled away from me. I told Harvey multiple times to relax and to stop. I regained control of Harvey and pushed him against the rear of my marked patrol car. Harvey was screaming that he could not see and was still feeling the effects of the OC spray. KWFD Rescue 2 came to the back of my marked patrol car and flushed Harvey's eyes with saline again. Due to Harvey's behavior I asked KWFD Rescue 2 if they could remove the Taser probes from Harvey. Medic Daniel Morales removed the Taser probes from Harvey. After the Taser probes were removed Harvey yelled, "My balls are burning." Harvey then banged his head twice on the rear window of my marked patrol car. Again I told him to relax and to stop. I sat Harvey down on the curb and he continued to complain about his ball burning. KWFD Rescue 2 returned and poured saline on Harvey's crotch area. After Harvey's crotch area was flushed I opened the rear door on my marked patrol car to place him into the rear seat. Harvey stood up and I instructed him to sit down in the rear of my marked patrol car. Harvey tensed and twisted his body to resisted my effort to place him in the rear of my marked patrol car. I placed Harvey back onto the curb and told him I was going to have him sit in the rear of my car in the air conditioning to help with the effects of the OC spray. KWFD Rescue 2 returned to Harvey again to evaluate his vitals. Harvey was still acting erratic and complaining that he was burning up. Rescue 2 was unable to get an accurate reading on his vitals. I moved Harvey to the rear of the KWPD transport van so Rescue 2 could get an accurate reading of his vital signs. Rescue 2 was still unable to get an accurate reading of his vitals and advised he would need to go to the hospital for evaluation and treatment.

I walked Harvey to Rescue 2 and rode with them to the Hospital. Harvey was evaluated and treated at Lower Keys Medical Center. Once medically cleared I transported Harvey to MCDC for processing without incident.

I then focused my attention on Harvey. While my Taser was still delivering its 5 second cycle I pointed it at Harvey and drove it into his abdomen and pushed him away from me. Ofc. Betz deployed his Taser at the same time as I drove my Taser into Harvey's abdomen. Harvey continued his aggressive movements towards me. Ofc. Standerwick deployed his Taser at Harvey. Ofc. Betz appeared to have control Shepard then Ofc. Standerwick and I went to take Harvey into custody. made contact with the two, Harvey became adversarial. Ofc. Standerwick and Ofc. Betz arrived to assist with this incident. Due to Shepard's level of intoxication I requested KWFD rescue respond to the scene to evaluate Shepard.

While we were waiting for KWFD Rescue to arrive Harvey became increasingly aggressive. Shepard became increasingly agitated and aggressive. KWFD Rescue 2 arrived to evaluate Shepard. Shepard stood up and I placed my hand on his shoulder to gain control of him. I instructed him to sit down and he pushed my hand off of his shoulder then began swinging his arms at me. I instructed Shepard to sit down and he refused to comply. Shepard continued to swing his arms and hands at me. I grabbed Shepard by the back of his head and directed him to the ground. Shepard went down to the ground then reached up and grabbed on to my right testicle. I quickly moved away from Shepard to free myself from his grasp. Shepard got back up to his feet. I un-holstered my Taser and fired it at Shepard to prevent further harm to both of us. The Taser probes struck Shepard and he fell to the ground.

While I was engaged with Shepard, Harvey stood up and took a fighting stance, and charged at me with his right arm cocked back and his right hand clenched as to throw a punch at me. I then focused my attention on Harvey. While my Taser was still delivering its 5 second cycle I pointed it at Harvey and drove it into his abdomen and pushed him away from me. Ofc. Betz deployed his Taser at the same time as I drove my Taser into Harvey's abdomen. Harvey continued his aggressive movements towards me. Ofc. Standerwick deployed his Taser at Harvey. Ofc. Betz appeared to have control Shepard then Ofc. Standerwick and I went to take Harvey into custody. Harvey was backing away from us and due to his aggressive behavior I utilized my OC spray to gain control and compliance. My OC spray was effective and Harvey became compliant. Ofc. Standerwick Handcuffed Harvey and we walked him over to KWFD Rescue 2 for treatment.
