

RESOLUTION NO. 15-015

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE SOLE-SOURCE PURCHASE OF 60 TASER X26Ps WITH TASER HD CAMs, ASSOCIATED ACCESSORIES AND A FIVE-YEAR TASER ASSURANCE PLAN (TAP), PURSUANT TO CITY ORDINANCES SEC. 2-797(1)(A) AND SEC. 2-844 (A)&(B) FROM TASER INTERNATIONAL INC. IN A TOTAL AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$161,816.00, PLUS THE RETURN/DESTRUCTION OF 60 TASER X26E TASERS; APPROVING THE USE OF STATE POLICE FORFEITURE FUNDS FOR THE PURCHASE; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, Florida Statutes section 932.7055 provides authority for the expenditure of state police forfeiture funds;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the purchase of 60 Taser X26Ps, with Taser HD Cams, associated accessories, and a five-year TAP, pursuant to Key West Code of Ordinances sections 2-797(1)(a) and 2-844 (a) & (b), in a total amount not to exceed \$161,816.00, plus the return/destruction of 60 Taser X26E Tasers, in accordance with the December 9, 2014 quotation from TASER International, Inc. is hereby approved.

Section 2: That state forfeiture funds (Law Enforcement Trust Fund) are authorized and budgeted for this purchase in the FY 14/15 Police Department Budget (Budget line 172-2111-521-6400).

Section 3: That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signature of the presiding officer and the Clerk of the Commission.
