A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING PURSUANT TO SECTIONS 2-797(4)(b), BEST INTERESTS OF THE CITY AND 2-844(a)(b) BRAND NAME SPECIFICATIONS OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES, THE PURCHASE OF TWENTY-FOUR (24) ZEBRA E-TRAFFIC CITATION PRINTERS AND ACCESSORIES FOR THE ENHANCEMENT AND UPGRADE OF THE POLICE DEPARTMENT'S ELECTRONIC TRAFFIC TICKET WRITING SYSTEM FROM BARCODES, INC. IN THE AMOUNT OF \$24,928.80; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, Section 2-796 of the Code of Ordinances requires competitive bidding for purchases or services in excess of \$20,000.00; and

WHEREAS, the Police Department has been using Zebra handheld electronic traffic citation products for several years with satisfactory results, and has identified a need to replace and upgrade some of the equipment because it is approaching the end of useful service life; and

WHEREAS, Key West Code of Ordinances section 2-797(4)(b) further provides "If in the opinion of the city manager exceptional circumstances exist to exempt a purchase from the competitive bid requirements of this subdivision for the best interests of the city, he shall place a resolution before the city commission for approval of such exemption."; and

WHEREAS, City staff obtained three written price quotes, and believes that a lower unit cost would not result from sealed bidding procedures; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager has recommended the waiver of formal bidding procedures pursuant to section 2-797(4)(b) of the Code of Ordinances; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST:

Section 1: That the expenditure of funds in an amount not to exceed \$24,928.80 to Barcodes, Inc., for the purchase of 24 ZEBRA ZQ520 4" Thermal Mobile Printers and related accessories, is hereby authorized pursuant to section 2-797(4)(b) and 2-844(a)(b) of the Code of Ordinances.

Section 2: That funding for this purchase is included in FY 15/16 Police Budget account #101-2101-521-6400.

Section 3: That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signature of the Presiding Officer and the Clerk of the Commission.
