On 04/21/2016, at approximately 1940 hours, I (Det. M. Siracuse) along with Det. H. del Valle were traveling eastbound on Flagler Avenue near the intersection of Kennedy Drive and Flagler Avenue. We were in an unmarked police vehicle equipped with emergency lights and a siren.

As I drove, I noticed a 1997 Toyota bearing Florida tag Y11EAA driving eastbound beside us. As I looked over, I could see the windshield was cracked directly in front of the driver, obstructing his field of vision. I pulled behind the vehicle as it began to make a northbound turn on 14th Street. As the vehicle turned on 14th Street, I activated my emergency lights and siren and initiated a traffic stop.

The vehicle came to a stop near the intersection of 14th Street and Harriet Avenue. I immediately noticed the passenger moving around excessively. I exited our police vehicle and began approaching the driver's side of the Toyota. As I was about to approach the vehicle I saw the front passenger side door open and a black male, later identified as Markease Kendrell Humphrey, began running from the vehicle. Humphrey ran eastbound on Harriet Avenue and I immediately began chasing him on foot. As I chased Humphrey, I continuously gave loud clear verbal commands identifying myself as police and telling him to stop running. Humphrey ignored my commands and continued running eastbound on Harriet Avenue. As Humphrey ran, he took off a black sweatshirt and dropped it in the roadway. I watched Humphrey's hands as he ran, and did not see him drop anything else and he did not appear to be armed.

I continued chasing Humphrey until he turned northbound on 15th Street and ran into the intersection of 15th Street and Duck Avenue. Humphrey ran across Duck Avenue and onto the sidewalk that runs along the northbound side of Duck Avenue. Once on the sidewalk, Humphrey began running westbound. As I grew closer, I could see Humphrey had unknown items clenched in his left hand and nothing in his right hand.

Off duty KWPD Officer J. Castillo was in the immediate area when the traffic stop initiated and saw Humphrey run from us. Ofc. Castillo happened to be driving eastbound on Duck Avenue when Humphrey crossed the intersection on 15th Street and Duck Avenue. Ofc. Castillo turned his personal vehicle in front of Humphrey, slightly slowing him down as he had to squeeze between Ofc. Castillo's vehicle and a concrete wall. At that time I had caught up to Humphrey, grabbed him by his upper body. and placed him on the ground. Officer Castillo exited his vehicle and assisted me in detaining Humphrey. Just prior to me grabbing Humphrey's left hand, I saw him place a black phone and a cigarette carton under Ofc. Castillo's truck, only a couple feet from where he was laying. I grabbed his left wrist and along with Ofc. Castillo, placed Humphrey in handcuffs.

As I looked over, I could see a clear plastic bag sticking out of the cigarette carton. I picked up the cell phone and cigarette carton and removed a large bag of what appeared to be crack cocaine from the carton. Det. H. del Valle and additional KWPD patrol units arrived on scene. Ofc. Castillo and I stood Humphrey up and leaned him against a concrete wall. Humphrey was having difficulty breathing and began spitting. Humphrey then spit a small slab of crack cocaine onto the hood of Ofc. Castillo's vehicle. It appeared Humphrey had put crack cocaine in his mouth and possibly attempted to eat the crack cocaine at some point during the incident. I asked Humphrey if he had ingested any additional crack cocaine and he said no. I had him open his mouth and I did not see any further narcotics. I asked Humphrey if he had a warrant for his arrest and he said yes, for a misdemeanor. KWPD Communications confirmed Humphrey's warrant.

Humphrey asked that an ambulance respond to the scene to check on his wellbeing. KWPD rescue 3 arrived on scene. Sgt. B. Lariz also arrived on scene and met with Humphrey. KWPD rescue 3 along with Ofc. Gaufillet transported Humphrey to the Lower Keys Medical Center (LKMC) for medical clearance.

Sgt. Lariz said when he was on scene he asked Humphrey what heappened and Humhprey said, "I ran from the officer."Huphrey also told Sgt. Lariz that he was not injured. This conversation was recorded on Sgt. Lariz's body worn camera, BWC.

Det. H. del Valle and I returned to the original traffic stop and met with the driver of the vehicle, identified by his Indiana driver's license as Nicholas Adam Reed. Det. H. del Valle issued Reed a citation (A4QVDHE) for an equipment violation reference his cracked windshield (F.S.S. 316. 810(1)). I gave the narcotics to Det. K. Malsheimer who had also arrived on scene and asked that he place them into the KWPD property section as evidence. Det. Malsheimer later informed me the weight of the crack cocaine was 19.6 grams and the small slab Humphrey had spit out weighed .1 grams. Det. Malsheimer also advised me he field tested the suspected crack cocaine and it field tested positive. In my training and experience as a narcotics detective, 19.6 grams of crack cocaine far exceeds that which would be considered personal use.

