

in-place concrete cap. A floating concrete dock system anchored with 14" precast concrete piles, and finished with 118 - 12" diameter wood mooring piles, equipped with electrical, water, sewer and fire services. Upland work includes underground utility services feeding the dock system, a new paver sidewalk, four (4) dock entry kiosk structures, over 100 electrical bollard lights, and the associated seawall landscaping. The new Dock Master facility includes a new 1-story dock master building structure designed with an office, lounge, men & women's restrooms, and laundry facilities for the boat owners. The facility is enclosed with an aluminum fence, a new Pavilion structure, and finished with architectural features including multiple benches, trash cans, BBQ grills, picnic tables, and an electronic fish cleaning and grinding facility.


