RE: Administrative Hearing, 827 Emma Street

On June 10, 2016 I received an e-mail from Code Enforcement regarding the removal of a tree at 827 Emma Street. On June 13, 2016, a site inspection documented that a tree had been removed from the front yard. The debris was piled in the street. I spoke to a gentleman standing in the yard who gave me approval to measure the tree stump. He stated that the tree was banging against the house and causing water line issues. I informed him that the removal of the tree required a permit and left my card for the property owner.

The tree appears to be a non-native tree with a 7" caliper measurement. At this time, the species is not identified but it is not on the protected or not protected tree lists and would have been regulated because it appears to be over 4" diameter.

It is recommended that a Settlement Agreement be issued to include the replacement of trees on the property. The tree was probably around 5" diameter at standard height.
