Due to the client's request for work outside the original scope of services, Calvin, Giordano & Associates, Inc. will provide the following additional services:

## I. **Professional Planning Services**

Provided as Exhibit A is the revised schedule which includes the four (4) A. additional workshops as requested; highlighted as Phases 12-17. The intent is to present not only the draft language related to these items but also include substantial graphics, when appropriate, to convey the suggested intent and/or result of the proposed regulations. In addition, we have also included the possibility of an additional Planning Board Meeting, perhaps the evening after the August 18, 2016 scheduled meeting. The intent is to split up the review into two groups, Group 1 would include all of the "cleanup" items and Group 2 would be all of the amendments related to the major issues. The fee for the four (4) additional workshops is \$26,750 which represents 190 hours of work split between Planning, Traffic Engineering and Landscape/Urban Design; approximately \$6,687.50 per workshop or 19% of the original contract amount.
