Bike/Walk Key West Program Update Report for the Sustainability Advisory Board, at its meeting of October 13, 2016

1. Bicycle and Pedestrian Master Transportation Plan (BPMTP). The Manager's RFP #16-006 BPMTP Committee ranked the four received proposals on September 23 and the ranking goes to the City Commission on October 18 (Item #22) to authorize the Manager to negotiate with the highest ranked firm. We hope negotiations, FDOT approval and City Commission approval of the contract will be done so work can commence before the end of the calendar year. 2. **Bicycle Parking**. Community Services Public Works Department just received a big order of new bicycle racks like the one pictured here. These were purchased with the \$15K in FY 15/16 funds. Specifically we received twenty 5-Loops on Rails, five 6-Loops on Rails, five 2-Loops on Rails. five 3-Loops on Rails and 15 single bollard style racks for a total of 170 racks. Public Works will be installing these after Fantasy Fest. We are still taking input on spots to install them. There is \$30K in FY 16/17 funds. (Thanks for

- 3. **The Big Jump.** At the City Commission meeting on October 18 the City Commission will be hearing a resolution authorizing the City Manager to apply to the People for Bikes Big Jump project. - 4. **South Florida Commuter Services (SFCS).** SFCS consultants are in Key West this week interviewing stakeholders and biking and walking the City as we hold meetings to brand our Bike/Walk Key West program and plan our outreach/multi media advertising campaign that will begin just before January 1. New Key West Bike Maps, brochures, safaety materials and online, print and radio advertising promoting bike, walk and transit as well as safety via our PAL Predictable, Alert and Lawful are all in the works.