Humphrey's incident began at the intersection of 14th Street and Harriet Avenue, and ended at the intersection of Duck Avenue and 15th Street. Both locations are well within 1000 feet of the Wicker sports complex, a publicly owned recreational facility.

I met with Humphrey at the LKMC. When I first saw Humphrey I jokingly said, "You know, you're supposed to ditch the dope while you're running." Humphrey immediately replied, "How can I ditch the dope if I couldn't ditch you?" I read Humphrey his rights and he waived his rights, agreeing to speak to me without a lawyer present. The first question I asked Humphrey was if he ran because of the warrant or the dope. Humphrey told me it was because of the dope. After only a few more questions, Humphrey told me he no longer wanted to speak to me about it. I recorded this interview on my body worn camera (BWC).

Once medically cleared, Ofc. Gaufillet transported Humphrey to the Monroe County Detention Center (MCDC) without further incident. I photographed Humphrey at the MCDC reference the KWPD response to resistance incident report. The only visible injury I saw on Humphrey was minor scratches on his right forearm. I placed the disc of photos in property as evidence.

Humphrey's Charges:

Possession of cocaine with intent to sell within 1000' of a recreational facility. Humphrey was detained well within 1000' of the Wicker sports complex. During the incident, numerous children were present at that complex playing sports. Upon his arrest, Humphrey was found to be in possession of 19.7 grams of FTP crack cocaine. That amount is consistent with street level narcotics sales, not personal use. Humphrey acted in violation of F.S.S. 893.13(1)(c)(1).

Evidence - Tampering with or destroying evidence. Humphrey fled on foot and when asked why (post Miranda), admitted it was because of the dope. It was Humphrey's intention to ditch or hide the crack cocaine as he ran, however he did not get the opportunity. Additionally, upon his arrest, Humphrey spit out a piece of crack cocaine and asked for rescue to respond. By putting crack cocaine in his mouth and later spitting it out, Humphrey attempted to hide and/or destroy evidence. Humphrey did so in violation of F.S.S. 918.13.

Resisting an officer without violence. Humphrey, who as a passenger of a vehicle is lawfully detained during a traffic stop, fled from the vehicle on foot and ignored a law enforcement officer's lawful order to stop. Humphrey acted in violation of F.S.S. 843.02.

Violation of probation reference DWLS (Warrant). Humphrey had an active arrest warrant reference violation of probation (F.S.S. 948).

This incident was recorded on my BWC and is cleared by arrest.

cracked directly in front of the driver, obstructing his field of vision. I pulled behind the vehicle as it began to make a northbound turn on 14th Street. As the vehicle turned on 14th Street, I activated my emergency lights and siren and initiated a traffic stop.

The vehicle came to a stop near the intersection of 14th Street and Harriet Avenue. I immediately noticed the passenger moving around excessively. I exited our police vehicle and began approaching the driver's side of the Toyota. As I was about to approach the vehicle I saw the front passenger side door open and a black male, later identified as Markease Kendrell Humphrey, began running from the vehicle. Humphrey ran eastbound on Harriet Avenue and I immediately began chasing him on foot. As I chased Humphrey, I continuously gave loud clear verbal commands identifying myself as police and telling him to stop running. Humphrey ignored my commands and continued running eastbound on Harriet Avenue. As Humphrey ran, he took off a black sweatshirt and dropped it in the roadway. I watched Humphrey's hands as he ran, and did not see him drop anything else and he did not appear to be armed.

I continued chasing Humphrey until he turned northbound on 15th Street and ran into the intersection of 15th Street and Duck Avenue. Humphrey ran across Duck Avenue. Once on the sidewalk, Humphrey began running westbound. As I grew closer, I could see Humphrey had unknown items clenched in his left hand and nothing in his right hand.

Off duty KWPD Officer J. Castillo was in the immediate area when the traffic stop initiated and saw Humphrey run from us. Ofc. Castillo happened to be driving eastbound on Duck Avenue when Humphrey crossed the intersection on 15th Street and Duck Avenue. Ofc. Castillo turned his personal vehicle in front of Humphrey, slightly slowing him down as he had to squeeze between Ofc. Castillo's vehicle and a concrete wall. At that time I had caught up to Humphrey, grabbed him by his upper body, and placed him on the ground. Officer Castillo exited his vehicle and assisted me in detaining Humphrey. Just prior to me grabbing Humphrey's left hand, I saw him place a black phone and a cigarette carton under Ofc. Castillo's truck, only a couple feet from where he was laying. I grabbed his left wrist and along with Ofc. Castillo, placed Humphrey in handcuffs.

