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Topic ORIGINAL

On February 4, 2016, I was dispatched to the Key West Ferry Terminal, 100 Grinnell Street, Key West, Florida, in reference to an intoxicated person who had been refused entry on to the ferry. Upon arrival, I was directed to the upstairs departures lounge where security was waiting with a white male, later identified as Daniel MORIN. Security told me that the captain of the ferry had refused MORIN to board the vessel due to his extreme intoxication. MORIN had slurred speech, glassy, bloodshot eyes and seemed to have difficulty maintaining his balance. He told me that he needed to get on the ferry in order to get to a rehab facility in Naples, Florida. As I explained that he would not be allowed on the boat, his demeanour deteriorated. His stance became increasingly aggressive, he was clenching his fists and he started shouting. Ofc Medina arrived as back up and we both tried to reason with him, but he continued to shout. Due to his apparent extreme intoxication and increasing aggression, I elected to place him in custody under the Marchman Act for protective custody. Ofc Medina and I made numerous requests to MORIN that he place his hands behind his back and he continued to refuse, saying, "That's not going to happen". He was flexing his muscles, balling his fists and he continued to shout, so I pulled out my Taser device and I turned it on, pointing it at him. I also requested additional officers, as MORIN looked as if he would resist if force was applied. Ofcs Vazquez, Hartle and Sgt Allen arrived and we continued to attempt to gain voluntary compliance from MORIN, employing verbal judo tactics and appealing to him to see sense.

After approximately thirty minutes of diplomacy, Sgt Allen was able to convince MORIN to allow himself to be handcuffed. We placed him in the back of my patrol car, I activated my COBAN in-car recording system and I started driving to the Monroe County Detention Center. While en route, MORIN started to behave aggressively again and he began to shout and scream and it appeared as if he was trying to free himself from the handcuffs (due to his size, we had applied two pairs). He then managed to maneuver himself so that he was lying supine on the back seat and he started to kick at the partition with tremendous force so that the car was shaking. He then adjusted himself so that he was kicking at the rear passenger side window and he kicked at the window repeatedly with force. He was also screaming very loudly and I notified dispatch of the situation. Due to the potential for injury that MORIN's actions were presenting, I pulled over into the parking lot of Banner Tire, 2312 N Roosevelt Blvd and informed dispatch. I exited the car and walked to the passenger side, where MORIN continued to kick and scream. Ofcs Medina and Vazquez both arrived to assist and I opened the right rear door, as Ofc Medina approached me with a hobble restraint. MORIN sat up and tried to exit the car, screaming, "Fuck you, you think you're tough?" I pushed him back into the car, ordering him to stay in the car. He started to kick with both feet and Ofc Vazquez used the drive-stun feature on his Taser device, pushing it against MORIN's chest. He continued to try and get out of the car and both Ofc Medina and Ofc Vazquez applied drive-stuns to MORIN (see their supplemental reports) and I requested the prisoner transport van. I threatened to pepper spray MORIN if he kept trying to get out and he repeatedly kicked at me as I tried to subdue him. I managed to evade all of the attempted kicks. Ofcs Clark and Ane also arrived to assist. We managed to apply the hobble restraint to MORIN's ankles and he continued to scream and issue threats.

Sgt Allen arrived with the prisoner transport van and MORIN was carried to the side compartment. He tried to kick the door back out, but once he was secured inside the van, Sgt Allen drove to the jail and

Ofc Medina and I followed. I requested that deputies meet us in the sallyport and Ofc Allen also requested a restraint chair. Once we had arrived at the jail, Sgt Allen opened the door to the van and MORIN was asleep. Corrections deputies met us in the sallyport and once MORIN had awoken, he kicked at Sgt Allen, but he managed to avoid the kicks. He was carried out of the van and placed in the restraint chair, but he continued to resist the deputies attempts to restrain him. Once he was effectively restrained, deputies wheeled him upstairs for processing.

My body-worn camera was activated through all encounters with MORIN.

SUPPLEMENTAL

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On Thursday, February 04, 2016, at approximately 1620 hours, Officer T. Stevens and I (Officer G. Medina) responded to 100 Grinnell Street (Ferry terminal) in reference to initially an intoxicated male individual (later identified as Daniel Morin) who was so intoxicated that the Captain did not want to allow him to board the boat.

Upon my arrival, I saw Officer T. Stevens already on scene next to a security/crew officer and the subject Daniel Morin.

I heard Officer T. Stevens give clear, loud commands for Morin to comply to his directions. I noticed Morin had blood shot red eyes, slurring his speech, and unsteady on his feet. Due to my training and experience I was aware that Morin's judgment was highly impaired to due some sort of substance abuse.

I initiated my COBAN body worn camera during the encounter. It was on till the subject was placed into the patrol vehicle. It was later uploaded to the COBAN server at the Monroe County Jail.

We attempted several times for Morin to listen to our directions and commands. We were asking Morin to turn around and place his hands behind his back, so that we could place him in handcuffs under our protective custody as a Marchman. However, due his level of impairment he would not comply and began shouting and balling his fists in a clenching manner. We stated several times to Morin that if he did not comply to our commands that he would be Tazed.

