

Green Commute Challengers Southernmost Beach Resort

During the week of March 28th to April 3rd, eleven of the largest employers within the City of Key West took the Green Commuting Challenge, whereby employees earned points for how they commuted to work. The highlights for those that rose to the challenge are:

City of Key West: Most self-powered employees commuting five days in a row;

- **First State Bank**: 3rd place in employers with 100-399 employees; 4th place in participation;
- Florida Keys Mosquito Control: The only employer with 100% participation;
- Florida Department of Health: 2nd place overall; 1st place in employers <99 employees Highest % of Fuel Efficient Cars; 2nd place for 80% participation;
- Florida Keys Community College: 3rd place overall; Highest % of employees carpooling;
 - **Kevs Energy Services:** Tied for 1st for longest distance bicycled;
 - **Lower Keys Medical Center**: Highest % of motorcycles/scooters; 2nd place carpools;
- Monroe County School District Admin: 3rd place in employers <99 employees;
- **Tropical Soup Group**: 1st place in employers >400; Highest % of walkers and bikers;
- **US Coast Guard** KW: 3rd place in participation; and, the best performing employer of all:

Grand Prize winner: Southernmost Beach Resort: Highest average commute score; 1st place in employers with 100-399 employees, and; Highest percentage of bussers.