As I looked over, I could see a clear plastic bag sticking out of the cigarette carton. I picked up the cell phone and cigarette carton and removed a large bag of what appeared to be crack cocaine from the carton. Det. H. del Valle and additional KWPD patrol units arrived on scene. Ofc. Castillo and I stood Humphrey up and leaned him against a concrete wall. Humphrey was having difficulty breathing and began spitting. Humphrey then spit a small slab of crack cocaine onto the hood of Ofc. Castillo's vehicle. It appeared Humphrey had put crack cocaine in his mouth and possibly attempted to eat the crack cocaine at some point during the incident. I asked Humphrey if he had ingested any additional crack cocaine and he said no. I had him open his mouth and I did not see any further narcotics. I asked Humphrey if he had a warrant for his arrest and he said yes, for a misdemeanor. KWPD Communications confirmed Humphrey's warrant.

Humphrey asked that an ambulance respond to the scene to check on his wellbeing. KWPD rescue 3 arrived on scene. Sgt. B. Lariz also arrived on scene and met with Humphrey. KWPD rescue 3 along with Ofc. Gaufillet transported Humphrey to the Lower Keys Medical Center (LKMC) for medical clearance.

Det. H. del Valle and I returned to the original traffic stop and met with the driver of the vehicle, identified by his Indiana driver's license as Nicholas Adam Reed. Det. H. del Valle issued Reed a citation (A4QVDHE) for an equipment violation reference his cracked windshield (F.S.S. 316. 810(1)). I gave the narcotics to Det. K. Malsheimer who had also arrived on scene and asked that he place them into the KWPD property section as evidence. Det. Malsheimer later informed me the weight of the crack cocaine was 19.6 grams and the small slab Humphrey had spit out weighed .1 grams. Det. Malsheimer also advised me he field tested the suspected crack cocaine and it field tested positive. In my training and experience as a narcotics detective, 19.6 grams of crack cocaine far exceeds that which would be considered personal use.

Humphrey's incident began at the intersection of 14th Street and Harriet Avenue, and ended at the intersection of Duck Avenue and 15th Street. Both locations are well within 1000 feet of the Wicker sports complex, a publicly owned recreational facility.

I met with Humphrey at the LKMC. When I first saw Humphrey I jokingly said, "You know, you're supposed to ditch the dope while you're running." Humphrey immediately replied, "How can I ditch the dope if I couldn't ditch you?" I read Humphrey his rights and he waived his rights, agreeing to speak to me without a lawyer present. The first question I asked Humphrey was if he ran because of the warrant or the dope. Humphrey told me it

was because of the dope. After only a few more questions, Humphrey told me he no longer wanted to speak to me about it. I recorded this interview on my body worn camera (BWC).

Once medically cleared, Ofc. Gaufillet transported Humphrey to the Monroe County Detention Center (MCDC) without further incident. I photographed Humphrey at the MCDC reference the KWPD response to resistance incident report. The only visible injury I saw on Humphrey was minor scratches on his right forearm.

At the MCDC, I was provided a copy of the outstanding arrest warrant for Humphrey.

Humphrey's Charges:

Possession of cocaine with intent to sell within 1000' of a recreational facility. Humphrey was detained well within 1000' of the Wicker sports complex. During the incident, numerous children were present at that complex playing sports. Upon his arrest, Humphrey was found to be in possession of 19.7 grams of FTP crack cocaine. That amount is consistent with street level narcotics sales, not personal use. Humphrey acted in violation of F.S.S. 893.13(1)(c)(1).

Evidence - Tampering with or destroying evidence. Humphrey fled on foot and when asked why (post Miranda), admitted it was because of the dope. It was Humphrey's intention to ditch or hide the crack cocaine as he ran, however he did not get the opportunity. Additionally, upon his arrest, Humphrey spit out a piece of crack cocaine and asked for rescue to respond. By putting crack cocaine in his mouth and later spitting it out, Humphrey attempted to hide and/or destroy evidence. Humphrey did so in violation of F.S.S. 918.13.

Resisting an officer without violence. Humphrey, who as a passenger of a vehicle is lawfully detained during a traffic stop, fled from the vehicle on foot and ignored a law enforcement officer's lawful order to stop. Humphrey acted in violation of F.S.S. 843.02.

Violation of probation reference DWLS (Warrant). Humphrey had an active arrest warrant reference violation of probation (F.S.S. 948).

This incident was recorded on my BWC and is cleared by arrest.
