RE: 1000 17th Street (Administrative Hearing)

FROM: Karen DeMaria, City of Key West Urban Forestry Manager

On August 14, 2015, a complaint was received regarding the removal of a Frangipani tree at 1000 17th Street. Research and a site inspection indicated that a frangipani tree greater than 4 inches diameter had been removed and that a tree removal permit had not been issued for the property. Review of Monroe County property appraiser's records indicated that the property owner was from out of town, therefore, a warning letter was sent requesting a discussion of the issue.

On September 16, 2015, a letter was received from Rabbi Wolkenfeld representing the property owners, Child Life Society. An e-mail was then sent to Rabbi Wolkenfeld requesting additional information. No response was received.

On May 11, 2016, an application was submitted to demolish an existing pool and construct a new pool with decking at 1000 17th Street. This application was processed through the simultaneous plan review. The Urban Forestry Manager rejected processing of the application due to the unauthorized removal of the frangipani tree that had not yet been resolved. Rabbi Wolkenfeld initiated contact with the Urban Forestry Manager and agreed to an appearance at the Tree Commission meeting to resolve the tree removal issue.

At the initial inspection of the property in August 2015, all that remained of the frangipani tree was a stump that was covered by dirt and a garbage bag. Information regarding the frangipani tree was collected through Google earth street view photos dated 2011 and show a large, multi-trunked tree, with an estimate diameter of 18-20 inches.



Rabbi Wolkenfeld:

Thank you for the letter dated September 9, 2015 regarding my letter about the unauthorized removal of a regulated tree from the property located at 1000 17th St, Key West Florida. The City of Key West has a very strict Tree Ordinance. The tree you removed, a frangipani tree, required a removal permit from the Tree Commission. While I understand the removal was out of concern for the safety of children, other options might have been considered prior to the removal of the tree.

Normal procedure is when a regulated tree is cut down without benefit of a tree removal permit is to have an administrative hearing in front of the Tree Commission. The Tree Commission determines what penalties, if any, are placed on the property, the homeowner, or the person who did the work. The Tree Commission meets once a month. Penalties could include a fine, the planting of trees on or near the property, or a combination of both.

Who actually cut down the tree and removed the stump for you?

Do you have a local representative that will be able to represent your organization at a Tree Commission meeting?





To Whom It May Concern:

It has come to my attention that the recent removal of a tree located at 1000 17th Street, Key West, FL might violate standards set forth in Section 110 (Tree Protection) of the City of Key Code of Ordinances.

Sec. 110-321. Required.

- (a) Unless a tree removal permit approved by the tree commission and issued by the Urban Forestry Manager has been obtained, no person, whether on publicly or privately owned land, shall cause tree abuse or other harm, or major maintenance to, hatracking, transplanting, topping or removal of the following:
- (3) Any dicot/canopy tree which is four (4) inches or more in diameter at standard height (DSH)

On August 14, 2015, I received an anonymous complaint regarding the removal of a tree in the back yard of a house located at 20th and 17th St. An inspection of the area determined that a Frangipani tree was missing from the backyard of 1000 17th Street. A stump with recent cuts and a garbage bag was observed where the tree once stood. Further investigation revealed that no permits had been issued for the removal of the frangipani tree at that location. A permit would have been required from the Tree Commission due to the size of the tree (greater than 4" diameter).
