

(e) In October of each even-numbered year beginning in 2008, the city commission shall hold a public hearing under this chapter to determine whether the public interest requires the issuance of new passenger vehicle licenses. If the issuance of new licenses is deemed necessary, the city commission shall adopt a resolution making such passenger vehicle for hire licenses to be issued on a random basis by a method approved by the city manager. Any applicant unless applicable provisions of sections 78-128 and 78-129, including the four- or eight-vehicle public hearing may be continued, deferred, rescheduled, or cancelled by the city commission. Nothing in this chapter shall apply to jitneys to apply for licensing before 2008. In making the findings as to whether the public interest requires the issuance of new licenses, the city commission shall take into consideration the number of passenger vehicles for hire already in operation, whether existing or proposed, the need, demonstrated demands necessitating the need for additional services, and the probable effect of the issuance of new licenses on the existing services.
