A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING AND APPROVING THE REPLACEMENT AND RELOCATION OF A MEMORIAL PLAQUE TO SMATHERS BEACH ACCESS POINT #6 TO COMMEMORATE DIANA NYAD'S HISTORIC SWIM FROM CUBA TO KEY WEST; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, in Resolution 14-221, the City Commission approved a memorial plaque to commemorate the date and location where long-distance swimmer Diana Nyad arrived at Smathers Beach, at the end of her record-breaking 110-mile swim from Cuba to Key West on September 2, 2013; and

WHEREAS, at its meeting of April 11, 2016, the Art in Public Places Board (AIPP) recommended removal and placement of the memorial plaque at a more historically accurate location on Smathers Beach; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the Key West City Commission approves and authorizes the removal and replacement of a memorial plaque to commemorate Diana Nyad's historic swim on City property at Smathers Beach from Access Point #11 to Access Point #6.
