65 in California, 9 in Florida, 16 in MA, 1 in NJ, 3 in NY, 1 in OR, 1 in TX, 3 in WA, 1 in DC, and 2 in ME, including a statewide ban on styrofoam at state functions.

Many of the Florida muni's are comparable or smaller in size to us: Bal Harbour (2,600), Bay Harbor Islands (5,800), Surfside (5,900), North Bay Village (7,400), Key Biscayne (12,832), Coral Gables (49,600).

Some are more restrictive than others, some only address beaches and local parks, some take on only restaurants, some take on all stores, restaruants and beaches and city events.

Attached is the most updated copy of the draft ordinance.

The Sustainability Board will be reviewing it next week, June 30<sup>th</sup>, at 5:30pm at Old City Hall on Greene Street.