Officer T. Stevens was in possession of my Tazer, while we were attempting to have Morin comply to our commands. Morin continued to resist our directions and Officer T. Stevens requested additional

units to our location due to the level of impairment and resistance of Morin.

Morin was a large muscular individual who was denying any assistance from our lawful authority and illustrated zero compliance.

Officer B. Vazquez arrived on scene first and continued to give lawful direction to Morin to comply, however to no avail as well.

Officer R. Hartle arrived on scene and also attempted to speak with Morin, which was also to no effect.

Sergeant R. Allen arrived on scene and began speaking with Morin. Sergeant R. Allen was able to get Morin in handcuffs without incident.

Morin was placed into Officer T. Steven's patrol vehicle and was being transported to Monroe County Jail under the Marchman Act.

All officers left the scene after Officer T. Stevens was transporting Morin to Monroe County Jail. During the transportation I heard Officer T. Stevens over Key West Communications that the subject (Morin) was resisting inside the vehicle and attempting to kick out his patrol vehicle window. Officer T. Stevens stated he was going to pull over to the side of the road (Banner Tire- North Roosevelt Blvd).

I informed Dispatch that I would be enroute to his location with a hobble device. It is a restraining device placed around the subject's feet to ensure that he would be unable to harm anyone with his feet.

Officer B. Vazquez arrived on scene. We attempted to get Morin to calm himself and comply to our lawful directions and commands again. Morin was shouting and attempting to get up and out of the patrol vehicle when attempting to place the hobble device on his feet. Officer B. Vazquez pulled out his Tazer device, while Officer T. Stevens pulled out his other non-lethal device (Pepper Spray) and warned him several times to comply. Morin failed to comply and was drive stunned with Officer B. Vazquez's Tazer device.

Drive stun is placing the device on the resisting subject without the Tazer cartridge attached.

Morin continued to disobey and resist during the struggle and was drive stunned in the upper torso area by my Tazer device. Again the cartridge was detached. Further resistance consisted with a second drive stun to the subject's right calf region. During the struggle the subject's feet were kicking about and almost struck Officer T. Stevens.

Officer T. Ane and Officer T. Clark arrived on scene during the encounter at some point and assisted in placing the Hobble device on the subject's feet. I assisted in handing over the hobble end to Officer T. Ane, so that he could clamp unto the passenger side door frame area.

Sergeant R. Allen arrived with the transport van.

We then gently placed Morin unto the ground from the patrol vehicle and picked him up. We then placed him into the side door area of the transport van with me holding his right shoulder area. Officer T. Ane was holding his left shoulder area, while other officers were holding his feet and legs. I went

inside the transport van, so that I could have the leverage to place Morin inside the van as safely as possible.

The only visible injury I noticed was a small amount of blood (abrasion) to his left knee area.

I then followed both Sergeant R. Allen and Officer T. Stevens to Monroe County Jail. I provided my Tazer device to Sergeant R. Allen, so that the evidentiary value could be documented. I took photographs of the subject, while he was already placed and secured in the restraining chair. I sent the photographs to Sergeant R. Allen for documentation and evidence.

On February 4th, 2016 at about 1620 hours, I, Ofc. B Vazquez responded to 100 Grinnell Street (Ferry Terminal), in reference Ofc. Medina and Ofc. Stevens, who were requesting back up.

Upon arrival, I observed Ofc. Stevens, pointing his Department issued Taser, at a white male later identified by his MA DL as Daniel S Morin. Morin appeared to be irate and belligerent. Morin refused to comply with any of Ofc. Stevens verbal commands. Morin eventually complied and was placed into handcuffs by Sgt. Allen.

I along with other officers on scene, walked Morin to Ofc. Stevens patrol vehicle. Ofc. Stevens advised he would be en-route to the county jail. I cleared the scene.

A few minutes later Ofc. Stevens, advised over our police radio, that Morin was attempting to kick out his back window. Ofc. Stevens said he was pulling over on the 2300 block of North Roosevelt Blvd. I responded to his location.

Upon arrival, I observed Ofc. Stevens speaking with Morin. Morin appeared to be even more irate and belligerent. Ofc. Stevens advised he needed to put a hobble restraint on Morin, and would need him to turn his body, so we could put the hobble restraint on Morin's feet. Without reason, Morin attempted to exit the back of Ofc. Stevens patrol vehicle, by turning his body and moving his shoulder towards Ofc. Stevens and I. I gave loud verbal commands for Morin to stay in the car. Morin verbally and physically refused my loud verbal commands to stay in the car, and defeated my efforts in controlling the situation. Morin began to kick at Ofc. Stevens and I. I removed my duty issued Taser x26P, from its holster, removed the cartridge and gave Morin a cartridge off drive stun to his chest area. Morin began to spit and scream obscenities to the officers on scene. Morin immediately fell on his back, and began to kick and scream at the officers on scene again. Morin moved from his back, to a seating position and attempted to exit the patrol vehicle. I gave Morin another cartridge off drive stun. Morin fell back on his back and began to kick at us again. Morin then proceeded to stand up and attempted to exit the rear of the patrol car, I gave loud verbal commands for Morin, to sit down. Morin refused to sit down, I gave Morin another cartridge off drive stun. Morin proceeded to stand up for a second time. I gave loud verbal commands for Morin to have a seat. He refused again to sit down. I gave another cartridge off drive stun. Officers on scene were eventually able to place the hobble restraint on Morin and place him in the KWPD transport van.

