A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, RANKING THE RESPONDENTS TO CITY OF KEY WEST REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS (RFP) NO. 16-006 FOR BICYCLE AND PEDESTRIAN MASTER TRANSPORTATION PLAN; DIRECTING THE CITY MANAGER TO NEGOTIATE A CONTRACT WITH THE HIGHEST RANKED FIRM FOR CITY COMMISSION APPROVAL; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

Section 2: That the City Manager is authorized to negotiate
a contract starting with the topped-ranked firm, and then the second
and third-ranked firms thereafter in order, if necessary, until an

before the City Commission for final consideration
Section 4: That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately
upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signature of
the Presiding Officer and the Clerk of the Commission.
