A summary of the agreement reached between the parties is as follows:

*Defendant Florida Department of Transportation shall pay
\$10,000 to Plaintiffs in full satisfaction of Plaintiffs' claims.
Subject to the approval of the City Commission, City of Key West
shall pay \$100,000 to Plaintiffs in full satisfaction of Plaintiffs'
claims. Plaintiffs shall be responsible for restoring all medical
subrogation and reimbursement claims. Plaintiffs shall
execute a release of all claims in favor of the Florida Dept
of Transportation and City of Key West. Upon payment of
the settlement funds this case shall be dismissed with*