I responded to his location. Upon arrival, I saw several Officers standing at the rear of Ofc. T. Steven's patrol vehicle. I saw Morin sitting up right in the back seat. Morin's demeanor was aggressive and he was incoherently cursing at the Officers in front of him. Ofc. B. Vazquez gave Morin several verbal commands to stay in the vehicle. Morin ignored Ofc. B. Vazquez's commands and attempted to stand, when Ofc. B. Vazquez conducted a drive stun (Cartridge Off) with his department issue TASER. (see supplemental)

Morin then laid on his back in the rear seat of the vehicle. Ofc. T. Clark and I grabbed Morin's legs and placed his legs in a hobble restraint, until Sgt. Allen arrived on scene with the KWPD Transport Van.

Ofc. T. Clark, Ofc. G. Medina, Ofc. B. Vazquez and I placed Morin in the rear seat of the Transport Van.

Morin was transported to MCDC.

My department issue body worn camera captured my involvement in this investigation. I later uploaded the video to the COBAN server.

No further action.

person who had been refused entry on to the ferry. Upon arrival, I was directed to the upstairs departures lounge where security was waiting with a white male, later identified as Daniel MORIN. Security told me that the captain of the ferry had refused MORIN to board the vessel due to his extreme intoxication. MORIN had slurred speech, glassy, bloodshot eyes and seemed to have difficulty maintaining his balance. He told me that he needed to get on the ferry in order to get to a rehab facility in Naples, Florida. As I explained that he would not be allowed on the boat, his demeanour deteriorated. His stance became increasingly aggressive, he was clenching his fists and he started shouting. Ofc Medina arrived as back up and we both tried to reason with him, but he continued to shout. Due to his apparent extreme intoxication and increasing aggression, I elected to place him in custody under the Marchman Act for protective custody. Ofc Medina and I made numerous requests to MORIN that he place his hands behind his back and he continued to refuse, saying, "That's not going to happen". He was flexing his muscles, balling his fists and he continued to shout, so I pulled out my Taser device and I turned it on, pointing it at him. I also requested additional officers, as MORIN looked as if he would resist if force was applied. Ofcs Vazquez, Hartle and Sgt Allen arrived and we continued to attempt to gain voluntary compliance from MORIN, employing verbal judo tactics and appealing to him to see sense.

After approximately thirty minutes of diplomacy, Sgt Allen was able to convince MORIN to allow himself to be handcuffed. We placed him in the back of my patrol car, I activated my COBAN in-car recording system and I started driving to the Monroe County Detention Center. While en route, MORIN started to behave aggressively again and he began to shout and scream and it appeared as if he was trying to free himself from the handcuffs (due to his size, we had applied two pairs). He then managed to maneuver himself so that he was lying supine on the back seat and he started to kick at the partition with tremendous force so that the car was shaking. He then adjusted himself so that he was kicking at the rear passenger side window and he kicked at the window repeatedly with force. He was also screaming very loudly and I notified dispatch of the situation. Due to the potential for injury that MORIN's actions were presenting, I pulled over into the parking lot of Banner Tire, 2312 N Roosevelt Blvd and informed dispatch. I exited the car and walked to the passenger side, where MORIN continued to kick and scream. Ofcs Medina and Vazquez both arrived to assist and I opened the right rear door, as Ofc Medina approached me with a hobble restraint. MORIN sat up and tried to exit the car, screaming, "Fuck you, you think you're tough?" I pushed him back into the car, ordering him to stay in the car. He started to kick with both feet and Ofc Vazquez used the drive-stun feature on his Taser device, pushing it against MORIN's chest. He continued to try and get out of the car and both Ofc Medina and Ofc Vazquez applied drive-stuns to MORIN (see their supplemental reports) and I requested the prisoner transport van. I threatened to pepper spray MORIN if he kept trying to get out and he repeatedly kicked at me as I tried to subdue him. I managed to evade all of the attempted kicks. Ofcs Clark and Ane also arrived to assist. We managed to apply the hobble restraint to MORIN's ankles and he continued to scream and issue threats.

Sgt Allen arrived with the prisoner transport van and MORIN was carried to the side compartment. He tried to kick the door back out, but once he was secured inside the van, Sgt Allen drove to the jail and Ofc Medina and I followed. I requested that deputies meet us in the sallyport and Ofc Allen also requested a restraint chair. Once we had arrived at the jail, Sgt Allen opened the door to the van and MORIN was asleep. Corrections deputies met us in the sallyport and once MORIN had awoken, he kicked at Sgt Allen, but he managed to avoid the kicks. He was carried out of the van and placed in the restraint chair, but he continued to resist the deputies attempts to restrain him. Once he was effectively restrained, deputies wheeled him upstairs for processing.

My body-worn camera was activated through all encounters with MORIN.
