A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, URGING FDOT TO REMOVE CROSSWALKS ON NORTH ROOSEVELT BOULEVARD THAT ARE UNSAFE AND DEEMED UNNECESSARY; REQUESTING THE INSTALLATION OF HIGH-INTENSITY ACTIVATED CROSS WALK SIGNALS (HAWK) AT CROSSWALKS ON NORTH ROOSEVELT BOULEVARD; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the City Commission finds that some crosswalks on North Roosevelt Boulevard present safety hazards, may not be necessary, and should be removed; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission finds that the use of HAWK traffic control beacons would enhance the safety of drivers and pedestrians.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the City Commission urges FDOT to promptly remove crosswalks on North Roosevelt Boulevard that are unsafe and deemed unnecessary.

Section 2: That the City Commission requests FDOT to install HAWK traffic control beacons at crosswalks on North Roosevelt Boulevard.

Section 3: That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signature of the presiding officer and the Clerk of the Commission.
