	<p>On 02/29/2016, Officer C. Rhinhart and I (Officer T. Calvert) responded to 6450 Jr College Road response to a white male laying on the sidewalk. The call came in from a concerned citizen who was jogging in the area.</p> <p>Officer Rhinhart recognized the male laying on the sidewalk as Thomas Matteodo. Matteodo had been transported to the ER about two hours earlier because he was to drunk to be Marchman Acted. Matteodo was told by Officer Rhinhart to sit on the sidewalk. Officer Rhinhart was explaining to Matteodo that he would now have to be Marchman Acted. Matteodo became upset. Because of Matteodo's angry response to this information, I activated my taser and pointed it at Matteodo. Matteodo continued to get more angry. Matteodo said we would be ruining his life because he would lose his job. Matteodo began standing up and moving quickly in my direction, in a lunging fashion. I told Matteodo to sit down but nearly immediately after telling him to sit down I deployed my taser striking Matteodo in his right shoulder area. Matteodo continued to step into my direction until eventually falling to the ground. Matteodo was placed into handcuffs moments later.</p> <p>Prior to Matteodo being tased Matteodo was sitting near the center of the sidewalk. The sidewalk is about eight feet wide. I was standing about two feet into the street from the sidewalk. Matteodo stood up quickly moving towards me closing the distance to myself by what seemed to be about half. Matteodo continued to move in my direction after being struck by the taser and fell to the ground past where I was standing. Based on Matteodo's increasingly agitated state I felt that Matteodo was getting up to confront me physically. This encounter was recorded by my BWC and taser video. My COBAN in-car recording system was not activated.</p> <p>Key West Rescue 3 and Sgt F. Duponty arrived moments later. Key West Rescue treated Matteodo on scene. Matteodo had two probe puncture marks on his right shoulder and he had some small abrasions on his elbows and knees. Sgt. Duponty photographed Matteodo. Officer Rhinhart removed the taser probes from Matteodo's shoulder. I collected the taser cartridge, wires, blast doors, 4 AFIDS and the probes. I submitted the taser cartridge and pieces into KWPD Property. Sgt. Duponty uploaded the photos to the COBAN DPM and provided me a disk of the taser video which I submitted to KWPD Property. My BWC video was uploaded to the COBAN DPM.</p> <p>Matteodo is being charged with resisting officers with violence, a violation of F. S.S. 893.09(4). Matteodo did knowingly and willfully resist lawful orders to stay seated. By standing up quickly in a lunging fashion Matteodo resisted these orders in a way that offered to do violence to me.</p>

	1	<p>On 02/29/2016, I Ofc. C. Rhinhart and Ofc. T. Calvert responded to 6450 Jr. College Road response to a white male laying on the sidewalk. The call came in from a concerned citizen who was jogging in the area.</p> <p>I recognized the white male laying on the sidewalk as Thomas Matteodo. Matteodo had been transported to the ER about two hours earlier because he was too intoxicated to be Marchman Acted. I woke up Matteodo and told Matteodo to sit up on the sidewalk. I explained to Matteodo that he would now have to be Marchman Acted due to his level of intoxication. Matteodo became instantly upset and agitated. Because of Matteodo's angry response to this information, Ofc. T. Calvert activated his department issued Taser and pointed it at Matteodo. Matteodo continued to get more angry and agitated with our interaction with him. Matteodo verbalized to Ofc. T. Calvert and I that we would be ruining his life because he would lose his job if he was transported to the Monroe County Detention Center to sober up. Matteodo then began standing up and moving quickly towards Ofc. T. Calvert's direction, in an aggressive manner. Ofc. T. Calvert told Matteodo to sit down, but Matteodo continued towards Ofc. T. Calvert. Ofc. T. Calvert deployed his department issued Taser striking Matteodo in what appeared to be Matteodo's right shoulder area. Matteodo continued to advance towards Ofc. T. Calvert until Matteodo fell to the asphalt on College Rd. after being tased once. I then contacted Key West Dispatch for Key West Rescue to respond and notified an on duty supervisor. I then gave Matteodo loud verbal commands to roll over and put his hands behind his back or he would be tased again. Matteodo complied by rolling over and put his hands behind his back. I handcuffed Matteodo and sat him up in a sitting position with his legs crossed.</p> <p>Key West Rescue #3 arrived on scene a short time later. Key West Rescue #3 treated Matteodo for minor abrasions on his elbows and knees. Key west Rescue #3 also evaluated the area on Matteodo's right shoulder area where the Taser probes made contact.</p> <p>Sgt. F. Duponty arrived on scene moments later and took digital photographs of Matteodo's minor injuries and the Taser probe placement.</p> <p>After Matteodo was evaluated and released on scene by Key West Rescue #3, I removed the Taser probes per Key West Police Department policy. I gave the Taser probes to Ofc. T. Calvert to be logged and stored as evidence.</p>
