I am not sure the process but would like to express my objection to the request for a variance to allow substitution of bicycle parking spaces in place of regular vehicle parking spaces at 5555 College Road.

As there are no attachments or site plans available on the City's website for this item, I do not know how many spaces are being considered for substitution but from looking at the amount of open, available land of this parcel (RE#00072080-001400) compared to the number of new units the marina would like to develop (62 total), I can only assume there will be a significant lack of available parking spaces. The substitution of bicycle parking spaces for vehicle spaces for this location is illogical and absurd.
